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these pilots called themselves the tokyo club it was a simple task to become a member all you had to do was strap yourself into a heavily loaded p 51 mustang take off from iwo jima fly 650 miles north over the sea often through monsoon storms in your single engined aircraft to japan attack a heavily defended target and then turn around and fly home despite a shrinking fuel supply and perhaps battle damage as well do it once and you earned membership in the club do it 15 times and you earned a trip home but make one mistake or have one touch of bad luck and you had a very good chance of ending up dead
