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a bestseller when originally published in 1938 a lost noir classic given new life in this edition featuring an introduction from matt groening a novel of luck and irony you play the black and the red comes up follows the wayward meanderings of a depression drifter dick as he bums his way from oklahoma to los angeles in search of his son and runaway wife there he commits one crime plans another and gets arrested for something he didn t do he is befriended by characters as lush and crazy as l a deco quentin genter film director decadent collector of beauty and poison mamie an indestructibly loving divorcee patsy who gilds her sandals with radiator paint and becomes an adored evangelist and a procession of crooks shysters rueful temptors and loopy saints

what would happen if an object significantly bigger than the sun comes into the solar system and starts to slow down without any apparent natural reason would the humans race panic would they try to destroy it or would they embrace it this is a story of what could happen and the consequences for the human race in the future

you must read this know what no one is saying read this book it will open your understanding to a new level

this book brings together key essays that seek to make visible and expand our understanding of the role of government policies programs and investments in shaping cities and metropolitan regions the costs and consequences of uneven urban and regional growth patterns suburban sprawl and public health transportation and economic development and the enduring connection of place space and race in the era of increased globalization whether intended or unintended many government policies housing transportation land use environmental economic development

education etc have aided and in some cases subsidized suburban sprawl job flight and spatial mismatch concentrated urban poverty and heightened racial and economic disparities written mostly by african american scholars the book captures the dynamism of these meetings describing the challenges facing cities suburbs and metropolitan regions as they seek to address continuing and emerging patterns of racial polarization in the twenty first century the book clearly shows that the united states entered the new millennium as one of the wealthiest and the most powerful nations on earth yet amid this prosperity our nation is faced with some of the same challenges that confronted it at the beginning of the twentieth century including rising inequality in income wealth and opportunity economic restructuring immigration pressures and ethnic tension and a widening gap between haves and have nots clearly race matters place also matters where we live impacts the quality of our lives and chances for the good life

conventional wisdom holds that christians as members of a universal religion all believe more or less the same things when it comes to their faith yet black and white christians differ in significant ways from their frequency of praying or attending services to whether they regularly read the bible or believe in heaven or hell in this engaging and accessible sociological study of white and black christian beliefs jason e sheldon and michael o emerson push beyond establishing that there are racial differences in belief and practice among members of american protestantism to explore why those differences exist drawing on the most comprehensive and systematic empirical analysis of african american religious actions and beliefs to date they delineate five building blocks of black protestant faith which have emerged from the particular dynamics of american race relations sheldon and emerson find that america s history of racial oppression has had a deep and fundamental effect on the religious beliefs and practices of blacks and whites across america

since world war ii protestant sermons have been an influential tool for defining american citizenship in the wake of national crises in the aftermath of national tragedies americans often turn to churches for solace because even secular citizens attend these services they are also significant opportunities for the protestant religious majority to define and redefine national identity and in the process to invest the nation state with divinity the sermons delivered in the wake of crises become integral to historical and communal memory it matters greatly who is mourned and who is overlooked melissa m matthes conceives of these sermons as theo political texts in when sorrow comes she explores the continuities and discontinuities they reveal in the balance of state power and divine authority following the bombing of pearl harbor the assassinations of jfk and mlk the rodney king verdict the oklahoma city bombing the september 11 attacks the newtown shootings and the black lives matter movement she argues that protestant preachers use these moments to

address questions about christianity and citizenship and about the responsibilities of the church and the state to respond to a national crisis she also shows how post crisis sermons have codified whiteness in ritual narratives of american history excluding others from the collective account these civic liturgies therefore illustrate the evolution of modern american politics and society despite perceptions of the decline of religious authority in the twentieth century the pulpit retains power after national tragedies sermons preached in such intense times of mourning and reckoning serve as a form of civic education with consequences for how americans understand who belongs to the nation and how to imagine its future

the american church in black and white is a book born out of the authors love for gods church it was shaped and given form and text in the crucible of the authors experience as a pastor of several indiana congregations congregations that attempted to create a christian counter narrative to the tragic narrative and legacy of our nations history of slavery and racism cautiously optimistic in tone the author posits that if the american church is going to live into christs prayer request for his church to be one john 17 21 if the church is going to deal effectively with the fallen powers and win people to the lord then christians will have to face and overcome the complex and tragic history of racial antipathy in this country also the church will have to learn how to successfully navigate a spiritual and cultural minefield the author has distilled the three main cultural controversies mines that can explode implode the churchs intercultural hopes down to 1 culturally based worship preferences 2 culturally based views on ministerial

authority and 3 biblical hermeneutics in black and white it is the authors conviction that in spite of these areas of potential conflict god has given the church the power to become an intercultural community that is distinctive attractive and authentically christian

this is a great book to pick up over a cup of coffee as the stories are short and entertaining brian wilsons short stories have been described as being like a box of chocolates each one being delightful but quite different some of the stories are humorous while others are thought provoking and there is a story for everyone hold on tight as wilson takes you on a journey through life look out for the twists and turns on the way wilson has been described as a master of short story twists here comes the sunperhaps will take you on a journey through the spring of life leaving behind winterthe bumpy roads his previous book the dark clouds have now parted and the sun emerges promising new beginnings and a warmer approach to life but life is never predictable and the best of plans sometimes fall apart and the humour of life surfaces brian wilsons collection comprises thirty entertaining short stories plus the contribution by a new short story writer the stories are set in new zealand china japan england zambia india and fiji brian wilson is well travelled and uses his overseas experiences as a basis for these stories having an ma honours in psychology he understands how people tick and his characters are very real and his stories true to life

no group of american minority voters shifted allegiance more dramatically in the 1930s than black americans did up until the new deal era blacks had shown their traditional loyalty to the party of lincoln by voting overwhelmingly the republican ticket by the end of f d roosevelt s first administration however they tremendously voted the democratic ticket the decades long wholesale attachment of blacks to the party of lincoln with its laudable efforts to support blacks emancipation proclamation and reconstruction was understandable and inevitable enough the anomaly was the massive shift by blacks to the democratic party traditionally identified with its long list of constant anti black and premeditated opposition to black liberation opposition to emancipation and reconstruction and with an ongoing record of all forms of racial discrimination segregation disfranchisement exclusion white primaries and white supremacy the transformation of the black vote from solidly republican to solidly democratic did not happen instantaneously but rather it developed over decades of maturing as a result of the amalgamated efforts of presidents and black leaders the move of black voters toward the democratic party was part of a nationwide trend that had occurred with the creation of the roosevelt coalition of 1936 this national shift would make the democrats the majority party for the next several decades including a very decisive margin of black voters in the balance of power

studies of the curse of ham the belief that the bible consigned blacks to everlasting servitude confuse and conflate two separate origins stories etiologies one of black skin and the other of black slavery this work unravels the etiologies and shows how the curse an etiology of black slavery evolved from an earlier etiology explaining the existence of dark skinned people we see when where why and how an original mythic tale of black origins morphed into a story of the origins of black slavery and how in turn the second then supplanted the first as an explanation for black skin in the process we see how formulations of the curse changed over time depending on the historical and social contexts reflecting and refashioning the way blackness and blacks were perceived in particular two significant developments are uncovered first a curse of slavery originally said to affect various dark skinned peoples was eventually applied most commonly to black africans second blackness originally incidental to the curse in time became part of the curse itself dark skin now became an intentional marker of servitude the visible sign of the blacks degradation and in the process deprecating black skin itself
