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from a mission field to a missions sender these words capture the story of the brazilian evangelical church which has gone from receiving missionaries in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries to becoming a movement that presently sends out more global laborers than the churches of england or canada do after narrating brazil s missional shift in this volume smither addresses one fascinating element of the story brazilian evangelical efforts in the arab world how have brazilians adapted culturally among arabs how have they approached ministry and how have they cultivated a theology of mission in the process brazilian evangelical missions in the arab world gives the reader insights from one emerging missions movement with an eye toward a more comprehensive view of the global church

often a disconnect exists between the way pastors children s ministry volunteers and churches describe the health and impact of children s ministry volunteers and the overall functioning of an ongoing children s ministry the volunteer dysfunction that is evident in many churches goes beyond the building scenario or the current strategy that leadership is pursuing if one asks the pastor of just about any local church how the children s ministry is going most pastors will respond positively however if speaking with a children s ministry volunteer one is likely to hear i am burned out but i feel obligated to serve here because we have such a shortage of volunteers and i do love these kids too often there is no program in place to monitor the health of the ministry official training is lacking church vision is blurred and many children s ministry volunteers feel like they are nothing more than large group unpaid babysitters this book analyzes these problems and provides pragmatic systematic steps to a healthier more robust children s ministry

jesus commissioned his apostles and by extension the church to make disciples many church leaders have come to the conclusion that attending worship services and bible study classes will result in making disciples a review of statistical reports indicates a majority of church members and attenders do not believe this process will work or they have come to the conclusion they do not want to become disciples the 2010 us religion census report indicated 79 of the 150 686 156 members children and other attenders did not attend worship

services it also reported over 60 of the same group did not attend bible study classes in 2014 one of the major denominations in the united states reported 63 of church members did not attend worship services and 62 did not attend bible study classes there are literally thousands of spiritual surveys available to church leaders a majority of these surveys develop conclusions based on a single survey being administered or two surveys being administered several months apart if a disciple making process is to be effective there needs to be a method of measuring the progress of individuals moving toward spiritual maturity this type of measurement would produce a visual of spiritual growth spiritual decline or spiritual non growth the only way to measure the spiritual progress of an individual is to create a measurement of the various elements of the spiritual life the process of measuring spiritual maturity in this book is self contained within the participating church and the responses of the participating individuals are highly confidential and warehoused by the participating church
