jesus commissioned his apostles and by extension the church to make disciples many church leaders have come to the conclusion that attending worship services and bible study classes will result in making disciples a review of statistical reports indicates a majority of church members and attenders do not believe this process will work or they have come to the conclusion they do not want to become disciples the 2010 us religion census report indicated 79 of the 150 686 156 members children and other attenders did not attend worship
