develop through our relation to others to our cultural inheritance and most importantly to god murphy addresses the questions of human uniqueness religious experience and personal identity before and after bodily resurrection

recent research in the philosophy of religion anthropology and philosophy of mind has prompted the need for a more integrated comprehensive and systematic theology of human nature this project constructively develops a theological accounting of human persons by drawing from a cartesian as a term of art model of anthropology which is motivated by a long tradition as was common among patristics medievals and reformed scholastics farris draws from philosophical resources to articulate christian doctrine as he approaches theological anthropology exploring a substance dualism model the author highlights relevant theological texts and passages of scripture arguing that this model accounts for doctrinal essentials concerning theological anthropology while farris is not explicitly interested in thorough critique of materialist ontology he notes some of the significant problems

associated with it rather the present project is an attempt to revitalize the resources found in cartesianism by responding to some common worries associated with it

because every single one of us will die most of us would like to know what if anything awaits us afterward not to mention the fate of lost loved ones given the nearly universal vested interest in deciding this question in favor of an afterlife it is no surprise that the vast majority of books on the topic affirm the reality of life after death without a backward glance but the evidence of our senses and the ever gaining strength of scientific evidence strongly suggest otherwise in the myth of an afterlife the case against life after death michael martin and keith augustine collect a series of contributions that redress this imbalance in the literature by providing a strong comprehensive and up to date casebook of the chief arguments against an afterlife divided into four separate sections this collection opens with a broad overview of the issues as contributors consider the strongest evidence of whether or not we survive death in particular the biological basis of all mental states and their grounding in brain activity that ceases to function at death next contributors consider a host of conceptual and empirical difficulties that confront the various ways of surviving death from bodiless minds to bodily resurrection to any form of posthumous survival then essayists turn to internal inconsistencies between traditional theological conceptions of an afterlife heaven hell karmic rebirth and widely held ethical principles central to the belief systems supporting those notions in the final section authors offer critical evaluations of the main types of evidence for an afterlife fully interdisciplinary the myth of an afterlife the case against life after death brings together a variety of fields of research to make that case including cognitiveneuroscience philosophy of mind personal identity philosophy of religion moralphilosophy psychical research and anomalistic psychology as the definitive casebookof arguments against life after death this collection is required reading for anyinstructor researcher and student of philosophy religious studies or theology it issue to raise provocative issues new to readers regardless of background from thosewho believe fervently in the reality of an afterlife to those who do not or are undecidedon the matter

early modern german philosophy 1690 1750 makes some of the key texts of early german thought available in english in most cases for the first time the translations range from texts by the most important figures of the period including christian thomasius christian wolff christian august crusius and georg friedrich meier as well as texts by consequential but less familiar thinkers such as dorothea christiane erxleben theodor ludwig lau friedrich wilhelm stosch and joachim lange the topics covered range across a number of areas of theoretical philosophy including metaphysics the immortality of the soul materialism and its refutation the pre established harmony epistemology the principle of sufficient reason the limits of reason with respect to matters of faith and logic the role of prejudices in cognition and the doctrine of truth these texts are intended to showcase german philosophy in the early modern period as a far richer tradition than it is typically given credit for and indeed as much more than either a footnote to leibniz or merely a step on the way to kant this collection is a valuable resource for students and scholars interested in the early modern german tradition and the often neglected works that enlightened it

what do we mean when we speak about the soul what are the arguments for the existence of the soul as distinct from the physical body do animals have souls what is the difference between the mind and the soul the soul hypothesis brings together experts from philosophy linguistics and science to discuss the validity of these questions in the modern world they contend that there is an aspect of the nature of human beings that is not reducible to the matter that makes up our bodies this perspective is part of a family of views traditionally

classified in philosophy as substance dualism and has something serious in common with the ubiquitous human belief in the soul the soul hypothesis presents views from a range of sciences and the resulting big picture shows more clearly than could a single author with one area of expertise that there is room for a soul hypothesis

proclus 412 485 a d was one of the last official successors of plato at the head of the academy in athens at the end of antiquity before the school was finally closed down in 529 as a prolific author of systematic works on a wide range of topics and one of the most influential commentators on plato of all times the legacy of proclus in the cultural history of the west can hardly be overestimated this book introduces the reader to proclus life and works his place in the platonic tradition of antiquity and the influence his work exerted in later ages various chapters are devoted to proclus metaphysical system including his doctrines about the first principle of all reality the one and about the forms and the soul the broad range of proclus thought is further illustrated by highlighting his contribution to philosophy of nature scientific theory theory of knowledge and philosophy of language finally also his most original doctrines on evil and providence his neoplatonic virtue ethics his complex views on theology and religious practice and his metaphysical aesthetics receive separate treatments this book is the first to bring together the leading scholars in the field and to present a state of the art of proclean studies today in doing so it provides the most comprehensive introduction to proclus thought currently available

few twenty first century academics take seriously mysticism s claim that we have direct knowledge of a higher or more inner reality or god but
