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in a context of increased politicization led by state and federal policymakers corporate reformers and for profit educational organizations the politics of education policy in an era of inequality explores a new vision for leading schools grounded in culturally relevant advocacy and social justice theories this timely volume tackles the origins and implications of growing accountability for educational leaders and reconsiders the role that educational leaders should and can play in education policy and political processes this book provides a critical perspective and analysis of today s education policy landscape and leadership practice explores the challenges and opportunities associated with teaching in and leading schools and examines the structural political and cultural interactions among school principals district leaders state and federal policy actors and increasingly powerful non state actors this fully revised second edition includes questions for discussion at the end of each chapter as well as expanded

discussion on critical race theory the effects on educational systems following the global pandemic the holistic needs of children including physical mental economic nutritional and emotional the impact of technology and ai book banning and the assault on school curricula in some states as well as teacher strikes and the politics of school boards an important resource for practicing and aspiring leaders the politics of education policy in an era of inequality shares a theoretical framework and strategies for building bridges between education researchers practitioners and policymakers

published in 1981 throughout the world education is a highly contentious political issue politicians are involved in educational decision making at all levels and very often educational reform is as much motivated by political ideology as by educational considerations this book which draws together the work of many leading authorities examines the current state of educational politics in many parts of the world the book looks at the problem from a theoretical and a comparative perspective and then analyses the problem in particular areas which include north america western europe and third world countries

the subject of education is a contentious issue in our world the politics of education an introduction critically examines the overt and covert political issues suffusing education questions of what is education what do we teach and how do we teach are all political questions the answers to which empower certain individuals groups and viewpoints over others this book explores the political contexts that shape our conceptions of education and guides our pedagogical practice contemporary educational theory and practice are taken to task for attempting to instill democratic values and a love of freedom anti democratically with little to no freedom for example the politics of education considers the effects of standardized examinations on the individual and her ability to function in a democratic society critiques of contemporary educational theory and practice by dewey foucault bourdieu classical conservative thinkers and others are considered this book examines education through historical and international lenses where appropriate alternative meanings and modes of education grounded in critical pedagogy are offered as steps in revolutionizing education tony monchinski a special education and social studies teacher in new york has taught in the west indies and asia he is a phd candidate in political science at the graduate center of the city university of new york where he studies the relationships between political ideologies and the uses of standardized exams a freelance writer tony writes widely for a variety of publications including a monthly column for musclemag international and frequent contributions to cultural logic an online journal of marxist theory and practice

this is an assessment of the reluctance of american education institutions to undergo change and reform at a time when it is considered necessary the lack of public confidence in educational institutions is discussed along with the subsequent consequences

politics and education cases from eleven nations tackles the relationship between politics and education the book presents several dimensions of the politics education relationship such as the use of education in achieving political agendas and the effects of the interest of a political group on educational policy the book present cases from 11 different countries that show the interaction between education and politics such as the use of educational policy as a compensatory legitimation in west germany the educational opportunity under pre and post revolutionary condition in nicaragua and the education and the maintenance of the social class system in jamaica the text will be of great interest to readers concerned with the implication of political agendas for the education system of a country

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education is a thoroughly political enterprise the process of determining the purpose of education has always been highly controversial it has resulted in disputes that have not only divided people philosophically but also on the basis of religion region class race and ethnicity as a result education provides us with a spectacular arena in which to explore the tensions inherent in european and north american societies as well as an understanding of how current politics shape education policy this book focuses on the politics of education relating to the formation of national identities as affected by globalization and multiculturalism it assesses the ways in which governance institutions political ideologies and competing interests both within and outside of the education community influence the content form and functioning of education as a collection of studies of the political aspects of education and educational policy making this book reaffirms that educational phenomena reflect and inevitably serve specific political agendas political scientists sociologists and education scholars will find this to be an important and valuable text

written by an international group of feminist scholars and activists the book explores how the rise in right wing politics fundamentalist religion and radical nationalism is constructed and results in gendered and racial violence the chapters cover a broad range of international contexts and offer new ways of combating assaults and oppression to understand the dangers inherent within the current global political and social climate the book includes a foreword by the distinguished critical activist antonia darder as well as a chapter by renowned feminist scholar chandra talpade mohanty

michael apple offers a powerful analysis of current debates and a compelling indictment of rightist proposals for change apple presents the causes and effects of further integrating schools into the corporate agenda as well as current calls for a national curriculum and national testing privatization and voucher plans and fundamentalist religious pressures to censor textbooks he demonstrates who will be the winners and losers culturally and economically as the conservative restoration gains in strength bringing with it an even greater restratification of knowledge and students in terms of race class and gender

this book suggests that the link between politics and education as described in ancient greece can bring forth a search for excellence today there exist great possibilities to courageously struggle for excellence yet these possibilities are often discarded by educators and politicians and strangled by the prevailing corporate capitalist regime
