have you ever seen something out of the corner of your eye but and when you looked it was gone ever wonder what would happen if you finally got the chance to see that fluttering image up close well siblings karen and brad got that opportunity and they discovered a whole world just beyond the doors of their grandpa s barn welcome to the fairy world of lienara author and illustrator misty a hull creates a fairy tale world in her book lienara brad and karen are on their first solo visit to their grandparents house the week begins uneventfully enough with rain in the forecast and not much other than chess and delicious food to entice them but a series of slightly bizarre happenings and their grandfather s odd behavior present them with an unusual adventure in the fairy world in lienara the children learn the importance of working together with their grandparents to defeat dark forces in the fairy world brad and karen find their true friendship to overcome the sinister powers and safely return to their family more mature and appreciative

karen momma k gorrell did not consider herself to be an activist but when those she cared about were wronged she refused to remain silent with the economy still reeling from the great recession in 2011 karen s husband and other retirees of the century aluminum plant a pillar of industry in their rural community of ravenwood had their healthcare benefits terminated the united steelworkers had negotiated for these union members to have a portion of their wages deducted to fund future benefits and the employees worked for decades with the promise of health insurance upon retirement when century idled the plant and reneged on its agreement retirees were left without affordable care at the time they needed it most knowing lives were on the line karen vowed to do whatever she could to pressure century to reinstate retirees promised benefits within months she became the lead organizer and spokesperson for a grassroots campaign that would capture the attention of lawmakers and century s ceo the campaign would also test her resolve her relationships and her faith in the systems that promised to protect working class people we were promised follows karen and a group of determined retirees on their long journey to seek justice from staging an occupy inspired camp at the ravenwood plant in west virginia to confronting century s corporate executives in illinois and california in highlighting appalachia s role in the modern labor movement and the impact of women activists in the region this story serves as a powerful example of everyday folks as karen said having the courage to stand up and raise hell and fight back

this book takes an interdisciplinary approach to using and creating poetry for conducting and reporting social research it includes examples of poetry interviews of poets and practical exercises that will enhance the discussion of poetry writing as a method when used as a teaching guide this book will encourage students to consider the importance of form and function in poetry for qualitative methods it also answers the question of how to teach the creation and evaluation of poetry it combats the perception that poetry is too difficult or mysterious to use as research and that only poets should be concerned with poetic craft

a good night for killing the man watched you've got one evil bastard out there matt cop matt proctor investigating a gruesome murder is accused of drug dealing corruption and kicked out of the police he fights to clear his name while hunting down a cyberworld cult that brings killing from computer gaming to the streets who target proctor and stalk his daughter sarah as their next victims proctor also has relationship issues with police colleague inspector azzra mukherjee

karen is sure that hilton is the man she wants to be with until a sexual encounter with beautiful inga while on vacation with him

leaves her sexually confused karen cannot decide if she wants inga or hilton inga says she could have both not convinced but uncertain karen lets him stray to a fantasy woman with an agenda of her own that brief affair ends in tragedy and death realizing she wants him more than she wants inga karen nurses him back to health happiness seems within her grasp until the consequences manifests as post traumatic stress can she share her life with a man in the grip of post traumatic stress as experienced by soldiers police and others many of whom seek relief in suicide is love enough to save him what about inga their lives come together in drama and must be resolved in drama

a rising star that fell anna levenko was set to become the next it girl in tennis the first ukrainian prophesied to win a grand slam and then everything changed years later with a business degree behind her an unpaid job keeping her busy and a family that means well anna can't help but dream of something bigger what's one little white lie in the grand scheme of things but anna's dream job isn't just sunshine and roses her first project takes her to tanzania and everything that could go wrong does not to mention her woeful love life will she ever reach the life she's worked so hard for or is success just not in the cards for anna
