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diagnosing borderline personality disorder bpd in young people has long been a tough call for clinicians either for fear of stigmatizing the child or confusing the normal mood shifts of adolescence with pathology now a recent upsurge in relevant research into early onset bpd is inspiring the field to move beyond this hesitation toward a developmentally nuanced understanding of the disorder the handbook of borderline personality disorder in children and adolescents reflects
