grasp the truly important things in life only those who are frank inherently can appreciate the beautiful scenery in a good day and dare to chase their dreams exactly as the author chants ah poet natural messenger embodiment of freedom and innocence only you first smell every subtle scent in spring even at late night at dawn or in early morning of the sun shining you are only messenger of universe forerunner of all things every sigh of nature sees eye to eye with you understands tacitly whether in the day or at night

proponents of magical realism at a time when few others were doing staged photography this volume presents the first critical look at tress s early career contextualizing the highly imaginative fantastic work he became known for while also examining his other interrelated series appalachia people and places open space in the inner city shadow and theater of the mind james a ganz mazie m harris and paul martineau plumb tress s work and archives studying ephemera personal correspondence unpublished notes diaries contact sheets and more to uncover how he went from earning his living as a social documentarian in appalachia to producing surreal work of imaginative fiction this abundantly illustrated volume imparts a fuller understanding of tress s career and the new york photographic scene of the 1960s and 1970s this volume is published to accompany an exhibition on view at the j paul getty museum at the getty center from october 31 2023 to february 18 2024

dreaming the social uses social dreaming as a tool to explore aspects of contemporary life and examine how we can reverse social fragmentation and large scale trauma since the attack on new york on 9 11 the world has been balanced on the edge of potential disaster exacerbated in recent years by global warming the covid pandemic and war in ukraine since the first edition in 2009 these national and global events have come to dominate our lives in unforeseen ways with this in mind this new edition explores the potential of social dreaming to help access things we know but are unable to think except through the complex activity of dreaming based on several research studies group sessions and mass dreaming experiments the book explores peoples experiences of dreaming during times of change transition and upheaval and discusses the insights that these dreams offer dreaming the social will be of great interest to all professionals interested in dreams and the power of social dreaming including psychoanalysts psychotherapists and clinical psychologists
