This book provides a unique account of adolescent students' L2 experiences in an Anglophone setting. It demonstrates there is a complex ensemble of factors that affect subject choice and enrolment decisions regarding elective second language learning in the face of global English. These findings address a gap in the research of adolescent L2 learners, the majority of whom have English as a first language and thus motivations for language learning vastly differ from those wanting to learn English as an additional language. The findings outlined in this book are valuable as they consider the practical implications for school language programmes. This book will be of interest to scholars, teachers, and policy makers globally wishing to gain further insight into motivational factors affecting L2 enrolment.
