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despite the impressive performance of the foreign and commonwealth office in representing the uk's interests across the globe with what is in governmental terms a particularly small budget the foreign affairs committee believes that the fco is under funded this situation has been exacerbated by the spending review 2010 and the lack of detail provided by the fco and the bbc world service as to exactly how the spending reductions target will be met is disappointing there are concerns about the steps taken by

the fco to adjust to its reduced budget reductions in the deployment of uk based staff overseas and the optimistic planned programme of property sales will have a detrimental impact on the ability of the uk to protect its interests overseas the establishment of the european external action service eeas will place a further strain on the fco's resources the committee welcomes the appointment of lord williams of baglan to the post of international trustee with responsibility for the bbc world service but reiterates its belief that a formal concordat governing the world service's budget and output should be drawn up setting out the world service's independence from budgetary pressures elsewhere in the bbc the budget cuts faced by the british council will lead to the council becoming a substantially different organisation by the end of the spending review period the greater emphasis that the british council will place on commercial activity risks a diminution of the uk's influence and soft power

the business innovation and skills committee has today published a report containing a number of conclusions and recommendations resulting from its inquiry into the insolvency service including i without an increase in resources the investigations unit will be unable to increase the number of cases it can prosecute which will further undermine stakeholder confidence ii there is a risk that further reductions in annual running costs and staff may put undue pressure on the insolvency service to deliver iii it is clear from the evidence that the fee generated income model for the official receiver service is unreliable in the current economic climate iv issues remain with pre pack administration which need to be addressed v given the level of debt relief they can receive it would not be unreasonable to increase the 525 upfront fee that individual debtor bankrupts have to pay the committee welcomes the news that the regulators and the insolvency industry have been working together to create common regulatory standards across the profession the creation of a single gateway for complaints common standards and a common appeals process would be an important step in this regard the service should be required to publish an annual report that charts progress in this area

in 2004 the gershon review recommended that the government pursue the sharing of services including human resources finance procurement and payroll to achieve cost savings it has been up to individual departments to establish their own arrangements and between 2004 and 2011 eight major shared service centres emerged the five centres examined by the nao were expected to cost 0.9 billion to build and operate but to date they have cost 1.4 billion they were also expected to have saved 159 million by the end of 2010/11 while in one instance government has achieved break even in a time consistent with the private sector its overall performance has been varied and the two centres that are still tracking benefits report a measured net cost of 255 million most departmental customers have not acted as intelligent customers and they will need to build in house capability with enough business and technical understanding to manage the services and work with the centres to achieve efficiencies among other findings are that the software systems used in the centres have added complexity and cost and that as the use of the centres has been voluntary departments have struggled to roll out shared services fully across all their business units and arm's length bodies the cabinet office has recently gained approval for a new strategy and business case the nao considers the approach is ambitious and has challenging timescales the cabinet office is actively working with departments on its implementation

financial management at the ministry of justice has improved considerably since the national audit office last examined this subject in 2010 hc 187 isbn 9780102965339 the ministry now has effective governance structures in place and in 2010 11 managed its money far more effectively allowing it to redeploy funds to where they were most needed financial management is now much more central to the operation of the organisation and the quality and consistency of financial planning and forecasting have improved financial information for decision making is more relevant and useful with the ministry s planning work allowing it to bring together a wide range of business information to estimate the financial implications of its workload it has also improved oversight of its arm s length bodies the ministry still has gaps in financial reporting skills and some of its underlying systems need further improvement it was one of only two government departments that failed to produce their financial accounts by the 2011 summer parliamentary recess mainly due to the accounts for the national offender management service being produced late the legal services commission an arm s length body of the moj had the audit opinion on its 2010 11 accounts qualified owing to the potential level of error put at an estimated 50 million there has also been little change in how the ministry monitors and collects assets due under confiscation orders with the amount of outstanding debt having increased by almost 400 million in 2010 11

introduction obstetric fistula is the presence of an opening between a woman s genital tract and urinary tract or between the genital tract and the rectum due to untreated obstructed labor or iatrogenic causes this disease is characterized by the leakage of the urine and or stools through the vagina objective the general objective of this need assessment is to contribute in decreasing the obstetric fistula related morbidity nepal by providing strong information that could help in struggle against obstetric fistula related morbidity methods this is a cross sectional study of 4 health sites in the republic of nepal between november 1st 2011 and december 16th 2011 data were collected on the prevention the management the social reintegration the training and the research related obstetric fistula standard assessment tool structured questionnaire for health workers and patient s interview were used we have also performed a literature review on obstetric fistula in nepal results with the mmr of 281 100 000 live birth it is estimated that there is 200 to 400 new cases of of in nepal each year leading to the overall 4300 prevalent cases our assessment shows that obstetric fistula surgery is practiced in three sites with information verifiable on the registers and files one fourth site is willing to be really involved in struggle against of none of the site is dealing with the five pillar of obstetric fistula two of three sites have of surgery in permanent base while one site actually proceeds by camps even where surgery is practiced there is still a need for training nursing and surgical technical protocol related to obstetric fistula struggle against obstetric fistula is not really coordinated at the country and regional level conclusion and recommendations we recommend elaborating a national strategy of struggle against the obstetric fistulas to elaborate protocols for care training tools organize the struggle against obstetric fistula while founding on the five pillars that are the prevention management reintegration training and operational research while dealing with the national strategy it is urgent to empower the facilities really involved in of surgery and the one committed to start the program
