this volume is the product of a conference on the theme development the next twenty five years which the institute of social studies held in

December 1977 to mark its own twenty fifth anniversary as a centre of development studies we felt it appropriate at that point in time to call together specialists from all over the world in an attempt to assess the state of play in our field as we move into the last quarter of the twentieth century. For several days therefore the institute's new building housed a remarkable concentration of knowledge and experience concerning the problems of the so called less developed countries drawn from all over the world although it was inevitable that the participants should represent the past and it was several times remarked that in that sense there were too few women present. The earnest and sometimes heated discussions looked to the future as much as to what had happened in the last twenty five years as the discussions proceeded three things became apparent firstly although the papers submitted did not fully reveal it the ongoing debate between radicals and moderates those who saw possibilities of change only basically through a direct break with existing structures and those who felt change possible within them is by no means at an end.
