the indian air force from a humble beginning in 1932 with 4 wapiti aircraft six indian officers and 22 hawai sepoys have traversed a long journey of eighty one years and crossed noteworthy milestones to become the fourth largest air force in the world while facing several limitations challenges iaf have met all the national defence requirements and made several strategic contributions with growing economic interests and national aspirations expanding interests well beyond our territorial boundaries and prevailing internal security challenges india s national defence requirements are also increasing the first gulf war was a monumental turning point in the war time employment of aerospace power ever since significance of aerospace power in war crisis and peace time has been gaining ascendancy kosovo and libya are the two pertinent examples of the allies virtually relying on aerospace power without committing any soldiers on the ground scrutiny of the emerging global and national trends suggests that employment of the aerospace assets as well as nation s expectation from the iaf will continue to rise alongside there is an unplanned fall in flying platforms weapon systems and pilot strength of the iaf this study is an attempt to analyse the history of the iaf in war as well as other than war operations to appreciate the emerging trends in geopolitics aerospace technology and doctrine and to identify the likely challenges iaf would be facing in the next two decades and beyond road map for transformation of the national security framework indigenous aerospace industry and the iaf has also been suggested

the environmental devastation caused by military conflict has been witnessed in the wake of the vietnam war the gulf war and the kosovo conflict this book brings together leading international lawyers military officers scientists and economists to examine the legal political economic and scientific implications of wartime damage to the natural environment and public health the book considers issues raised by the application of humanitarian norms and legal rules designed to protect the environment and the destructive nature of war contributors offer an analysis and critique of the existing law of war framework lessons from peacetime environmental law means of scientific assessment and economic valuation of ecological and public health damage and proposals for future legal and institutional developments this book provides a contemporary forum for interdisciplinary analysis of armed conflict and the environment and explores ways to prevent and redress wartime environmental damage

armed conflict and military activities have serious adverse impacts on the environment modern weaponry troop movements landmines hazardous military waste and the destruction of forests for military use are a few sources of harm to the environment both during armed conflict and peacetime military activities ecological assaults in combat areas are often kept a secret by the government resulting in even greater humanitarian and environmental harm environmental degradation is increasingly being recognized as one of the most significant challenges of the 21st century and its effects are being felt worldwide both domestic and

international legislations have been inadequate in mitigating the impact of military activities this book provides details of the environmental destruction wreaked during international and non international armed conflicts and argues that the existing legal regime for the protection of the environment during armed conflict requires substantial modification it puts forward the view that though it is inconceivable to impose an absolute ban on environmental damage during military operations strengthening and clarifying the existing laws protecting the environment in times of conflict and enforcing environment friendly practices among military forces could go a long way in protecting natural assets of our earth

explores the links between the cold war and the global environment ranging from the environmental impacts of nuclear weapons to the political repercussions of environmentalism

the book comprehensively analyses whether a state may be held responsible for environmental damage resulting from its wrongful conduct in international armed conflict focusing on elements of state responsibility s main elements obligations damage and standard of conduct under the law of armed conflict and international environmental law the book covers war and occupation and other relevant applicable laws this extends to international water and human rights law it presents techniques to resolve conflicts of norms from different law branches when simultaneously applied and incorporates latest legal developments and potential impact on the subject engaging with detailed analysis of legal rules the book highlights weaknesses within the law alongside proposing new interpretations of outdated notions practical application of the rules is illustrated by two cases of damage to land mediterranean sea and air pollution in the israel hezbollah war in lebanon 2006 and to the occupied palestinian territory s natural resources mainly land water and quarries it concludes by examining mechanisms to enforce state responsibility the book will be of interest to graduate law students researchers and practitioners in the field of international law the law of armed conflict international environmental and water law and human rights law

as environmental security gains increasing attention there is a pressing need for rigorous examinations of environmental causes of conflict and the potential for conflict resolution environmental conflict explores the role of environmental degradation or scarcity in intrastate or interstate violent conflict and how cooperative efforts might forestall such undesirable consequences by presenting cutting edge conceptual and empirical research examining how environmental factors may influence group and state decisions to employ violence this book enhances understanding of the possibilities for future conflict and how to prevent it

the inherent dangers of war zones constrain even the most ardent researchers with the consequence that little has been known for certain about the effects of war on stable environments war and nature sifts through the available data from past wars to evaluate the actual impact that combat has on natural surroundings examining conflicts of various kinds the long war in tropical vietnam the relatively brief and highly technical wars in the persian gulf and various civil wars in africa and south central asia fought with small arms brauer asks whether differences in technology location and duration are critical in causing environmental and humanitarian harm a number of unexpected conclusions are drawn from this data including practical agendas for collecting scientific evidence in future wars and suggestions about what the world s environmental and conservation organizations can do one thing war and nature does is to show us how globalization can be a force harnessed for good ends

there is no doubt that international law was of major importance during the gulf conflict of 1990 91 military and other actions were repeatedly justified through reference to international law and disputes about interpretation were frequent this book provides a definitive legal analysis of the conflict with reference both to international and to english law some have been tempted to argue that international law is an ineffective means of controlling the activities of a state and its armed forces from the fact that there were no war crimes trials of the leaders of iraq or of any other state international law does however provide a set of norms either agreed to by individual states through the ratification of or accession to a treaty or by which apply to all states by the operation of customary international law and other secondary sources this book determines these norms in order to judge the manner in which individual states recognized the binding nature of them in the conduct of their operations the contributors include lawyers from each of the three british armed services

armed conflicts have become more complicated with the emphasis shifting towards new weapons such as drones cybercrime and autonomous weapons in july 2017 the un general assembly adopted the treaty on the prohibition of nuclear weapons this treaty prohibits a full range of nuclear weapon related activities such as undertaking to develop test produce manufacture acquire possess or stockpile nuclear weapons or other nuclear explosive devices as well as the use or threat of use of these weapons the ongoing conflicts have shown that the consequences of the use of explosive weapons are not limited to death physical injury and disability but also include long term impacts on mental well being the use of improvised weapons by states and non state actors is an area of concern for the environment every state must therefore ensure that weapons used by their armed forces are explicitly adjudged under international humanitarian law ihl and human rights law while reviewing a new weapon the states must adopt multilateral approaches drawing upon relevant legal health environmental and military expertise this book describes the environmental effects of eight weapons and explosive remnants of war that have caused extensive environmental harm in the recent past it also makes specific recommendations addressed to the international community and the states for protecting the natural environment from the impact of weapons of war this book will contribute towards a better understanding of the environmental harm caused by military weapons

this collection of essays by professor michael n schmitt of durham university draws together those of his articles published over the past two decades that have explored particular fault lines in the law of armed conflict as such they examine the complex interplay between warfare and law seeking to identify where the law and warfare appear to diverge and where such apparent divergence can be accommodated through contextual interpretation of the law each essay examines a particular issue in either the jus ad bellum the law governing resort to force or jus in bello international humanitarian law that has proven contentious in terms of applying extant norms to the evolving face of armed conflict among the topics addressed are counter terrorism cyber operations asymmetrical warfare assassination environmental

warfare and the participation of civilians in hostilities

explores the ways environmental issues may lead to international conflict and identifies strategies that might head off potential conflict

this book analyses the issues surrounding the protection of the environment in times of armed conflict and to pose questions as to its adequacy and efficacy but the focus is not simply upon the interpretation of the legal provisions in isolation instead the analysis establishes a benchmark standard of environmental harm against which the adequacy and efficacy of the legal provisions can be measured

this timely study examines how the environmental impact of modern warfare violates fundamental principles of international environmental and humanitarian laws and why these consideration need to be included in rules of armed conflict if direct attacks on innocent civilians are universally recognized as unacceptable then environmental devastation of their habitat by acts of war must also be recognized as an unacceptable consequence of armed conflict the author presents the case that the international community understand its responsibility to curb environmental consequences of modern weaponry and incorporate environmental concerns into the conventions regulating armed conflict published under the transnational publishers imprint

the essays selected for this volume illustrate the growing interest in and importance of crime that is both environmental and transnational in nature the topics covered range from pollution and waste to biodiversity and wildlife crimes and from the violation of human rights associated with the exploitation of natural resources through to the criminogenic implications of climate change the collection provides insight into the nature and dynamics of this type of crime and examines in detail who is harmed and what can be done about it differential victimisation and contemporary developments in environmental law enforcement are also considered collectively these essays lay the foundations for a criminology that is forward looking global in its purview and that deals with the key environmental issues of the present age

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
