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although the moods may vary throughout these evocative works the elegance and

subtly shifting energies of their musical language could only be those of maurice ravel includes rapsodie espagnole ravel s first entirely orchestral composition the magical mother goose suite valse nobles et sentimentales and pavane for a dead princess

excellent exhibition of the russian romantic s mature style particularly in the melodic style of the slow movement and the lavish and imaginative use of the orchestra notably in the scherzo

romance murder and revenge don giovanni offers an ingenious blend of comic and tragic elements in recounting the adventures of a dashing libertine whose trail of seductions and abandonments leads literally to hell mozart s masterpiece a product of his inspired collaboration with poet lorenzo da ponte premiered to public and critical acclaim in 1787 since then every great opera singer has assayed one or another of its leading roles and audiences around the world have delighted in its charms this addition to dover s series of vocal scores for the world s most popular operas contains the complete music for voice with a piano reduction of the orchestral part handsome and inexpensive it features large pages and clear type for easy reading reproduced from an authoritative edition and including an english language version of the libretto this edition of don giovanni will prove an indispensable practical aid for soloists chorus members and rehearsal pianists

brahms was a master of musical structure especially in his 4 symphonies this text presents full orchestral scores of no 1 in c minor op 68 no 2 in d major op 73 no 3 in f major op 90 and no 4 in e minor op 98

classic 1919 arrangements of four keyboard masterpieces goldberg variations chromatic fantasy and fugue the art of the fugue and concerto for piano and string orchestra in d minor breitzkopf härtel edition

volume ii of this critically acclaimed three part collection features introductory text and performance notes to 30 scarlatti sonatas from sonata xxxi to sonata lx the works appear in chronological order and with kirkpatrick numbers this urtext edition preserves the sonatas original presentation save for the addition of accidentals and the inversion of treble and bass clefs in accordance with modern practices and ease of playing

over 40 pieces many difficult to find elsewhere including harpsichord toccatas capriccio on the departure of his most beloved brother 6 little preludes more

this dynamic and expressive work initiated an irrevocable change in the course of symphonic music marking the end of the classical era and the beginning of romanticism authoritative source

four fantasies each with separate violin part carmen fantasy fantasia on themes from gounod s faust fantasie from mozart s the magic flute and fantasie brillante on the march and the romance from rossini s otello

two popular pieces include the 1860 full orchestra revision of serenade no 1 in d major op 11 and brahms s 1875 revision of serenade no 2 in a major op 16 authoritative early editions instrumentation

complete reproductions of op 42 in d minor op 50 nos 1 6 the prussian quartets and op 54 nos 1 3 first set of tost quartets reproduced from the authoritative eulenburg edition

divvirtually all of the composer s works for piano solo 4 piano sonatas invitation to the dance 8 sets of variations grande polonaise others authoritative c f peters edition div

monumental and inspiring the nine symphonies of anton bruckner 1824 1896 stand as late landmarks in the austro germanic symphonic tradition their grandeur originality and nobility of vision have made them staples of the orchestral repertoire unfortunately bruckner s symphonies suffered in his own lifetime from revision and editing by other musicians so that the first published editions of several of the works were quite foreign to the composer s intentions the two symphonies in this volume have been reproduced from the authoritative bruckner society editions by robert haas which represent most faithfully bruckner s ideal versions included here are his most famous symphonies the symphony no 4 in e flat romantic and the symphony no 7 in e

these 21 symphonies composed by mozart between 1764 and 1771 while he was still a boy are astonishing displays of his precocious genius reproduced from the authoritative breitkopf and härtel complete works edition they abound in the qualities that characterize his finest works melodic richness musical invention and a much imitated but unsurpassed grace a splendid way for musicians and music lovers alike to savor and study the composer s youthful development and growing

mastery of symphonic form this new and modestly priced volume completes dover s three part cycle of mozart s symphonic compositions which include symphonies nos 22 34 and nos 35 41 all are among the most performed and recorded works in the orchestral repertoire

this handsome affordable volume includes the overtures to the flying dutchman and rienzi the overture and introduction to act iii of tannhäuser the preludes to acts i and iii of lohengrin the prelude and liebestod from tristan and isolde the prelude to act i of parsifal and the prelude to act i of meistersinger

the work of 100 years and three generations of archivists this compilation which originally appeared in 1905 encompasses the musical wealth of a nation

this compilation based on authoritative editions offers full scores of two suites from bizet s supreme achievement publisher s description

three of the most popular romantic violin concertos performed today in one volume includes beethoven concerto for violin and orchestra in d major opus 61 1806 mendelssohn concerto for violin and orchestra in e minor opus 64 1844 and tchaikovsky concerto for violin and orchestra in d major opus 35 1878

first volume of a newly engraved edition contains the first nine sonatas the fantasy in d minor k 397 rondo in d k 485 variations in c k 265 and andante in f k 616

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
