the swing voter occupies a cherished place in american political lore candidates court swing voters consultants target them and pundits speculate constantly on which way they will lean but nobody has adequately defined them as a group what exactly is a swing voter no one really seems to know t he swing voter in american politics fills this conceptual gap the book brings political scientists and pollsters together to answer four basic questions what is a swing voter how can analysts use survey data to identify swing voters how do swing voters differ if at all from the rest of the electorate and what role do swing voters play in determining the outcomes of contemporary elections drawing on a wide range of sources including american national election studies data gallup polls pew center surveys and the national annenberg election survey the contributors track swing voters across six decades and in national and local

for decades journalists have called the winners of u s presidential elections often in error well before the closing of the polls in votes that count and voters who don t sharon e jarvis and soo hye han investigate what motivates journalists to call elections before the votes have been tallied and more importantly what this and similar practices signal to the electorate about the value of voter participation jarvis and han track how journalists have told the story of electoral participation during the last eighteen presidential elections revealing how the portrayal of voters in the popular press has evolved over the last half century from that of mobilized partisan actors vital to electoral outcomes to that of pawns of political elites and captives of a flawed electoral system the authors engage with experiments and focus groups to reveal the effects that these portrayals have on voters and share their findings in interviews with prominent journalists votes that count and voters who don t not only explores the failings of the media but also shows how the story of electoral participation might be told in ways that support both democratic and journalistic values at a time when professional strategists are pressuring journalists to provide favorable coverage for their causes and candidates this book invites academics organizations the press and citizens alike to advocate for the voter s place in the news

why it s time to enshrine the right to vote in the constitution throughout history too many americans have been disenfranchised or faced needless barriers to voting part of the blame falls on the constitution which does not contain an affirmative right to vote the supreme court has made matters worse by failing to protect voting rights and limiting congress s ability to do so the time has come for voters to take action and push for an amendment to the constitution that would guarantee this right for all drawing on troubling stories of state attempts to disenfranchise military voters women african americans students former felons native americans and others richard hasen argues that american democracy can and should do better in assuring that all eligible voters can cast a meaningful vote that will be fairly counted he shows how a constitutional right to vote can deescalate voting wars between political parties that lead to endless rounds of litigation and undermine voter confidence in elections and can safeguard democracy against dangerous attempts at election subversion like the one we witnessed in the aftermath of the 2020 presidential election the path to a constitutional amendment is undoubtedly hard especially in these polarized times a real right to vote explains what s in it for conservatives who have resisted voting reform and reveals how the pursuit of an amendment can yield tangible dividends for democracy long before ratification

whether it is requests for bricks and mortar or more operating money each election type and context is unique with no guarantee that a set of campaign strategies successful in one district will not fail in another community if successful campaigns were not such a delicate balance of science and art the key to success would have long since been discovered resulting in significantly more school districts winning at the ballot box as members of the baby boom generation collectively watch their last child receive a diploma from our nation s public schools passing school finance elections is going to be even more difficult promising tougher battles with the

electorate and tighter margins between success and failure school finance elections represents a marriage of research and successful practice presenting a comprehensive planning model for school leaders preparing for and conducting school finance elections information presented emphasizes systems and strategies rather than specific campaign tactics avoiding a myopic focus on tactics allows school leaders to elevate their thinking to a more comprehensive and long range vision of election planning each of the chapters elaborates on one of the ten elements in the authors comprehensive planning model use of this model has reaped success in all types of school districts from new jersey to california and the authors aim to bring readers success at the ballot box as well this second edition builds on the first with expanded sections about the attitudes of voters whose children have grown and graduated research into the nature of organized opposition and new material highlighting the internet in campaigns the authors provide school leaders with important resources to guide their planning and execution of school finance referenda

approval voting proposes a compelling way to elect some 500 000 officials in public elections under this system voters may vote for or approve of as many candidates as they like in multicandidate elections among the many benefits of approval voting are its propensity to elect the majority candidate rather than the strongest minority candidate as often occurs under plurality voting its relative invulnerability to insincere or strategic voting and by offering voters the opportunity to influence election outcomes more equitably a probable increase in voter turnout since the publication of the first edition of this book its arguments in favor of an election reform practically unknown in 1983 have stood the test of time perhaps the proof of the pudding lies in the adoption of approval voting by about a dozen professional societies several with tens of thousands of members and their generally favorable experience with it after a generation of discussion and debate on the subject the authors remain convinced that approval voting is as relevant today as it was

when rigorous analysis and systematic empirical research on this election reform began more than 30 years ago

this timely book provides a thought provoking discussion of issues that influence voter registration and turnout in contemporary america elections not only determine who will fill an office they have a lot to say about how the democratic process works or doesn't work in 21st century america this fascinating book sheds light on that question by focusing on factors that currently shape elections and political participation in the united states it covers issues that are consistently in the media such as gerrymandering voter id and rules pertaining to when where and how americans register and vote but it also goes beyond the obvious to consider issues that are often overlooked civic education and engagement citizen apathy and political alienation for example the volume begins with an introduction to elections that includes a discussion of the history of voting in the united states each subsequent chapter covers a different topic relative to registration and voting it addresses matters of education as well as socialization mobilization and the legal and political structures that shape u s political participation ideal for readers who may be considering such concerns for the first time the work will foster an understanding of why political participation is important and of the causes and consequences of non voting

is voting out of fashion does it matter if voters don't show up at the polls if yes is legal enforcement of voting compatible with democracy these are just a few of the questions linked to the thorny problem of electoral abstention this book addresses the hot question whether there is a duty to vote and if this is enforceable in the form of compulsory voting divided into two parts anthoula malkopoulou begins by expertly presenting the importance of compulsory voting today situating the debate within the contemporary discussion on liberty equality and democracy then she questions the historical origins of the idea in europe in particular she examines

parliamentary discussions and other primary sources from france and greece including a few additional insights from other countries like switzerland and belgium focusing especially on the years between 1870 and 1930 the reader learns about the historical actors of the debates their efforts to legitimate punishment of abstention through normative arguments but also their strategic motivations and political interests while discussions at the beginning of the century focus on introducing compulsory voting malkopoulou criticizes its misuse after the second world war exposing the contingency of relevant normative claims today and the conditionality of compulsory voting from ancient times until today you learn about the ideological debates their political context and how the problems of equal representation and democratic moderation persist through the ages

during every election cycle political observers generate a seemingly limitless supply of theories opinions and predictions unfortunately many of these assertions oversimplify complex subjects or overhype the latest political fads inevitably some misinformation becomes part of the conventional wisdom about american elections the objective of conventional wisdom and american elections exploding myths exploring misconceptions is to bring clarity to several of these subjects for example it is now commonplace for commentators to emphasize the negative tactics and practices of the campaigns of presidential candidates in 2016 some commentators suggested that the presidential campaign was the nastiest ever with the campaigns of president donald trump hillary clinton and their supporters going to new extremes of negativity however these claims are not new dating as far back as the presidential election of 1800 critics of thomas jefferson stated that his potential victory would bring about legal prostitution and the burning of the bible in 1824 opponents of andrew jackson charged that he was a murderer and that his wife was a bigamist perhaps most scurrilous of all jackson s opponents even accused his dead mother of being a prostitute in total conventional wisdom and american elections identifies eleven

widely held myths and misconceptions about elections in the united states the conclusions drawn throughout the book are based on the most current political science research in some instances the literature is clear in debunking popular myths about american elections on other issues research findings are more mixed in either case conventional wisdom and american elections clarifies the issues so that readers can discern between those in which scholars have largely resolved and those in which honest debate remains

in democracy gone abele argues that the last eight years in particular have shown us that our democracy has largely disintegrated leaving behind only an exoskeleton that was once its original vertebrae of ends and principles this book questions whether or not the american democratic experiment has run out of steam and if through our inattention we have replaced our democracy with politicians lustful for power and central authority that is out of touch with the needs of common people the essays included in democracy gone focus specifically on two questions first how true are we staying to our founding values in our national actions and dialogues second how consistent and universal is our application of the principles and standards we claim to hold dear the underlying call is that it is critical to our form of democracy in the united states that citizens once again become active participants in the issues of the day nothing less than the reclamation of our democracy is at stake
