ka lei ha'aheo beginning hawaiian is a culturally oriented hawaiian language textbook its grammar lessons include the relationship between the language and the hawaiian world view the book s dialogs are drawn from contemporary hawaiian family life extensive classroom testing was used in developing ka lei ha'aheo although it was designed for college use it is also a handy resource for high schools and individuals particularly because its companion volume ka lei ha'aheo teacher guide and answer key provides english translations and answers to the exercises the text s lively appeal is further enhanced with line drawings

according to unesco it is believed that at least half of the nearly 7 000 languages spoken around the world will cease to be used within the next 100 years if this issue is neglected people will lose not only their cultural heritage but also invaluable understandings about the history of all humankind endangered languages of the caucasus and beyond includes the manuscripts of 19 papers that were presented at the 1st international cua conference on endangered languages organized by the caucasus university association cua at ardahan turkey on 13 to 16 october 2014 the articles address issues such as the state of the field of

documentation conservation and revitalization of endangered languages with special reference to the endangered languages in the caucasus region and beyond

in 1907 hawai i s fledgling college of agriculture and mechanical arts boasting an enrollment of five students and a staff of twelve opened in a rented house on young street the hastily improvised college and the university into which it grew owed its existence to the initiative of native hawaiian legislators the advocacy of a caucasian newspaper editor the petition of an asian american bank cashier and the energies of a president and faculty recruited from cornell university in distant ithaca new york today nearly a century later some 50 000 students are enrolled yearly at ten campuses in a unique system of community colleges and professional schools malamalama a history of the university of hawai i documents the many contributions the university has made over the decades to culture and education in the islands from its start the university rejected the racial stereotyping and prejudice common in territorial hawai i thus fostering an ease of association among students of diverse backgrounds and providing through student government and campus societies a venue where future political leaders of the islands could hone their skills the story of how the university of hawai i grew from a regional undergraduate college to an internationally recognized graduate and research university weathering repeated crises along the way is told by emeritus professors kamins and potter in part i they highlight the university s relationship with the legislature the actions and personalities of its very different presidents and the effects of social upheaval and changing budgets on an evolving institution three alumni provide personal accounts of their years at the university parts ii and iii offer particular histories by knowledgeable contributors including faculty members and administrators of the hilo and west oahu campuses of each fo the seven community colleges and of programs at the manoa campus the strands of history woven together here reveal the university s abiding determination to serve as a cultural link across the pacific and among hawai i s own ethnic communities the university seal dominated by the hawaiian word malamalama light of knowledge depicts a map of the pacific hemisphere celebrating the great diversity of people and cultures that contributed to its founding and the westward reach of its connections

variation in p is an essential follow up to the seminal proposals of the generative tradition regarding prepositional syntax recent research shows that prepositional phrases have a complex internal structure and that the grammatical encoding of locative

meaning has its own place in universal grammar the papers collected in the first part of this volume not only test these proposals against new comparative data but also shed light on the relation between spatial expressions and other semantic relations like possession the second part of the volume explores the role of prepositions in non spatial environments as well as in more general phenomena like verbal affixation ellipsis and complementation by drawing on evidence from less studied languages and by considering prepositional syntax in interaction with clausal syntax as well as within prepositional phrases variation in p refines and develops theories introduced by previous generative studies

in the summer of 2019 a group of kia i or protectors made up of kānaka ōiwi native hawaiians and their allies came together to prevent the construction of the thirty meter telescope tmt on the dormant volcano maunakea in mele on the mauna joseph keola donaghy explores how music and especially haku mele or hawaiian language composers played a crucial role in this defense musicians flocked to the mauna mountain to perform for the kia i and a worldwide audience via social media haku mele created new songs at unprecedented levels releasing many commercially with proceeds benefiting organizations providing support services and supplies to the kia i this book features over 30 of the author s interviews with individuals who participated in musical activities connected with this movement including kia i and their supporters composers musicians and community leaders donaghy explores indigenous hawaiian concepts and theories like mana power mo okū auhau and pilina genealogy and relationships kapu aloha philosophical code of conduct and aloha āina love of land patriotism and western academic concepts like connectedness and community building poetics sound ing and silenc e ing conflict and creativity mele on the mauna illuminates how music played a powerful role in building solidarity inspiration and activism reveling in the most contentious confrontations about protecting maunakea and the outpouring of musical performances and creativity that occurred

in this groundbreaking work peter mills reveals a wealth of insight into the emergence of the hawaiian nation state from sources mostly ignored by colonial and post colonial historians alike by examining how early hawaiian chiefs appropriated western sailing technology to help build their island nation mills presents the fascinating history of sixty hawaiian owned schooners brigs barks and peleleu canoes while these vessels have often been dismissed as examples of chiefly folly mills highlights their significance in hawai'i s rapidly evolving monarchy and aptly demonstrates how the monarchy s own nineteenth century sailing fleet

facilitated fundamental transformations of interisland tributary systems alliance building exchange systems and emergent forms of indigenous capitalism part one covers broad trends in hawai'i s changing maritime traditions beginning with the evolution of hawaiian archaic states in the precontact era mills argues that indigenous trends towards political intensification under the predecessors to kamehameha i set the stage for kamehameha s own rapid appropriation of western sailing vessels from the first procurement of a western style vessel in 1790 through the beginning of the constitutional monarchy in 1840 these vessels were part of a nuanced strategy that promoted a diverse revenue base for the monarchy and developed greater international parity in hawai'i s foreign diplomacy part two presents the histories of the sixty vessels owned by hawaiian chiefs between 1790 and 1840 discussing their significance origin physical attributes ownership procurement and purpose using newspapers and other contemporaneous sources mills uncovers little known details of more than 2 000 voyages around and between the islands and to distant parts of the pacific his meticulous documentation of each ship s itinerary is a valuable resource for tracking the movement of chiefs and commoners between islands as they engaged in the business of building a newly interconnected hawaiian nation part three connects these previously neglected maritime stories with an expanding body of historical treatments of hawaiian agency readers with enthusiasm for life in nineteenth century hawai'i will appreciate the entertaining and at times deeply moving glimpses into the daily lives of individuals in hawai'i s pluralistic port communities

paying particular attention to hula performances that toured throughout the u s beginning in the late nineteenth century adria l imada investigates the role of hula in the american colonization of hawai i
