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throughout hooks powerful life she envisioned described and enacted a radical engaged pedagogy and praxis rooted in love rather than power while simultaneously modeling transgressive modes of being in the world bell hooks radical pedagogy is the first sustained collection of teachings and reflections that address the full scope of bell hooks teaching trilogy organized into four parts covering engaged pedagogies pedagogies of hope and joy pedagogies of the body mind spirit strategies of resistance and anticolonial frameworks the book offers an accessible guide to hooks work for students teachers and researchers the chapters examine how hooks pedagogical framework resists antiblack imperialist white supremacist capitalist able and cisheteronormative patriarchal pedagogical praxes while simultaneously calling for a deep and sustained commitment to the work of educating people to heal this world into what it might become the book brings together the work of educators who are making visionary interventions in their fields of study and in their local and regional communities they include scholars and teachers affiliated with universities schools across k 12 levels as well as community education cooperatives the book includes a foreword by the feminist scholar beverly guy sheftall spellman college usa

recent attacks on ethnic studies revisionist actions in curriculum content and anti immigrant policies are creating a new culture war in america this important work lays out the current

debates both in k 12 and higher education to uncover the dangers and to offer solutions in 2010 hb 2281 a law that bans ethnic studies in arizona was passed in the same year texas whitewashed curriculum and textbook changes at the k 12 level since then the nation has seen a rise in the legal and political war on ethnic studies revisionist actions in curriculum content and anti immigrant policies creating a new culture war in america white washing american education demonstrates the value and necessity of ethnic studies in the 21st century by sharing the voices of those in the trenches educators students community activists and cultural workers who are effectively using multidisciplinary approaches to education this two volume set of contributed essays provides readers with a historical context to the current struggles and attacks on ethnic studies by examining the various cultural and political wars that are making an impact on american educational systems and how students faculty and communities are impacted as a result it investigates specific cases of educational whitewashing and challenges to that whitewashing such as tom horne s attack along with the state board of education against the mexican american studies in the tucson school district the experiences of professors of color teaching ethnic studies in primarily white universities across the united states and the role that student activists play in the movements for ethnic studies in their high schools universities and communities readers will come away with an understanding of the history of ethnic studies in the united states the challenges and barriers that ethnic studies scholars and practitioners currently face and the ways to advocate for the development of ethnic studies within formal and community based spaces

hollywood film directors are some of the world s most powerful storytellers shaping the fantasies and aspirations of people around the globe since the 1960s african americans have increasingly joined their ranks bringing fresh insights to movie characterizations plots and themes and depicting areas of african american culture that were previously absent from mainstream films today black directors are making films in all popular genres while inventing new ones to speak directly from and to the black experience this book offers a first comprehensive look at the work of black directors in hollywood from pioneers such as gordon parks melvin van peebles and ossie davis to current talents including spike lee john singleton kasi lemmons and carl franklin discussing 67 individuals and over 135 films melvin donalson thoroughly explores how black directors storytelling skills and film techniques have widened both the thematic focus and visual style of american cinema assessing the meanings and messages in their films he convincingly demonstrates that black directors are balancing hollywood s demand for box office success with artistic achievement and responsibility to ethnic cultural and gender issues

what does it mean to be a woman do women have a unique nature and a unique vocation should feminists work to help women specifically or to support all people thinking woman examines the lives and ideas of women in the history of philosophy who wished to understand and advocate for themselves as women some like hildegard of bingen and edith stein found women to be a unique creature designed by god necessary for good stewardship of creation others such as mary wollstonecraft and sojourner truth found women to be identical to men in all but biology and thus identical before the law still others from simone de beauvoir to judith butler found the very question troubling as they tried to sort out cultural ideas from biological rules these women and their views form a canon on the question of women a canon that can help guide the conversation for thinkers and activists today who want both to understand women and to advocate for justice for all people

founded in 1943 negro digest later black world was the publication that launched johnson publishing during the most turbulent years of the civil rights movement negro digest black world served as a critical vehicle for political thought for supporters of the movement

the black prairie archives an anthology recovers a new regional archive of black prairie

literature and includes writing that ranges from work by nineteenth century black fur traders and pioneers all of it published here for the first time to contemporary writing of the twenty first century this anthology establishes a new black prairie literary tradition and transforms inherited understandings of what prairie literature looks and sounds like it collects varied and unique work by writers who were both conscious and unconscious of themselves as black writers or as prairie people their letters recipes oral literature autobiographies rap and poetry provide vivid glimpses into the reality of their lived experiences and give meaning to them the book includes introductory notes for each writer in non specialist language and notes to assist readers in their engagement with the literature this archive and its supporting text offer new scholarly and pedagogical possibilities by expanding the nation s and the region s archives they enrich our understanding of black canada by bringing to light the prairies black histories cultures and presences

this two volume set features 400 articles on african americans in sports including biographical entries as well as entries on events tournaments leagues clubs films and associations the entries cover all professional amateur and college sports such as baseball tennis and golf

on 4 july 1910 in 100 degree heat at an outdoor boxing ring near reno nevada film cameras recorded and thousands of fans witnessed former heavyweight champion jim jeffries reluctant return from retirement to fight jack johnson a black man after 14 grueling rounds johnson knocked out jeffries and for the first time in history there was a black heavyweight champion of the world at least 10 people lost their lives because of johnson s victory and hundreds more were injured due to white retaliation and wild celebrations in the streets public screenings received instantaneous protests and hundreds of cities barred the film from being shown congress even passed a law making it a federal offense to transport moving pictures of prizefights across state lines and thus the most powerful portrayal of a black man ever recorded on film was made virtually invisible this is but one of the hundreds of films covered in the a to z of african american cinema which includes everything from the birth of a nation to crash in addition to the films brief biographies of african american actors and actresses such as sidney poitier james earl jones halle berry eddie murphy whoopi goldberg denzel washington and jamie foxx can be found in this reference through a chronology a list of acronyms and abbreviations an introductory essay a bibliography appendixes black white photos and hundreds of cross referenced dictionary entries on actors actresses movies producers organizations awards film credits and terminology this book provides a better understanding of the role african americans played in film history

everyone has a story to tell a legacy to leave to both living family and future generations in his memoir a boy from barnhart times remembered author herb taylor shares his life story and legacy from his coming of age on large ranches and small towns in west texas to his subsequent career as a professional army officer taylor writes of life and its realities during the drought years of the 1950s he chronicles the people places ideas and incidents he encountered during a twenty eight year army career as well as his struggle with a lifelong alcohol addiction and the death of his childhood sweetheart after a thirty five year marriage he writes of the good times and the not so good the ordinary and the unusual in a casual personal and informative way that captures the times and his life experiences equal parts genealogy history travelogue and memoir taylor s memories are the emotional account of a life well lived as well as an interesting and intricate record of times gone by

the salacious and scandalous murders of a series of couples on texarkana s lovers lanes in seemingly idyllic post wwii america created a media maelstrom and cast a pall of fear over an entire region what is even more surprising is that the case has remained cold for decades combining archival research and investigative journalism pulitzer prize nominated historian james presley reveals evidence that provides crucial keys to unlocking this decades old puzzle dubbed the phantom murders by the press these grisly crimes took place in an america before dial telephones dna science and criminal profiling even pre television print and radio media stirred emotions to a fever pitch the phantom killer exhaustively researched is the only definitive nonfiction book on the case and includes details from an unpublished account by a survivor and rare never before published photographs although the case lives on today on television the internet a revived fictional movie and even an off broadway play with so much of the investigation shrouded in mystery since 1946 rumors and fractured facts have distorted the reality now for the first time a careful examination of the archival record personal interviews and stubborn fact checking come together to produce new insights and revelations on the old slayings

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
