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an art historian develops a theological philosophical and historical framework within which to experience and interpret modern and contemporary art that is in dialogue with the christian faith

where and how do we encounter god s revelation made once for all in christ jesus the answer to this urgent question is explored in matthias joseph scheeben s handbook of catholic dogmatics book one theological epistemology part one the objective principles of theological knowledge here translated for the first time in english by michael j miller scheeben 1835 1888 a renowned german theologian in this unabridged first part of a two volume set begins with a discussion of the nature and scope of dogmatic theology as a science he treats divine revelation as the source of theological knowledge and as

transmitted in scripture and in the apostolic tradition included in this volume is schreeben's treatise the objective principles of theological knowledge schreeben writes on faith in its source contents and handing on in the church as it confronts the believer eliciting his or her assent

did the twentieth century patristic renewal come from nowhere was all nineteenth century theology neo scholastic do theologians personal failings invalidate their theologies these are the questions that guide the contributors to this volume as they reassess the legacy of the so called roman school a nineteenth century theological network centered in the jesuit roman college though not entirely uncritical the roman college represents a collective effort at sympathetic historical retrieval it shows how various figures connected to the roman school perrone passaglia schrader franzelin newman schreeben and kleutgen engaged theologically the problems of their own day and set the stage for later theological renewal

this book offers an introduction to some of the fundamental themes of theology from the very beginning however it insists on the contribution to be found in the different christian traditions the reader is enabled to view these traditions as part of a common heritage drawing on the wealth of these understandings of what it is to be christian can be an inspiration for those from very different church structures and even for people who seek to understand their own spiritual journey and search for god without identifying themselves or their journey with any particular church a number of important theological questions are covered in the book it starts with a look at theological method before examining the idea of divine revelation this is followed by investigating the nature of authority and authorities in different churches and where these coincide and come into conflict the historical and cultural contexts of theology and its roots in religious experience are also examined each theme has a biblical and patristic part as well as a genuinely reciprocal discussion involving contemporary catholic orthodox and protestant theologians

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how does the church perceive herself fr louis bouyers the church of god sets out to answer that question in light of tradition and theological reflection through the centuries but especially by drawing on the teaching of the second vatican council this book is a highly readable thorough synthesis of ecclesiology after the council presented by one of the greatest theologians of the 20th century the author himself a former lutheran minister also explores reformation views of the church as well as the catholic churchs deepened understanding of her distinctive identity and her imperfect but real communion with the orthodox churches and protestant ecclesial communities the church of god is a major contribution to the ecclesiology of communion fostered by the second vatican council and continued by pope paul vi but especially by john paul ii and benedict xvi indeed the book reflects the hermeneutic of reform pope benedict xvi insists should guide the interpretation of vatican ii

this book explores the mariology of one of the most unique and fascinating thinkers in the russian orthodox tradition father sergius bulgakov bulgakov develops the russian sophianic mariological tradition initiated by vladimir solo ev and argues that mary is the soul of the world or the pneumatological hypostasis mary is the first and greatest disciple to be adopted by the holy spirit by situating mary within the life and mission of the holy spirit bulgakov maintains the respect and veneration that orthodox christians have for mary but also places mary squarely within the community of disciples mary is a model disciple who reveals that the goal of the spiritual life spiritual motherhood in addition this text reveals the relevance and importance of bulgakov s contribution to the contemporary discussion about the role of mary in the history of salvation

o blessed confidence o safe refuge mother of god and our mother st anselm of canterbury 1033 1109 doctor of the church what is not generally known and only infrequently studied is the role of our lady over the centuries as a catechist teacher of the faith in a very real sense primary teacher because she is mother of god and mother of the church and faithful if any one factor might be singled out for the very high level of faith and religious practice in medieval merry england merry because mary s dowry because consecrated to mary as her possession and property it is this marian catechesis only when england deliberately rejected mary did it cease to be the happy place it once was unfortunately english colonization of other peoples took place only after the repudiation of mary by england that is why this catechetical work is especially valuable for the faithful and those who are seeking faith in america and other english speaking cultures it will bring to their attention precisely what is central to catechetics and so often missing the presence of mary mother and teacher it will make perfectly clear why we need not fewer marian sanctuaries but many many more in all parts of the country where this quiet but so real and profound influence of the marian principle of the church will be felt at every level it is my prayer and hope that those who read and study this work will find the same inspiration and stimulus that i found in having the privilege to read the manuscript before publication we are much indebted to brother anthony josemaria pasquale a franciscan tertiary of the immaculate and gifted scholar

in tilt finding christ in culture brian nixon takes the reader on a voyage of discovery traveling the currents of god s presence in culture summed up in four streams that define a noun people places things and ideas in his journey nixon touches upon people as diverse as andy warhol cormac mccarthy robert redford and georgia o keeffe places such as canterbury england and las vegas nevada things as unique as typewriters trains and abstract art and ideas as fascinating as mathematics and beauty in these short impressionistic pieces nixon with the curiosity of a journalist elicits intelligent discussion and poetic articulations prompting a head tilt from those who join him on a theo cultural expedition

in verbum domini his 2010 apostolic exhortation pope benedict xvi challenged the church to keep theology firmly rooted in the study of scripture the essays collected here respond thoughtfully and concretely to that charge together demonstrating that exegesis is essential to the theological task and to faith for scholars students and the broader church

the traditions about jesus and his teaching circulated in oral form for many years continuing to do so for decades following the writing of the new testament gospels james dunn is one of the major voices urging that more consideration needs to be given to the oral use and transmission of the jesus tradition as a major factor in giving the synoptic tradition its enduring character

this volume is the masterpiece of chao gejin one of the best known chinese scholars of epic studies during the last several decades between the 20th and 21st centuries the discussion ranges from homeric

and indo european epics to renewed discoveries of age old african and asian epics the author details developments in research from parry and lord s work on homeric epics and serbo croatian oral poetry to his own research on the mongol heroic epic the book traces the formation of theoretical systems such as oral formulaic theory ethnopoetics and performance theory and ends with the author s explorations of the 20th century mongolian singer arimpil s singing of his native epic poetry by combining china s theoretical concerns in verbal art and western theories in folklore chao illustrates the nature and feature of oral epic in many ways and is heading for constructing an oral poetics in a broader sense students and scholars of epic studies literature folklore and anthropology will find this an essential reference
