the endless wars of the seventeenth century took their toll in the lives of millions of soldiers and crushing taxes to legitimize war europe s rulers turned to the church o god we praise you te deum laudamus was sung in the churches of france and sweden to celebrate victory in battle it was a way of thanking god but also an opportunity for congregations to learn what had happened and an occasion for festivities in the story of war the historian anna maria forssberg applies a narrative and ritual perspective to the te deum looking at specific wars such as the thirty years war and at themes such as peace and enmity this is a unique comparative study of war propaganda in early modern times and how it defined the roles of ruler and ruled alike there were national differences but ultimately all war stories were highly selective bloody defeat and uneventful everyday life were glossed over what mattered were spectacular victories and royal glory yet in the end the war stories peddled in both sweden and france were profoundly challenged by the crisis of 1709

papou had stories to tell that went unheard until his granddaughter decided to write this book he was not a hero he said he was a boy he didn t choose to fight this war he was drafted he was

only 18 a recent high school graduate a child and somebody's son this boy survived landing on omaha beach with his friends falling all around him but on the morning of october 7 1944 he was almost fatally injured by a bomb that landed on his tent he learned how to walk again and chose to go straight back to the front lines because he felt that was where he should be with his buddies he came back only to find that he was one of the few in his unit who remained this is a story of wwii it's also a story of love faith courage and hope this book is appropriate for elementary through high school and addresses the us history and social studies standard of the world and the us place in it conflicts between and among countries and people us world history sequence

this charming little story breaks the autobiography mold technically it's the childhood account of a third culture american kid and his adventures and exploits growing up all over the world in the 1950s and 60s the book will transport you from australia to africa from brazil to israel from europe to the far east but it's not just a travelogue or a dry where i was born sleeper it's part adventure it's about surfing in africa and sailing in rio de janeiro it's a buddhist parable about the responsibilities of power and african lessons about the power of belief it's a childhood love story it's a new perspective on the evils of apartheid and the oppression that took its place and that still mars the beauty of a magnificent country it's a story of cultures and geopolitics it's the backstory about how a few courageous norwegians defeated nazi plans for a german atom bomb it's part the rant of a funny irreverent iconoclastic opinionated old curmudgeon perhaps occasionally thought provoking it's a window into the insights that wide travels and an open mind can bring it's also a story about family and the importance of real family values and of developing a sense of place in the world the book is interlaced with stories and anecdotes about the author's own forebears and pioneer ancestors and the roles they played in shaping the expansion and development of the american west it's a little known slice of texas history and of the founding of places like dallas and fort worth it's a story of lone star gypsies that will give you new perspectives on life and death how to live it to the fullest and maybe even how to avoid fearing the mysteries at the end of one's existence

Against the backdrop of the Civil War years, Christie works as a servant, actress, governess, companion, seamstress, and army nurse—all jobs that Alcott knew from personal experience, exposing the often insidious ways in which the employments conventionally available to women constrain their self-determination. Alcott's most overtly feminist novel work breaks new ground in the literary representation of women as its heroine pushes at the boundaries of nineteenth-century expectations and assumptions. The novel is supplemented here with all the usual Library of America features, plus a conversation with editor Susan Cheever and a reading group guide.

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
