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this work is a multi disciplinary collection of essays from leading researchers and practitioners exploring legal ethical social psychological and practical aspects of surrogate motherhood in britain and abroad

divided into 15 chapters this book provides the reader with an insight into certain representations of mothers and motherhood in history and today s societies in some areas of the world notably in britain and asia key facts about the history of motherhood are presented together with the use of very recent notions and phrases portraying good and bad mothers an analysis of the concepts of naming and blaming along with regret with respect to mothers in 21st century societies provides food for thought other issues addressed are varied and numerous the politics of early intervention feminist critique mothers with disabilities and mothers of disabled children incarcerated mothers surrogate mothers teenage mothers lesbian mothers and mothering in eastern asia namely in china japan and korea interestingly both visual arts and literature play a crucial role in this analysis the publication will appeal to students academics researchers and the general public interested in and seeking to comprehend the shifts that have occurred over time in connection with the vast and inexhaustible subject of motherhood and mothers a private and public matter readers are also provided with a rich reference section dealing with the latest publications on the issues tackled by prominent academics and researchers in human geography women s studies sociology gender studies contemporary history and the arts

the two phenomena highlighted in this edited volume motherhood mothering and masculinities are each recent areas of development in critical feminist and men's studies in contributing to these areas of gender studies this book draws attention to the fact that much can also be gained when we explore relationships between them an idea that may not readily come to mind while femininities and masculinities are co constructed motherhood and mothering bring additional perspectives to the study of femininity that affect the construction of masculinity in complex ways the 12 chapters in this volume allow readers to ponder some of these complexities and may suggest other issues that require investigation spanning many continents the essays have both a global and historical reach emphasising cultural differences and historical changes of import is the idea that mothers have agency and are active in constructions affecting their lives they are able to bring motherhood out of the shadows as they strive to build re evaluate or alter their roles within families and communities these have an impact on developments in masculinities the book is divided into three parts and the chapters investigate a wide range of issues including cultural constructs gender in parent child relationships non binary developments the impact of war on mothering decolonisation struggles and much more

the observation that *mater semper certa est* remains accurate under most legal systems in the world maternity is defined as the personal status filiation of a woman who gave birth to a child it is typically complemented by the fatherhood of the man from whom the child biologically originates often *quem nuptiae demonstrant* however in some states a kind of competitive way of acquiring the legal status of mother and father or homosexual parents a and b has been introduced via concluding a contract with a surrogate mother usually with a woman coming from poorer societies and with the assistance of professional intermediaries and organizers the postulates to change substantive family law or at least to recognize the effects of foreign law and procedures a kind of procreative tourism appear nowadays also in states generally prohibiting surrogate motherhood the issues discussed in this volume concern both national law and international court cases recent examples include the opinion of the european court of human rights of 10 april 2019 initiated by the french cour de cassation the judgement of the german bundesgerichtshof of 20 march 2019 and dilemmas of polish administrative courts focusing on the international perspective the present volume as well as an accompanying book in polish are the results of the international cooperation of over 30 experts from both member states and observer states of the council of europe the monograph is structured from the general to the detail and includes a comprehensive view as well from the issues of philosophy and sociology of law to human rights standards of national constitutions and international agreements to principles of *ordre public* of forum and their protection with measures of private public and penal law this allows readers including legislators and judges the better understanding of the fundamental legal problems that surrogate motherhood brings both in states where law creates them in a narrower or wider extent and in other countries of the world to which these problems can be imported with the movement of people and with *de lege lata* and *de lege ferenda* postulates

this expansive survey spotlights pervasive issues affecting girls and women's sexual and reproductive health across the lifecourse research from diverse countries around the world analyzes the complex relationships among biological psychological sociocultural and economic issues particularly in terms of inequities as they shape women's lives major challenges and possibilities for intervention are examined in their national context and with their global implications including child marriage motherhood reproductive care and access fertility childbearing contraception abortion hiv stis gender based violence sexual pleasure and menopause in

these forceful dispatches a consistent human rights perspective emphasizes women's control autonomy and agency in all stages of their lives a sampling of topics covered girl child marriage a persistent global women's health and human rights violation investigating challenges and resilience among women living with obstetric fistula in kenya a qualitative exploration of mainstream and social media reflections on abortion a continuum of severity of sexual intimate partner violence among black women in the united states economic empowerment to improve sexual and reproductive health among women and girls summarizing an interdisciplinary field on research and practical levels global perspectives on women's sexual and reproductive health across the lifecourse will be an invaluable text for undergraduate and graduate courses in a wide range of fields including public health global health women's studies sociology anthropology gender studies and human rights

traditional histories of war have typically explored masculine narratives of military and political action leaving private domestic life relatively unstudied this volume expands our understanding by looking at the relationships between mothers and children and the varied roles both have assumed during periods of armed conflict

motherhood and military are often viewed as dichotomous concepts with the former symbolizing feminine ideals and expectations and the latter suggesting masculine ideals and norms mothers military and society contributes to a growing body of research that disrupts this false dichotomy this interdisciplinary and international volume explores the many ways in which mothers and the military converse align contest and intersect in society through various chapters that include in depth case studies theoretical perspectives and personal narratives this book offers insights into the complex relationship between motherhood and the military in ways that will engage both academic and non academic readers alike

how we dispose of our rubbish choose the foods we buy enjoy art relate to our families and think about ourselves are just a few of the ways that ideas about nature shape our everyday ethical decisions nature and natural facts have long been used to make sense of why we act a certain way nature is a concept with great power when we describe something as natural or unnatural it has a moral force and political consequences we see this in moral panics about genetically modified foods the spread of government enforced waste recycling schemes concerns about assisted reproductive technologies our ideas about what is natural shape our ethical thinking in terms of how people live or want to live their lives but also in guiding our sense of morality justice and truth the idea of naturalness is essential to grasping anglo american cultures throughout history and in different places nature has had different forms meanings and moral valences it is a knowable fact but at the same time almost a divine principle that is ultimately unfathomable yet with the rise of new technologies there is increasing uncertainty about what we claim to be natural who we are how we are related to each other and how we should live this book examines the how ideas about nature and ethics overlap and separate across cultural species geographic and moral boundaries it compares the varied ways in which nature and ideas of naturalness pervade all aspects of people's lives from family relationships to the production and consumption of food to ideas about scientific truth in a world of increasing uncertainty nature remains a powerful concept the

ultimate reference point invested with profound moral authority to guide our ethical behaviour this book was originally published as a special issue of ethnos

the book takes a holistic approach to highlight and explore the range of issues specifically associated with mothering and imprisonment from sentencing through custody to resettlement and focusing on the perspective of mothers and their children

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
