this book is concerned with developments in three main areas of monetary history domestic commercial banking monetary policy and the uk s international financial position for ease of analysis the 160 years under study are arranged into three clear chronological divisions part 1 covers the years 1826 1913 a period in which the uk emerged as the world s leading economic power it was in these years that an extensive and fully operative domestic banking

system was established part 2 covers 1914 to 1939 the years which marked a break in the traditional monetary arrangements of the victorian and edwardian eras part 3 covers 1939 1986 when the dominance of state influence within the domestic money markets was re established by the second world war and the acceptance by the authorities of the obligation to manage the economy which meant that successive postwar governments took direct responsibility for the conduct of monetary and credit policy

this book tackles poverty and policy issues in the uk by discussing successful projects and practices across lots of short chapters the first section provides a brief history overview of poverty in the uk over the past two hundred years and discusses the question of why the uk as a wealthy western nation still has a poverty issue it discusses various vulnerable groups and contextual factors which lead to these inequalities the second section articulates what anti poverty work is and shares project examples from across the country where anti poverty workers are supporting people to survive and then to thrive lived experiences voices are articulated to present examples of poverty being experienced this book draws on academic and practitioner work and aims to equip the activist and inform the student academic and policy maker

the italian diaspora throughout the world navigate and negotiate various complex and multidirectional language dynamics in order to account for the sociolinguistic processes that have taken place this book provides a detailed observation of these linguistic dynamics from the point of view of the italian diaspora in bedford in the uk this study on the language behaviour of three generations of italian residents in bedford provides empirical data on and highlights the importance of the sociolinguistic examination of english in service encounters what comes to light in most of the cases analysed is that audience design has a proven influence on the choice of language and repertoire within the speech of the bedford italian community there are not only switches from one language to another but also style shifts in the linguistic repertoire throughout this study it becomes clear that speakers freely use the two languages available to their speech community and thanks to their active and passive repertoire they apply a range of linguistic resources from both italian and english the volume also uncovers some especially interesting traits in 3rd generation speech involving in particular a rather widespread use of mixed pronunciation upon moving past the initial assumption that the adoption of this mixed pronunciation is used to show the younger generation s sense of belonging to the bi community a quite different reason emerges closer analysis reveals that due to an increasing feeling of non britishness this linguistic choice may be linked to a deliberate and conscious attempt on their part not to accommodate to british culture and in so doing to distance themselves further from it

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this book shows how international trade was a key part of the classic western policy of containment towards the soviet union in the cold war in the late 1970s trade and containment may summarise the new relation that communist china moulded with the capitalistic west in the late 1970s ideology had become less important and a rapprochement between the prc people s republic of china and the western powers over trade with the purpose of isolating and weakening the common russian rival was practically unavoidable within a relatively short span of time the balance of power in the indo pacific area had been reversed simply put beijing s market was too big to be ignored and the atlantic allies collaborated sometimes even competing with each other to allow china access to the centres of world finance however the western powers had not realised that beijing would never pursue alignment with them on the contrary the increased trading and financial linkage with capitalistic countries gave china room to manoeuvre enabling it to play the western states off against each other this book will be of much interest to

the british economy after oil 1988 examines the future paths for the british economy as north sea oil runs out it considers the argument that the future lies in the promotion and growth of services as well as the counter argument that the future lies with the development of a strong manufacturing base for the economy

fifteen years ago the aids epidemic did not exist on the public agenda in just over a decade the public and official response to the disease has resulted in the development of a whole network of organizations devoted to the study containment and practical treatment of aids in this important and original analysis of aids policy virginia berridge examines the speed and nature of the official and unofficial response to this new and critical historical event the policy reaction in britain passed through three stages from 1981 1986 the outbreak of a new contagious disease led to public alarm and social stigmatization with a lack of scientific certainty about the nature of the disorder aids was

a new and open policy area there were no established departmental local or health authority mechanisms for dealing with the problem this was a period of policy development from below with relatively little official action and many voluntary initiatives behind the scenes this phase was succeeded in 1986 1987 by a brief stage of quasi wartime emergency in which national politicians and senior civil servants intervened and a high level political response emerged the response was a liberal one of safe sex and harm minimization rather than draconian notification or isolation of carriers the author demonstrates that despite the thatcher revolution in government in the 1980s crisis could still stimulate a consensual response the current period of normalization of the disease sees panic levels subsiding as the rate of growth slows and the fear of the unknown recedes official institutions have been established and formal procedures adopted and reviewed paid professionals have replaced the earlier volunteers the 1990s have seen change in the liberal consensus towards a harsher response and the partial repoliticization of aids in this fascinating and scholarly account virginia berridge analyses a remarkable period in contemporary british history and exposes the reaction of the british political and medical elites and of the british public to one of the most challenging issues of this century

the human geography of the uk is currently being reshaped by a number of forces such as globalisation transition in the organisations of production the changing character of state intervention and changing relationships with europe a consideration of the impacts of these forces on economic social and political landscapes is therefore an urgent task at the same time enduring institutional features of the british economy and polity are also having important influences on socio economic processes the result is a complex mosaic of uneven development which belies the notion of simplistic regional contrasts rather than simply mapping spatial inequality a united kingdom charts the processes underpinning uneven development at a range of scales and for a number of key topics the book draws upon and synthesises the latest contemporary research findings and places emphasis on the interrelated nature of economic social and political geographies it treats the human geographies of the uk in a coherent and integrated way and asks whether contemporary processes of change are tending towards the reduction of socio spatial divisions or their reproduction in new forms
