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alfred louis kroeber offers an all embracing account of human culture looking at its historical definitions many definitions and its role as a foundation for all of the social sciences a work striking for its thoroughness culture a critical review begins by examining the origins of the term culture and how it came to be associated with civilization and social change the appearance of the word in intellectual writings such as those of kant and hegel increased through the 19th century interpretations of the word as the later section on definitions shows persisted in varying widely with scholars differing in what they consider part of a given country s culture some constructed strict definitions involving things like a country s symbols morality festivals and
