

The Davis Family And The Leather Industry 1834 1934

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tampa s davis islands has long been among the most desirable places to live on florida s west coast built from mud dredged from the bottom of the tampa bay it s possible few thought the project would amount to very much with the exception of its creator david p davis the developer and tampa native davis purchased the dredged land in the 1920s during the florida land boom the gamble paid off in dividends as the davis islands made him wildly rich and nationally famous he

followed the islands up with a subdivision twice its size in St Augustine which he named Davis Shores Davis sold his Tampa development in August 1926 but he slipped into debt and died under mysterious circumstances while en route to Europe aboard a luxury liner only months later though their creator did not live to see it work on Davis Islands continued and the development ultimately became an unmitigated success join author Rodney Kite Powell as he examines the history of one of Florida's most famous neighborhoods

This book draws upon ethnographic and qualitative research in the United States to demonstrate the means through which long haul truck drivers navigate work and family tensions in ways that resonate across categories of race class gender and religion it examines how Christianity and constructions of masculinity are significant in the lives of long haul drivers and how truckers work to construct narratives of their lives as good moral individuals in contrast to competing cultural narratives which suggest images of romantic rule free renegade lives on the open road based upon ethnographic fieldwork interviews observations of long haul truckers and participation in a CDL school this rich ethnography highlights how Christian trucking opportunities provide avenues through which balance is struck between work and family masculinity and other identities embedded in larger social discourse about the meaning of masculinity and similar to evangelical perspectives such as those of the Promise Keepers Christian truckers often draw upon older ideas about responsible breadwinning fatherhood in their discourse about being good fathers while on the road this discourse is in some conflict with the lived experiences of Christian truckers who simultaneously find themselves confronted by more contemporary cultural narratives of the work family balance and expectations of what it means to be a good worker or a good trucker the book offers new insight in the field of work and family studies and an extremely relevant voice in the broader contemporary discourse in the United States on the meaning of fatherhood and religion in the 21st century

this is the annotated edition of novelist journalist Rebecca Harding Davis's 1904 autobiography bits of gossip and a previously unpublished family history written for her children the memoirs are not traditional autobiography rather they are Davis's perspective on the extraordinary cultural changes that occurred during her lifetime and of the remarkable and sometimes scandalous people who shaped the events she provides intimate portraits of the famous people she knew including Emerson Hawthorne Louisa May Alcott Ann Stephens Oliver Wendell Holmes and Horace Greeley equally important are Davis's commentaries on the political activists of the Civil War era from Abraham Lincoln to Booker T. Washington from the daughters of the Southland to Lucretia Mott from Henry Ward Beecher to William Still

connections quebec s eastern townships and the world examines the region s direct links to larger prevailing international forces and identities here the eastern townships take centre stage as the reader encounters the vibrancy of a place marked not by its insularity but by its long history a central meeting ground shaped by its many engagements with the world the book provides new perspectives on compelling and significant topics in townships history and culture including indigenous land use the mobility of peoples to and from the region linguistic diversity economic production education sport religion and culture in myriad forms these studies recast the eastern townships as a centre a borderland a lieu de passage between nations communities and peoples featuring original and compelling insights quebec s eastern townships and the world confirms that this beautiful region was and is a global place one intimately connected to the world

in the years leading up to the civil war southern evangelical denominations moved from the fringes to the mainstream of the american south scott stephan argues that female baptists methodists and presbyterians played a crucial role in this transformation while other scholars have pursued studies of southern evangelicalism in the context of churches meetinghouses and revivals stephan looks at the domestic rituals over which southern women had increasing authority from consecrating newborns to god s care to ushering dying kin through life s final stages laymen and clergymen alike celebrated the contributions of these pious women to the experience and expansion of evangelicalism across the south this acknowledged domestic authority allowed some women to take on more public roles in the conversion and education of southern youth within churches and academies although always in the name of family and always cloaked in the language of christian self abnegation at the same time however women s work in the name of domestic devotion often put them at odds with slaves children or husbands in their households who failed to meet their religious expectations and thereby jeopardized evangelical hopes of heavenly reunification of the family stephan uses the journals and correspondence of evangelical women from across the south to understand the interconnectedness of women s personal family and public piety rather than seeing evangelical women as entirely oppressed or resigned to the limits of their position in a patriarchal slave society stephan seeks to capture a sense of what agency was available to women through their moral authority

one of the most elegant mansions in florida goodwood was built over a century ago and stands today as one of tallahassee s grandest historical monuments it was once the center of a thriving plantation founded by the croom family of north carolina who in the 1820s sought to revive their fortunes in the newly opened florida territory william warren rogers and erica r clark tell the story of this family and their legacy shedding new light on many aspects of antebellum family life plantation management and race relations they describe how brothers hardy and bryan croom developed goodwood plantation to over four thousand acres with nearly two hundred slaves before hardy and his family were killed in a shipwreck and how a twenty year lawsuit complicated by questions of survivorship and residency denied bryan control of the estate this meticulously detailed account drawing extensively on family correspondence and court records is a story of humaneness hard work and family values but also of selfishness and greed that reveals an intriguing chapter of southern history

this is a study of the effectiveness of abraham lincoln and jefferson davis as commanders in chief during the civil war it begins by comparing their backgrounds prior to assuming the presidency then comparing their military strategies and command structures the final area of comparison is their involvement in the first military draft in american history davis had extensive government and military experience but exhibited personality traits early on that later hampered his performance as a war time commander in chief lincoln had very little experience but excelled at dealing with people lincoln tried several staff arrangements before finally appointing grant as general in chief davis changed his structure very little throughout the war although he appointed lee as general in chief in the first year he lost his services by placing him in command of a field army both faced strong challenges from a powerful governor over the draft davis first tried to win over the governor then appealed directly to the people lincoln publicly kept distant from the draft and worked behind the scenes

my practice life has spanned 36 years and during that time i have been involved in untangling countless mysterious maladies or at least trying to do so all of these efforts were without the benefit of any formal training about family systems i am greatly encouraged by this book because it first draws attention to the intricate web that mankind has woven for itself the family physician has often been caught up in this web and therefore rendered impotent efforts to understand all of this are to be applauded it has been my good fortune to know the editors leonard roberts and michael crouch and as a family physician i feel that their hearts are in the right place they have grown up medically speaking in an era when society has become more complex where life is not easy birth and its medical participants are suspect childhood is complicated by divorce and loneliness adolescence is a time of aimless searching young adults are hard pressed to earn a living the quality of life is being threatened somewhat by the overgrowth of high technology dying with dignity is at a premium the editors are to be commended for helping us clarify the role of the family physician in all of this

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
