communities that dot the coast of maine and the prized crustacean that has long  
provided their livelihood through forgotten wars and rebellions and with a deep  
tradition of resistance to interference by people from away maine s lobstermen  
have defended an earlier vision of america while defying the tragedy of the  
commons the notion that people always overexploit their shared property instead  
these icons of american individualism represent a rare example of true communal  
values and collaboration through grit courage and hard won wisdom
