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the new gypsy caravan book on how to build a travel trailer that is based on the design of a gypsy caravan the book includes measured drawings photographs and assembly instructions on how to build a caravan mountable to a conventional utility trailer and is capable of being towed by a small car the background and history of the gypsy caravan are also included

a formidable challenge to the study of roma gypsy music is the muddle of fact and fiction in determining identity this book investigates gypsy music as a marked and marketable exotic substance and as a site of active cultural negotiation and appropriation between the real roma and the idealized gypsies of the western imagination david malvinni studies specific composers including liszt brahms rachmaninov janacek and bartók whose work takes up contested and varied configurations of gypsy music the music of these composers is considered alongside contemporary debates over popular music and film as malvinni argues that gypsiness remains impervious to empirical revelations about the real roma

this long awaited book by beshlie her longest to date describes her itinerant life in waggons and trailers giving a first hand account of the life of the traveller and giving an insight into the romani culture the book is enriched by many of beshlie s own illustrations

gypsies have lived in england since the early sixteenth century yet considerable confusion and disagreement remain over the precise identity of the group the question who are the gypsies is still asked and the debates about the positioning and permanence of the boundary between gypsy and non gypsy are contested as fiercely today as at any time before this study locates these debates in their historical perspective tracing the origins and reproduction of the various ways of defining and representing the gypsy from the early sixteenth century to the present day starting with a consideration of the early modern description of gypsies as egyptians land pirates and vagabonds the volume goes on to examine the racial classification of the nineteenth century and the emergence of the ethnic gypsy in the twentieth century the book closes with an exploration of the

long lasting image of the group as vagrant and parasitic nuisances which spans the whole period from 1500 to 2000

this thirteenth edition has been completely revised to take into account all the changes that have occurred in british planning including the policies introduced by the labour government devolution innovations and the european union

now that the political and economic plight of european roma and the popularity of their music are objects of international attention romani routes provides a timely and insightful view into romani communities both in their home countries and in the diaspora over the past two decades a steady stream of recordings videos feature films festivals and concerts has presented the music of balkan gypsies or roma to western audiences who have greeted them with exceptional enthusiasm yet as author carol silverman notes roma are revered as musicians and reviled as people in this book silverman introduces readers to the people and cultures who produce this music offering a sensitive and incisive analysis of how romani musicians address the challenges of discrimination focusing on southeastern europe then moving to the diaspora her book examines the music within romani communities the lives and careers of outstanding musicians and the marketing of music in the electronic media and world music concert circuit silverman touches on the way that the roma exemplify many qualities adaptability cultural hybridity transnationalism that are taken to characterize late modern experience and rather than just celebrating these qualities she presents the musicians as complicated pragmatic individuals who work creatively within the many constraints that inform their lives

gypsies egyptians romanies and more recently travellers who are these marginal and mysterious people who first arrived in england in early tudor times are claims of their distant origins on the indian subcontinent true or just another of the many myths and stories that have accreted around them over time can they even be regarded as a single people or ethnicity at all gypsies have frequently been vilified and not much less frequently romanticized by the settled population over the centuries social historian david cressy now attempts to disentangle the myth from the reality of gypsy life over more than half a millennium of english history in this the first comprehensive historical study of the doings and dealings of gypsies in england he draws on original archival research and a wide range of reading to trace the many moments when gypsy lives became entangled with

those of villagers and townsfolk religious and secular authorities and social and moral reformers crucially it is a story not just of the gypsy community and its peculiarities but also of england s treatment of that community from draconian elizabethan statutes through various degrees of toleration and fascination right up to the tabloid newspaper campaigns against gypsy and traveller encampments of more recent years

the publication of the macpherson report on the stephen lawrence case shows that racism in the uk is still a major problem for many communities although often overlooked the prejudice and discrimination experienced by gypsies and travellers is in some ways worse because of its seeming acceptability they are stereotyped and denigrated find it increasingly difficult to pursue their traditional way of life suffer a lower life expectancy and higher infant mortality rate than that of settled people and have low rates of literacy

does geography affect our sense of self how are social characteristics mapped out on the ground and is there any authentic

sense of place now or are we increasingly placeless concentrating on the period between the end of the second world war and the end of the century this reader argues that there is a reciprocal relationship between the constitution of places and people what it means to be a man or a woman to have a nationality and a sense of place has been transformed and reinvented as our view of the world has changed the present is perceived as a time of fear a period in which all that is solid seems to melt into air while the 1950s are a site of nostalgia a period of clarity and certainty a time when people know their place bringing together an interdisciplinary collection of articles for social and cultural geographers this reader critically examines the argument that the close associations of the 1950s between place the home the community and the nation state and the social divisions gender class and nationality are breaking down in the 1990s drawing out the oppositional movements in each decade it seeks to show how the supposed stability of one and the mobility of the other are exaggerated

this literary analysis of the representation of gypsies in juvenile literature is unique in its comparative scope as well as in the special attention to rare pre 1850 narratives the period in which juvenile literature developed as a specific genre most studies on the subject are about one national literary tradition or confined to a limited period in this study dutch english french and german texts are analysed and discussed with reference to main academic publications on the subject emphasis is on the rich variation in narrative presentations rather than on an inventory of images or prejudices an important topic is the fundamental difference between early english and german narratives important because of the wide dissemination of german stories

how do marginalized communities speak back to power when they are excluded from political processes and socially denigrated in what ways do they use music to sound out their unique histories and empower themselves how can we hear their voices behind stereotyped and exaggerated portrayals promoted by mainstream communities record producers and government officials sounding roman music and performing identity in western turkey explores these questions through a historically grounded and ethnographic study of turkish roman gypsies from the ottoman period up to the present drawing on extensive

ethnographic fieldwork 1995 to the present collected oral histories historical documents of popular culture recordings images song texts theatrical scripts legal and administrative documents this book takes a hard look at historical processes by which roman are stereotyped as and denigrated as ingene a derogatory group name equivalent to the english term gypsy and explores creative musical ways by which roman have forged new musical forms as a means to create and assert new social identities sounding roman presents detailed musical analysis of turkish roman musical genres and styles set within social historical and political contexts of musical performances by moving from byzantine and ottoman social contexts we witness the reciprocal construction of ethnic identity of both roman and turk through music in the 20th century from neighborhood weddings held in the streets informal music lessons to recording studios and concert stages the book traces the dynamic negotiation of social identity with new musical sounds through a detailed ethnography of turkish roman gypsy musical practices from the ottoman period to the present this work investigates the power of music to configure new social identities and pathways for political action while testing the limits of cultural representation to effect meaningful social change

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
