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what is the optimal political framework for environmental reform reform on a scale commensurate with the global ecological crisis how adequate are liberal forms of parliamentary democracy to face the challenges posed these are the questions pondered by the contributors to this volume

presenting cutting edge observations this research handbook tackles the intersecting crises of biodiversity loss and climate change from a legal perspective experts critically analyse international laws and institutions protecting biodiversity highlighting key areas of development conflict and opportunity

following the profile of recent issues of the yearbook volume 13 2009 of redescriptions focuses on contemporary debates around the concept of democracy several articles by scholars from different fields political theory philosophy history rhetoric women s studies law discuss the present state and future prospects of democracy its relationship to other concepts deliberation rhetoric parliament majority vs minority as well as its in compatibility with the power of the courts and the expertise in this volume examples of conceptual histories are provided by articles on women s suffrage and friendship

contemporary public policy challenges are increasingly called wicked problems or problems that cannot be solved by one sector or one agency of government alone solutions to wicked problems often further require the recognition and acceptance of tradeoffs or drawbacks which might include a cost or sacrifice for the whole of society or a subsection of society based on the premise that government of by and for the people is not sufficient to rise to and meet wicked public policy problems this volume provides strategies and ideas for public administration educators across diverse environments as well as undergraduate and graduate education to include and integrate the principles of with the people in public administration education and practice this book explores the ways that notions of governing with citizens can be integrated into courses that focus on public administration and policy it invites instructors to think about what it means to be educators within higher education institutions in a democratic society championing deliberation and engagement as a way to prepare students for professional roles in their communities each chapter is written by a contributor who has road tested the inclusion of democratic ideals and principles in their own classrooms and each chapter therefore provides blueprints

curriculum plans and lesson plans for the integration of democratic principles in public administration education and practice teaching democratic ideals to public affairs students is essential reading for faculty in public administration public policy and political science departments and it will also be a useful guidebook for practicing public administrators as well as those who provide training to practicing administrators and leaders

representative democracy is in crisis one remedy is to foster citizen participation beyond elections this has led to the development of democratic innovations such as participatory budgeting and citizens assemblies through which lay citizens can discuss political problems and make meaningful contributions democratic innovations critics argue that they fail to truly empower citizens that they impede democratic representation and efficient government advocates assert that democratic innovations make political systems more inclusive and democratic do these institutions matter for policy making do they affect the broader public what do political leaders do with their recommendations how can we scrutinise democratic innovations impacts do they truly transform representation this book brings together scholars from a range of disciplines to offer innovative ideas to develop research improve our knowledge of the impacts of democratic innovations and help us respond more effectively to contemporary democratic challenges

problems of institutional design and redesign structuring and restructuring acquired particular poignancy through recent developments from eastern europe to southern africa at the same time scholars in each of several disciplines political science economics sociology history and philosophy have increasingly come to appreciate the important independent role that is and should be played by institutional factors in social life in this volume disparate theories of institutional design given by each of those several disciplines are synthesized and their peculiar power illustrated through analysis of examples ranging from changes in the british welfare state through the transition of eastern european societies to the reward structure of the modern university the contributors emphasize the important interpenetration of normative and empirical issues in theories of institutional design

since the late 1980s ecological thought and the european eco movement have gone through a phase of fundamental transformation which has been widely acknowledged but not yet theorised in any satisfactory way this important text questions why radical ecological criticism has had so little impact on contemporary society despite the

urgency of the issues it highlights the book offers a challenging theoretical critique of ecological thought itself

in this book robert brulle draws on a broad range of empirical and theoretical research to investigate the effectiveness of u s environmental groups brulle shows how critical theory in particular the work of jürgen habermas can expand our understanding of the social causes of environmental degradation and the political actions necessary to deal with it he then develops both a pragmatic and a moral argument for broad based democratization of society as a prerequisite to the achievement of ecological sustainability from the perspectives of frame analysis resource mobilization and historical sociology using data on more than one hundred environmental groups brulle examines the core beliefs structures funding and political practices of a wide variety of environmental organizations he identifies the social processes that foster the development of a democratic environmental movement and those that hinder it he concludes with suggestions for how environmental groups can make their organizational practices more democratic and politically effective

what would constitute a definitively green state in this important new book robyn eckersley explores what it might take to create a green democratic state as an alternative to the classical liberal democratic state the indiscriminate growth dependent welfare state and the neoliberal market focused state seeking she writes to navigate between undisciplined political imagination and pessimistic resignation to the status quo in recent years most environmental scholars and environmentalists have characterized the sovereign state as ineffectual and have criticized nations for perpetuating ecological destruction going consciously against the grain of much current thinking this book argues that the state is still the preeminent political institution for addressing environmental problems states remain the gatekeepers of the global order and greening the state is a necessary step eckersley argues toward greening domestic and international policy and law the green state seeks to connect the moral and practical concerns of

the environmental movement with contemporary theories about the state democracy and justice eckersley's proposed critical political ecology expands the boundaries of the moral community to include the natural environment in which the human community is embedded this is the first book to make the vision of a good green state explicit to explore the obstacles to its achievement and to suggest practical constitutional and multilateral arrangements that could help transform the liberal democratic state into a postliberal green democratic state rethinking the state in light of the principles of ecological democracy ultimately casts it in a new role that of an ecological steward and facilitator of transboundary democracy rather than a selfish actor jealously protecting its territory

an analysis of the normative prerequisites for addressing the challenges of democratic earth system governance in the anthropocene

in this global approach to climate change and freshwater access cameron fioret explores the harmful effects of water commodification making use of deliberative democratic theory fioret suggests tools that can change the balance of democratic decision making power by rethinking the governance of water more broadly five main case studies including detroit cochabamba and kerala span four continents to convey the global and local scope of normative water issues these examples draw on contemporary water justice movements to explore how anti water commodification struggles can utilize water recommoning practices to make water governance processes more deeply democratic highlighting the ethical and sociopolitical ramifications of water injustice this study moves beyond the surface issue of distributional concerns to this end fioret draws on research in democratic political theory and environmental philosophy to consider what right people have to water the putative harms of privatizing and commodifying water common ownership and legal protections alongside local and transnational political activism in navigating these pressing issues the ethics of water provides a searing analysis of water commodification and political domination today

a bold argument that constitutional states are not weaker because their powers are divided they are often stronger because they solve collective action problems rooted in speech and communication

deliberative democracy has challenged two widely accepted nostrums about democratic politics that people lack the capacities for effective self government and that democratic procedures are arbitrary and do not reflect popular will indeed that the idea of popular will is itself illusory on the contrary deliberative democrats have shown that people are capable of being sophisticated creative problem solvers given the right opportunities in the right kinds of democratic institutions but deliberative empirical research has its own problems in this book two leading deliberative scholars review decades of that research and reveal three important issues first the concept deliberation has been inflated so much as to lose empirical bite second deliberation has been equated with entire processes of which it is just one feature and third such processes are confused with democracy in a deliberative mode more generally in other words studies frequently apply micro level tools and concepts to make macro and meso level judgements and vice versa instead bächtiger and parkinson argue that deliberation must be understood as contingent performative and distributed they argue that deliberation needs to be disentangled from other communicative modes that appropriate tools need to be deployed at the right level of analysis and that scholars need to be clear about whether they are making additive judgements or summative ones they then apply that understanding to set out a new agenda and new empirical tools for deliberative empirical scholarship at the micro meso and macro levels

this theoretical and practical book builds on the knowledge that sustainability s value pluralism cannot be reconciled with the value monism of classical neoclassical nationalist or socialist political economy developing the concept of sustainability value sv which requires integrating economic exchange social labour environmental intrinsic and cultural use values in all processes of extraction manufacturing trade consumption and disposal the book reformulates our understanding of key political economy topics such as trade investment preference formation corporate governance and the role of the state the book illustrates how sv is being realised via multi stakeholder networks which forming at the community national and global levels enable the required cross value deliberation
