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the nation state of israel is a short and concise overview of israel that includes its patriarchal history since abraham its geography and environment its economy culture and demographics its government and legal system zionism and the holocaust its conflicts and peace since 1948

a collection of articles about israel s right of establishment as a jewish homeland and as an independent country

for the last two centuries the nation state has posed a formidable challenge to multinational empires it has served as a base for modernisation secularisation and democratisation and also for the formation of totalitarian regimes today the nation state faces challenges from multiple directions national minorities demand self determination while religious forces challenge secular governments and global migration movements undermine the cultural uniformity once considered essential for the formation and preservation of nation states this is the third of a three volume set detailed below which addresses key challenges facing the contemporary nation state from a global perspective but with special emphasis on the middle east and israel publication reflects research conducted under the auspices of the israel democracy

institute's nation state project which analyses israel's complex reality in which a jewish majority contends with an arab minority ultra orthodox religious forces reject the authority of the nation state and an immigrant society exhibits substantial cultural and ethnic variance volume iii explores the cultural social and political effects of immigration on the contemporary nation state its character cohesion and possible future as well as on contemporary liberal democracy contributions deal with such issues as different liberal approaches to the issue of immigration and immigrant integration nation building narratives and their implications for immigrants and minorities citizenship tests and integration policy in the united states and in europe as well as israel's law of return and the debate about it and other aspects of immigration policy

a revisionist account of zionist history challenging the inevitability of a one state solution from a bold path breaking young scholar the jewish nation state has often been thought of as zionism's end goal in this bracing history of the idea of the jewish state in modern zionism from its beginnings in the late nineteenth century until the establishment of the state of israel dmitry shumsky challenges this deeply rooted assumption in doing so he complicates the narrative of the zionist quest for full sovereignty provocatively showing how and why the leaders of the prestate zionist movement imagined articulated and promoted theories of self determination in palestine either as part of a multinational ottoman state 1882 1917 or in the framework of multinational democracy in particular shumsky focuses on the writings and policies of five key zionist leaders from the habsburg and russian empires in central and eastern europe in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries leon pinsker theodor herzl ahad ha am vladimir ze ev jabotinsky and david ben gurion to offer a very pointed critique of zionist historiography

the history of partition in the twentieth century is one steeped in controversy and violence literature partition and the nation state offers an extended study of the social and cultural legacies of state division in ireland and palestine two regions where the trauma of partition continues to shape political events to this day focusing on the period since the 1960s when the original partition settlements in each region were challenged by irish and palestinian nationalists joe cleary's book contains individual chapters on nationalism and self determination on the construction of national literatures in the wake of state division and on influential irish israeli and palestinian writers film makers and public intellectuals cleary's book is a radical and enthralling intervention into contemporary scholarship from a range of disciplines on nations and nationalism it will be of interest to scholars in cultural and post colonial studies nations and nationalism irish literature middle east studies and modern history

this edited book examines the growing worldwide phenomenon of civilizational populism in democratic nation states and brings together research that explores this in a wide variety of religious political and geographic contexts in doing so the book shows how from europe to india and pakistan and from indonesia to the americas populists increasingly define national belonging through civilizational identity claiming that the world can be divided into several religion defined civilizations with incompatible values the volume also discusses the complex relationship between civilizational populism democracy and nationalism and shows how nationalists often use civilizational identity to help define ingroups and outgroups within their society with this the book investigates the salience of the concept its widespread and

influential nature and also explains how populists construct civilizational identities and the factors behind the rise of civilizational populism

the book analyses the development of israel's national identity through the world of local jewish zionist historiography inspired by norbert elias historical and figurational sociology the book examines the different phases and generations in israel in light of the collective habitus and the nation state survival unit set by zionism it does so by putting in relation the intellectual profession of history writing and the processes of state and identity building it processually pursues the autonomization of the historiographical field in israel from its socio genesis in pre state israel to recent decades by combining together well established literature on the relations between nationalism and statehood and on the particularity of the israeli case the book updates the state of the art and opens new debates on jewish israeli exceptionalism while shedding light on continuity and change in israeli statehood vis à vis the supposed uniqueness of jewish history as reinterpreted and codified by zionism as it examines the interconnections between local intelligentsia and politics the enquiry avails of the sociological concepts of generation habitus survival unit field according to the long period tradition of research in pierre bourdieu norbert elias max weber and more this rich sociological conceptualization permits to mirror and contextualize israel's national identity with both intellectual and sociopolitical emphases by situating israeli historians and their profession on the dynamic crossroads and intersections of academia politics and greater society the study delineates the deep meaning of israeliness

national security has been at the forefront of the israeli experience for seven decades with threats ranging from terrorism to vast rocket and missile arsenals and even existential nuclear dangers yet despite its overwhelming preoccupation with foreign and defense affairs israel does not have a formal national security strategy in israeli national security chuck freilich presents an authoritative analysis of the military diplomatic demographic and societal challenges israel faces today to propose a comprehensive and long term israeli national security strategy the heart of the new strategy places greater emphasis on restraint defense and diplomacy as means of addressing the challenges israel faces along with the military capacity to deter and if necessary defeat israel's adversaries while also maintaining the resolve of its society by bringing israel's most critical debates about the palestinians demography iran hezbollah hamas us relations and nuclear strategy into sharp focus the strategy freilich proposes addresses the primary challenges israel must address in order to chart its national course the most comprehensive study of israel's national security to date this book presents the first public proposal for a comprehensive israeli national security strategy and prescribes an actionable course forward

can israel be both jewish and truly democratic how can a nation state which incorporates a large national minority with a distinct identity of its own be a state of all its citizens written by two eminent israeli scholars a professor of constitutional law and a historian alexander yakobson and amnon rubinstein are the first to treat zionism and israeli experience in light of other states experiences and in particular of newly established states that have undergone constitutional changes and wrestled with issues of minorities citing various european constitutions and laws the authors explore concept of a jewish state and its various meanings in the light of international law and the current norms of human rights as applied to other democratic societies compatible with liberal democratic norms and conclude that international

reality does not accord with the concept which regards a modern liberal democracy as a culturally neutral and a nationally colourless entity in light of the new political map in israel and the prospect of future disengagement from the west bank israel and the family of nations is essential reading for all those who wish to understand israel s future challenges

this work treats the european political philosophy that has engendered the nation state concept considered to be the logical evolution of human history as a linear periodization into the modern state this modern state concept is treated as the end of history in liberal democratic theory in spite of it remaining a european phenomenon where it has been imposed beyond the european political culture it has provoked a plague of civil wars and occupations such as in palestine in europe itself it has also resulted in such features as the spanish inquisition the latter day spanish civil war and the fascist dictatorship that followed as well as the nazi regime and its holocaust in alliance with the various fascist allies seeking their own nation state various attempts have followed in europe itself to overcome the nation state itself by means of the european union which sought to unite the nation states with a federated effort to bring some stability to the economy and life of the region in light of the disastrous wars of the twentieth century the contradictions of the nation state and federalism become ever more apparent as the eu now descends into economic chaos this sub title invites a comparison and a contrast between the jewish political culture and the Zionist movement one may consider political culture as encompassing civil society history religious theology and law comprising a collective consciousness this historical heritage forms a national identity which is currently oriented into nationalism by the state the endurance of national identity apart from the state and with the extinction of the state is projected as the basis of an independent civil society

the state of israel is an unlikely powerhouse in a troubled region since 1948 israel has retained its status as a democratic state without interruption an investor friendly environment and skilled workforce have led to a thriving economy whilst the israel defense forces are one of the most powerful armed forces in the world yet israel is also blighted by a plethora of

for more than forty years yitzhak rabin played a critical role in shaping israeli national security policy and military doctrine he began as a soldier in the palmach the elite underground unit of the jewish community in palestine served in the 1948 war of independence and ultimately became chief of staff of the israel defense force idf defense minister in several governments ambassador to the united states and twice prime minister as chief of staff rabin led the idf to its triumph in the 1967 six day war he was assassinated in 1995 as prime minister as he left a peace rally drawing on unpublished materials and interviews with important sources including rabin himself efraim inbar s work offers a systematic study of rabin s strategic thinking and his policies topics include the evolution of rabin s thinking his contributions to idf military buildup his stress on israel s relationship to the united states his attitudes toward the use of force and his approach to israel s nuclear status in the middle east inbar s conclusion evaluates rabin s contribution to israel s national security and assesses rabin s personal transition from warrior to peace maker because of rabin s crucial role in israel s defense establishment at important junctures in its history this book provides an important view into the security challenges israel has faced and how the country has responded over four decades

since the founding of the zionist movement until today the question of the relationship between church and state in israel remains unresolved resulting in a continuous legal and social conflict among israelis the tension that arises from judaism acting not only as a religion and culture but also as a national entity constitutionally underpinning an entire state resulting in the jewish and democratic state of israel manifests in major aspects of daily life for israelis such as marriage and divorce conversion and shabbat this book presents a crucial piece of scholarship in understanding the history and current dynamics of the relation between state and religion in israel and in doing so provides a unique perspective on the future potential solutions to this social rift

in the domain of comparative constitutionalism israeli constitutional law is a fascinating case study constituted of many dilemmas it is moving from the old british tradition of an unwritten constitution and no judicial review of legislation to fully fledged constitutionalism endorsing judicial review and based on the text of a series of basic laws at the same time it is struggling with major questions of identity in the context of israel s constitutional vision of a jewish and democratic state israeli constitutional law in the making offers a comprehensive study of israeli constitutional law in a systematic manner that moves from constitution making to specific areas of contestation including state religion relations national security social rights as well as structural questions of judicial review it features contributions by leading scholars of israeli constitutional law with comparative comments by leading scholars of constitutional law from europe and the united states

defining israel the jewish state democracy and the law is the first book in any language devoted to the controversial passage of israel s nation state law israel has no constitution and though it calls itself the jewish state there is no agreement among israelis on how that fact should be reflected in the government s laws or by its courts since the 1990s a number of civil society groups and legislators have drafted constitutions and proposed basic laws with constitutional standing that would clarify what it means for israel to be a jewish and democratic state are these bills liberal or chauvinist are they a defense of the knesset or an attack on the independence of the courts is their intention democratic or anti democratic the fight over the nation state law whether to have one and what should be in it toppled the 19th knesset s governing coalition and even after its passage on july 29 2018 remains a point of contention among israel s lawmakers and increasingly the israeli public defining israel brings together influential scholars journalists and politicians observers and participants opponents and proponents jews and arabs all debating the merits and meaning of israel s nation state law together with translations of each draft law the final law and other key documents the essays and sources in defining israel are essential to understand the ongoing debate over what it means for israel to be a jewish and democratic state

is there an israeli nation how is it related to the historical jewish people how is it related to the zionist movement under what conditions could non jews become equal members of this nation these and other questions stand at the center of the moshe berent s a nation like all nations towards the establishment of an israeli republic the mission of the zionist movement was to work toward the normalization of jewish existence to become a nation like all nations israel contrary to that aspiration is not a normal nation state since according to the formal national ethos it belongs to the jewish people and there is no recognized israeli nation dr berent asserts that the fusion of nationality and religion together with the absence of a normal nation state are the source of israel s basic problems and are responsible for israel s powerlessness to solve problems i e the status of religion in public life the relations between seculars and religious the status of non jews especially arabs the absence of a constitution the inability to agree about borders or to decide about peace and war a nation like all nations towards the establishment of an israeli republic makes the case that a separation between

nationality and religion the recognition in the existence of an israeli nation and the establishment of israel as a republic as the state of the israeli nation is a pre condition for finding the solution of all of these problems

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
