by means of careful analysis of relevant writings by hobbes rousseau kant hegel and marx david james argues that the concept of practical necessity is key to understanding the nature and extent of human freedom practical necessity means being or believing oneself to be constrained to perform certain actions in the absence whether real or imagined of other more attractive options or by the high costs involved in pursuing other options agents become subject to practical necessity as a result of economic social and historical forces over which they have or appear to have no effective control and the extent to which they are subject to it varies according to the amount of economic and social power that one agent possesses relative to other agents the concept of practical necessity is also shown to take into account how the beliefs and attitudes of social agents are in large part determined by social and historical processes in which they are caught up and that the type of motivation that we attribute to agents must recognize this practical necessity freedom and history from hobbes to marx shows how rousseau kant hegel and marx in contrast to hobbes explain the emergence of the conditions of a free society in terms of a historical process that is initially governed by practical necessity the role that this form of necessity plays in explaining history necessity invites the following question to what extent are historical agents genuinely subject to both practical and historical necessity

this volume explores the development of post kantian practical philosophy through the themes of freedom right and revolution

albert schweitzer philosopher physician nobel peace laureate theologian and musician developed a character oriented ethics focused on self realization nature centered spirituality and moral idealism which anticipated the current renaissance of virtue ethics schweitzer s idea of reverence for life underscores the contribution of moral ideals to self realization connects ethics to spirituality without religious dogma and outlines a pioneering environmental ethics that bridges the gap between valuing life in its unity and valuing individual organisms in this book mike w martin interprets schweitzer s reverence for life as an umbrella virtue drawing together all the more specific virtues in particular authenticity love compassion gratitude justice and peace loving each of which martin discusses in an individual chapter martin s treatment of his subject is sympathetic yet critical and for the first time clearly places schweitzer s environmental ethics within the wider framework of his ethical theory

this is a critical history of analytic philosophy from its inception in the late 19th century to the present day the book focuses on the connections between the four

leading movements in the field logical realism logical positivism ordinary language analysis and linguistic essentialism

as threats of infectious disease grow and the nation confronts chronic health problems such as diabetes and obesity health professionals citizens and community stakeholders must address increasingly complex ethical conflicts about public health policies and practices essentials of public health ethics introduces students to the field of public health ethics by focusing on cases topics span the discipline of public health and integrate materials concepts and frameworks from numerous fields in public health such as health promotion environmental health and health policy by delving into both historical and contemporary cases including international cases the authors investigate the evolution and impact of various understandings of the concept of the public over time i e the public not only as a numerical population that can be defined and measured but also as a political group with legally defined obligations and relationships as well as diverse cultural and moral understandings while the text examines a range of philosophical theories and contemporary perspectives it is written in a way that presupposes no previous exposure to the philosophical concepts but at the same time provides challenging cases for students who do have more advanced knowledge thus the book should be useful in schools and programs in public health as well as for undergraduate public health courses in liberal arts institutions and for health sciences students at the advanced undergraduate and graduate levels

this work defends an interrelated set of theses in value theory normative ethics and meta ethics the three parts correspond to these three areas part one value defends a biocentric theory of moral standing and then the coherence and objectivity of belief in intrinsic value despite recent objections intrinsic value is located in the flourishing of living creatures specifically a neo aristotelian species relative account is supplied of wellbeing or flourishing in terms of the development of the essential capacities of one s species there follows a theory of priorities or of relative intrinsic value in which the satisfaction of basic needs takes priority over other needs and over wants and the interests of complex and sophisticated creatures over those of others where they are at stake part two defends a practice consequentialist theory of the criteria of rightness and of obligation which leaves room for supererogation underpins our intuitions about justice commends population growth only where it is genuinely desirable and responds better than act consequentialism to objections like that concerned with the separateness of persons part three sifts meta ethical theories rejects moral relativism and defends a cognitivist and naturalist meta ethic

in defending analytical naturalism it takes into account the latest literature on supervenience by responding to recent discussions this study supersedes my theory of value and obligation 1987 it is equipped with detailed end notes and an ample bibliography which could prove a research tool of itself
