an account of the history structure and operation of the first and second banks of the united states this study examines how the banks performed as national and central institutions and what happened to the economy when the charter of the second bank was allowed to expire in 1836 historians have paid little recent attention to the early history of central banking in the united states and many americans believe that the federal reserve created in 1913 was our first central bank the economic crisis during the

american revolution actually led to the founding of a national bank called the bank of north america during the period of confederation although it became a private bank before the constitution was ratified in 1788 it proved to be such a success that in 1791 alexander hamilton the first secretary of the treasury was able to convince president washington that a similar bank should be established while the first bank of the united states performed well during its tenure its charter was allowed to lapse in 1811 a second bank of the united states was created five years later in 1816 and it prospered under the leadership of its third president nicholas biddle from 1823 to 1830 when central banking was practiced this success ended with the 1828 election of andrew jackson who refused to recharter the bank and withdrew the government's funds in 1833 severely weakened the bank continued but its charter finally expired in 1836 much to biddle's dismay

this biography of a bank is largely a narrative that lauds the founder of the bank a p giannini and his son for their ability to expand the bank and its assets from its origins within the bank of italy in 1906 to the early 1950s this reprint contains no additional material the 1954 copyright

the bank for international settlements bis founded in 1930 works as the bank for central banks the bis is an international forum where central bankers and officials gather to cope with international financial issues and a bank which invests the funds of the member countries this book is a historical study on the bis from its foundation to the 1970s using archival sources of the bank and financial institutions of the member countries this book aims to clarify how the bis faced the challenges of contemporary international financial system the book deals with following subjects why and how the bis has been founded how did the bis cope with the great depression in the 1930s was the bis responsible for the looted gold incident during wwii after the dissolution sentence at the bretton woods conference in 1944 how did the bis survive how did the bis act during the dollar crisis in the 1960s and the 1970s a thorough analysis of the balance sheets supports the archival investigation on the above issues the bis has been and is still an institution which proposes an alternative views crisis manager under the great depression of the 1930s peace feeler during the wwii market friendly bank in the golden age of the keynesian interventionism and crisis fighter during the recent world financial turmoil harmonizing the methodology of economic history international finances and history of economic thoughts the book traces the past events to the current world economy under financial crisis
