clarke garrett examines the differing responses of catholics and protestants and the resulting disturbances roderick phillips describes the

wide variation in provincial response to the revolutionary assembly's family reform measures he traces the different reactions of urban and rural residents to such legal measures as liberalization of divorces secularization of birth death and marriage registrations and inheritance reform peasants in central france were already engaged in total revolution when joseph fouché arrived there in late 1793 nancy fitch argues that fouché was formed by his encounter with indigenous peasant radicalism as much as the peasants were influenced by his rhetoric of a new political culture donald sutherland summarizing scholarly debate on the subject argues that in the final analysis the revolution itself was tragically and profoundly alien to many french men and women in 1789

this volume has three main themes first there is the concept of the industrial revolution and its main characteristics and the author defends both the term and the notions behind it against attempts to play down their significance a particular interest is the comparison of what happened to britain with similar processes in other european countries the second theme is the set of problems facing the early entrepreneurs and managers their difficulties as pioneers in the economic as well as the social sphere are often underrated and are here explored in detail last there is an emphasis on the characteristic feature of industrialisation as a regional phenomenon and on the significance of particular regions in the entire process all three themes have called forth extended debate in which these essays have played an important part

over his distinguished career as a european intellectual historian and cultural critic martin jay has explored a variety of major themes the frankfurt school the exile of german intellectuals in america during the nazi era western marxism the denigration of vision in twentieth century french thought the discourse of experience in modern europe and america and lying in politics essays from the edge assembles jay's writings from the intersections of this intellectual journey several essays focus on methodological debates in the humanities and social sciences the limits of interdisciplinarity the issue of national or universal philosophy cultural relativism and visuality and the implications of periodization in historical narrative others examine the concept of scopie regime and the metaphors of revolution and the gardening impulse among the theorists treated at length are theodor adorno hannah arendt jacques derrida and michel foucault the essays also include several of jay's salmagundi columns dealing with subjects as varied as the new museum of modern art in new york the impact of colin wilson's *The Outsider* and the demise of the partisan review all of these efforts can be considered what arthur schopenhauer called to borrow the title of one of his most celebrated collections *Parerga and Paralipomena* as essays from the edges of major projects they illuminate jay's major arguments elaborate points made only in passing in the larger texts and explore ideas farther than would have been possible given the focus of the larger works themselves the result is a lively diverse offering from an extraordinary intellect

discussing race ethnicity and statism as challenging issues that need to be confronted in any current discussion of women s revolutionary experiences

shapin claims that there was no such thing as the scientific revolution neither as a coherent chronological event nor as a movement in science instead he writes about how reformed practices of making the same observations led to the creation of new ideas

in this second edition jonathan sperber has updated and expanded his study of the european revolutions that brought millions of people across the european continent into political life between 1848 1851 the book offers an inclusive narrative of the revolutionary events and a structural analysis of the reasons for the revolutions ultimate failure a wide reaching conclusion and a detailed bibliography make the book ideal both for classroom use and for a general reader wishing a better knowledge of this major historical event
