the topic of loving relationships is one of the most important and often problematic areas of people s lives unfortunately such importance is best perceived when relationships are unsatisfactory and or threatened by the possibility of an imminent breakup when that happens our mood our ability to concentrate our energy our work and our health among other dimensions of our lives can be profoundly affected although contemporary love life appears to be markedly different from that of predecessor generations given the wide range of current relationships as the hook up living together separate cohabitation virtual love or even betrayal among many other forms of loving interaction we live in a time when relationships between two or more people it seems need more understanding and more accurate research however studying love scientifically is a hard task because of methodological difficulties and conceptual improprieties intrinsically related to this type of investigation because it can be considered such a familiar concept many researchers should agree on what love is and how it can be measured but this is not what occurs after all what is love is it as a psychological phenomenon capable of being scientifically studied by psychology the goal of this research topic is to promote and disseminate publications related to what is conceived scientifically as the psychology of love differing from conceptions related to self help and common sense conceptualize love through psychological science systematize knowledge about the nature of love and related phenomena such as jealousy shyness inhibition infidelity and other related topics understand conceptualizations of love and relationship dynamics of people in monogamous and consensually non monogamous relationships research the establishment and maintenance of romantic relationships and try to understand scientifically the role of love in marital satisfaction
