focusing on the asia pacific region which in recent years has been the engine of global economic growth this volume surveys trends and prospects in technical and vocational education and training tvet with particular reference to achieving inclusive growth and the greening of economies underlying the increasing pressure for new models of tvet provision is the rapid pace of technological change demand for a work force which is highly responsive to evolving needs and a transforming market place that calls for higher order skills and lifelong learning the book proposes a re engineered modernized tvet system that fosters an innovative approach which enhances the employability of workers as well as the sustainability of their livelihoods the book includes contributions from leading policy makers researchers and practitioners including those in the private sector in analyzing and forecasting the most urgent priorities in skills development the book argues for creative approaches to tvet design and delivery particularly with a view to improve job prospects and meeting the goals of inclusion sustainable development and social cohesion addressing issues such as the chronic mismatches between skills acquired and actual skills required in the work place the volume proposes diversified approaches towards workforce development and partnerships with the private sector to improve the quality and relevance of skills development the new imperatives created by greening economies and responses required in skills development and training are addressed developing tvet is a high priority for governments in the asia pacific region as they seek to achieve long term sustainable growth since the continued success of their economic destinies depend on it the volume also includes an emerging framework for skills development for inclusive and sustainable growth in the asia and pacific region

pacific encounters brings together for the first time many stunning polynesian objects collected by voyagers and missionaries during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries illustrated are over 270 items gathered from the major regions of polynesia many are from the british museum which houses fine and rare material from the expeditions of captain cook captain vancouver and members of the london missionary society ranging from massive images of gods

to small fish hooks they are discussed in the contexts of their local use and meanings and their journeys to museums all over the world these pieces have remarkable stories to tell of encounters between humans and their gods between polynesians and europeans their respective chiefs and priests beliefs and technologies pacific encounters is a groundbreaking book that conveys the wonder and excitement not only of the objects themselves but of the fascinating polynesian cultures that produced them

how when and why has the pacific been a locus for imagining different futures by those living there as well as passing through what does that tell us about the distinctiveness or otherwise of this sea of islands foregrounding the work of leading and emerging scholars of oceania pacific futures brings together a diverse set of approaches to and examples of how futures are being conceived in the region and have been imagined in the past individual chapters engage the various and sometimes contested futures yearned for unrealized and even lost or forgotten that are particular to the pacific as a region ocean island network destination and home contributors recuperate the futures hoped for and dreamed up by a vast array of islanders and outlanders from indigenous federalists to lutheran improvers to cantonese small business owners making these histories of the future visible in so doing the collection intervenes in debates about globalization in the pacific and how the region is acted on by outside forces and postcolonial debates that emphasize the agency and resistance of pacific peoples in the context of centuries of colonial endeavor with a view to the effects of the slow violence of climate change the volume also challenges scholars to think about the conditions of possibility for future thinking at all in the midst of a global crisis that promises cataclysmic effects for the region pacific futures highlights futures conceived in the context of a modernity coproduced by diverse pacific peoples taking resistance to categorization as a starting point rather than a conclusion with its hospitable approach to thinking about history making and future thinking one that is open to a wide range of methodological epistemological and political interests and commitments the volume will encourage the writing of new histories of the pacific and new ways of talking about history in this field the region and beyond

theory in the pacific the pacific in theory explores the role of theory in pacific archaeology and its interplay with archaeological theory worldwide the contributors assess how the practice of archaeology in pacific contexts has led to particular types of theoretical enquiry and interest and more broadly how the pacific is conceptualised in the archaeological imagination long seen as a laboratory environment for the testing and refinement of social theory the pacific islands occupy a central place in global theoretical discourse this volume highlights this role through an exploration of how pacific models and exemplars

have shaped and continue to shape approaches to the archaeological past the authors evaluate key theoretical perspectives and explore current and future directions in pacific archaeology in doing so attention is paid to the influence of pacific people and environments in motivating and shaping theory building theory in the pacific the pacific in theory makes a significant contribution to our understanding of how theory develops attuned to the affordances and needs of specific contexts and how those contexts promote reformulation and development of theory elsewhere it will be fascinating to scholars and archaeologists interested in the pacific region as well as students of wider archaeological theory

this book integrates class environmental and political analysis to uncover the history of clearcutting in the douglas fir forests of b c washington and oregon between 1880 and 1965 part i focuses on the mode of production analyzing the technological and managerial structures of worker and resource exploitation from the perspective of current trends in labour process research rajala argues that operators sought to neutralize the variable forest environment by emulating the factory model of work organization the introduction of steam powered overhead logging methods provided industry with a rudimentary factory regime by 1930 accompanied by productivity gains and diminished workplace autonomy for loggers after a depression inspired turn to selective logging with caterpillar tractors timber capital continued its refinement of clearcutting technologies in the post war period achieving complete mechanization of yarding with the automatic grapple driving this process of innovation was a concept of industrial efficiency that responded to changing environmental conditions product and labour markets but sought to advance operators class interests by routinizing production the managerial component of the factory regime took shape in accordance with the principles of the early 20th century scientific management movement requiring expertise in the organization of an expanded technologically sophisticated exploitation process operators presided over the establishment of logging engineering programs in the region s universities graduates introduced rational planning procedures to coastal logging contributing to a rate of deforestation that generated a corporate call for technical forestry expertise after 1930 industrial foresters then emerged from the universities to provide firms with data needed for long range investment decisions in land acquisition and management part ii constitutes an environmental and political history of clearcutting this reconstructs the process of scientific research concenring the factory regime s impact on the ecology of the douglas fir forest assessing how knowledge was utitized in the regulation of cutting practices analysis of business government relations in british columbia washington and oregon suggests that the reliance of those client states on revenues generated by timber capital enouraged a pattern of regulation that

served corporate rather than social and ecological ends

the code of federal regulations is the codification of the general and permanent rules published in the federal register by the executive departments and agencies of the federal government
