the twentieth century australian welfare state made the bold promise to care for its citizens but since the 1990s social security has become increasingly conditional and punitive in its provision of this so called care who cares outlines the perspectives of people affected by two recent welfare measures offering an urgent account of the implications of these reforms eve vincent has interviewed people who were impacted by the controversial cashless debit card which limited discretionary spending as well as those looking after small children who are compulsory participants in the program parentsnext vincent challenges the very category of welfare recipient which defines people exclusively by their relationship to paid work and she asks who bears the burden of looking after vulnerable people once the welfare state s duty of care is displaced by surveillance and punishment who cares offers a new and deeply humane account of life on welfare today

this volume has its origin in the fifth sixth and seventh workshops on and bayesian methods in applied statistics held at maximum entropy the university of wyoming august 5 8 1985 and at seattle university august 5 8 1986 and august 4 7 1987 it was anticipated that the proceedings of these workshops would

be combined so most of the papers were not collected until after the seventh workshop because all of the papers in this volume are on foundations it is believed that the contents of this volume will be of lasting interest to the bayesian community the workshop was organized to bring together researchers from different fields to critically examine maximum entropy and bayesian methods in science and engineering as well as other disciplines some of the papers were chosen specifically to kindle interest in new areas that may offer new tools or insight to the reader or to stimulate work on pressing problems that appear to be ideally suited to the maximum entropy or bayesian method a few papers presented at the workshops are not included in these proceedings but a number of additional papers not presented at the workshop are included in particular we are delighted to make available professor e t jaynes unpublished stanford university microwave laboratory report no 421 how does the brain do plausible reasoning dated august 1957 this is a beautiful detailed tutorial on the cox polya jaynes approach to bayesian probability theory and the maximum entropy principle

there has never been a mid ocean ditching by an air carrier jet these are the words that haunt captain charlie wells when he realizes that his jumbo jet has a problem over the atlantic none of the passengers or crew could know that a disgruntled airline mechanic has sentenced them to a night of terror as the flight approaches the equal time point and is the most distant from land captain wells and his crew of pilots and flight attendants struggle to avoid making history while airline personnel the faa and the fbi try to solve the mystery of tri con flight eleven a small u s navy ship may be the only hope for the 208 souls on board ride along in the cockpit as this routine international flight becomes a nightmare that will require all the flight staff s training to survive after reading equal time point frequent flyers and first time passengers will find themselves studying the emergency procedure card in the seatback before their next flight

a step towards verified software worries about the reliability of software are as old as software itself techniques for allaying these worries predate even james king s 1969 thesis on a program verifier what gives the whole topic a new urgency is the conjunction of three phenomena the blitz like spread of software rich systems to control ever more facets of our world and our lives our growing impatience with deficiencies and the development proceeding more slowly alas than the other two trends of techniques to ensure and verify software quality in 2002 tony hoare one of the most distinguished contributors to these advances over the past four decades came to the conclusion that piecemeal efforts are no longer sufficient and proposed a grand challenge intended to achieve over 15 years the production of a verifying compiler a tool that while processing programs would also guarantee their adherence to specified properties of correctness robustness safety security and other desirable properties as hoare sees it this endeavor is not a mere

research project as might normally be carried out by one team or a small consortium of teams but a momentous endeavor comparable in its scope to the successful mission to send a man to the moon or to the sequencing of the human genome

following the holocaust american literature experienced a resurgence of jewish themes characters and contributions this book focuses on the genres of science fiction and fantasy of the post holocaust period and argues that while the era was colored by grief it also offered a renaissance of jewish creative expression the author provides an overview of texts beginning with the rise of jewish speculative fiction anthologies in science fiction and fantasy and delving into emerging subgenres such as alternate history post apocalyptic cold war second wave feminism counterculture parodies new wave postmodernism and cyberpunk to illustrate how jewish culture made its mark on popular culture the book also covers the silver age and bronze age of comics which saw stan lee jack kirby julius schwartz and marv wolfman form new superhero teams to battle prejudice and draws parallels with some of the most impactful shows made by jewish creators including star trek twilight zone and doctor who the analysis also looks beyond the american context to include texts from germany the soviet union brazil and israel
