the american dream of equal opportunity and social mobility still holds a powerful appeal for the many immigrants who arrive in this country each year but if immigrant success stories symbolize the fulfillment of the american dream the persistent inequality suffered by native born african americans demonstrates the dream s limits although the experience of blacks and immigrants in the united states are not directly comparable their fates are connected in ways that are seldom recognized immigration and opportunity brings together leading sociologists and demographers to present a systematic account of the many ways in which immigration affects the labor market experiences of native born african americans with the arrival of large numbers of nonwhite immigrants in recent decades blacks now represent less than 50 percent of the u s minority population immigration and opportunity reveals how immigration has transformed relations between minority populations in the united states creating new forms of labor market competition between native and immigrant minorities recent immigrants have concentrated in a handful of port of entry cities breaking up established patterns of residential segregation and in some cases contributing to the migration of native blacks out of these cities immigrants have secured many of the occupational niches once dominated by blacks and now pass these jobs on through ethnic hiring networks that exclude natives at the same time many native born blacks find jobs in the public sector which is closed to those immigrants who lack u s citizenship while recent immigrants have unquestionably brought economic and cultural benefits to u s society this volume makes it clear that the costs of increased immigration falls particularly heavily upon those native born groups who are already disadvantaged even as large scale immigration transforms the racial and ethnic make up of u s society forcing us to think about race and ethnicity in new ways it demands that we pay renewed attention to the entrenched problems of racial disadvantage that still beset native born african americans

this book is based on the true life experiences of an immigration lawyer a totally assimilated third generation mexican american who felt it necessary to represent the unrepresented and underrepresented humans in the united states he was full of idealistic ideas ambition and a willingness to try whatever he could to help his clients it is also a story of compassion sadness and the effort to help the hopeless cases good intentions are often punished and this book explores jaded politics bribes and consequences

the topic of immigration is at the center of contemporary politics and from a scholarly perspective existing studies have documented that attitudes towards immigration have brought about changes in both partisanship and voting behavior however many scholars have missed or misconstrued the role of religion in this transformation particularly evangelical protestant christianity this book examines the historical and contemporary relationships between religion and immigration politics with a particularly in depth analysis of the fault lines within evangelicalism divisions not only between whites and non whites but also the increasingly consequential disconnect between elites and laity within white evangelicalism the book s empirical analysis relies on original interviews with christian leaders data from original church surveys conducted by the authors and secondary analysis of several national public opinion surveys it concludes with suggestions for bridging the elite laity and racial divides ruth m melkonian ph d emory university is chair and professor of political science at gordon college massachusetts she has contributed chapters to faith in a pluralist age 2018 and is the good book good enough 2011 she has published in a wide range of journals including social science quarterly the review of faith international affairs latin american perspectives political research quarterly comment and capital commentary lyman a kellstedt ph d university of illinois is professor of political science emeritus at wheaton college illinois he has authored or coauthored numerous articles book chapters and books in religion and politics including religion and the culture wars 1996 the bully pulpit 1997 and the oxford handbook of religion and american politics 2009

undocumented in the u s south is a rare look into the everyday realities of undocumented youth in k 12 public schools in an anti immigrant policy context youth and their families navigate historical and current legacies and realities of segregation racial discrimination and inequality with a deep three year ethnographic study hundreds of hours of observational research interviews and policy analysis sophia rodriguez traces the lives of undocumented youth across multiple public school settings her research underscores how these youth are racialized through state policies school and organizational practices and everyday interactions with educators and peers as the first study of its kind to combine this unique framework for analysis undocumented in the u s south sheds light on the challenges youth face in their everyday struggle to belong rodriguez invites us to consider youth experiences as central knowledge for improving educators awareness and school practice while promoting policies that are humanizing and rooted in youth experience

arizona s controversial new immigration bill is just the latest of many steps in the new criminalization of immigrants while many cite the presumed criminality of illegal aliens as an excuse for ever harsher immigration policies it has in fact been well established that immigrants commit less crime and in particular less violent crime than the native born and that their presence in communities is not associated with higher crime rates punishing immigrants moves beyond debunking the presumed crime and immigration linkage broadening the focus to encompass issues relevant to law and society immigration and refugee policy and victimization as well as crime the original essays in this volume uncover and identify the unanticipated and hidden consequences of immigration policies and practices here and abroad at a time when immigration to the u s is near an all time high ultimately punishing immigrants illuminates the nuanced and layered realities of immigrants lives describing the varying complexities surrounding immigration crime law and victimization
