offering a collection of diverse readings reinforced with discussions of the rhetorical modes the fifth edition now provides new essays writing prompts and an expanded glossary

Allen's Dictionary of English Phrases is the most comprehensive survey of this area of the English language ever undertaken taking over 6000 phrases it explains their meaning explores their development and gives citations that range from the venerable Bede to Will Self crisply and wittily written the book is packed with memorable and surprising detail whether showing that salad days comes from Antony and Cleopatra that Flavour of the Month originates in 1940s American ice cream marketing or even that we've been calling a spade a spade since the sixteenth century Allen's Dictionary of English Phrases is part of the Penguin Reference Library and draws on over 70 years of experience in bringing reliable useful and clear information to millions of readers around the world making knowledge everybody's property

this new edition includes most of the essays that have made the Broadview Reader one of the most popular first year textbooks in Canada and adds 18 fresh selections as before essays are gathered into groups by topic but the editors also provide

alternative tables of contents by rhetorical patterns and devices and by chronology each selection is followed by a wide range of questions and suggestions for discussions and the reader also includes a glossary and biographical notes most of the new selections are of recent vintage but in recognition of the degree to which modern issues often have a long and honourable history the editors have also added several selections by nineteenth century writers also the reader now includes a full section on women in society the book s balance of canadian and non canadian writers has been maintained as has the range of different styles and different essay lengths that are included in all the new edition includes 80 selections

distinguished linguistics scholar anatoly liberman set out the frame for this volume in an analytic dictionary of english etymology here liberman s landmark scholarship lay the groundwork for his forthcoming multivolume analytic dictionary of the english language a bibliography of english etymology is a broadly conceptualized reference tool that provides source materials for etymological research for each word s etymology there is a bibliographic entry that lists the word origin s primary sources specifically where it was first found in use featuring the history of more than 13 000 english words their cognates and their foreign antonyms this is a full fledged compendium of resources indispensable to any scholar of word origins

a lively street level history of turn of the century urban life explores the americanizing influence of the irish on successive waves of migrants to the american city in the newest volume in the award winning penguin history of american life series james r barrett chronicles how a new urban american identity was forged in the streets saloons churches and workplaces of the american city this process of americanization from the bottom up was deeply shaped by the irish from lower manhattan to the south side of chicago to boston s north end newer waves of immigrants and african americans found it nearly impossible to avoid the irish while historians have emphasized the role of settlement houses and other mainstream institutions in americanizing immigrants barrett makes the original case that the culture absorbed by newcomers upon reaching american shores had a distinctly hibernian cast by 1900 there were more people of irish descent in new york city than in dublin more in the united states than in all of ireland but in the late

nineteenth century the sources of immigration began to shift to southern and eastern europe and beyond whether these newcomers wanted to save their souls get a drink find a job or just take a stroll in the neighborhood they had to deal with entrenched irish americans barrett reveals how the irish vacillated between a progressive and idealistic impulse toward their fellow immigrants and a parochial defensiveness stemming from the hostility earlier generations had faced upon their own arrival in america they imparted racist attitudes toward african americans they established ethnic deadlines across city neighborhoods they drove other immigrants from docks factories and labor unions yet the social teachings of the catholic church a sense of solidarity with the oppressed and dark memories of poverty and violence in both ireland and america ushered in a wave of progressive political activism that eventually embraced other immigrants drawing on contemporary sociological studies and diaries newspaper accounts and irish american literature the irish way illustrates how the interactions between the irish and later immigrants on the streets on the vaudeville stage in catholic churches and in workplaces helped forge a multiethnic american identity that has a profound legacy in our cities today

a whole and not just the united states the third part focuses on how these ingredients have been transformed into foods identified with the american diet and on how americans have produced and presented these foods over the last four centuries the final section explores how food practices are a means of embodying ideas about identity showing how food choices preferences and stereotypes have been used to create and maintain ideas of difference including essays on all the key topics and issues the routledge history of american foodways comprises work from a leading group of scholars and presents a comprehensive survey of the current state of the field it will be essential reading for all those interested in the history of food in american culture

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
