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the rise of cctv and surveillance technologies has been one of the key developments in contemporary society but its impact has often been analysed in a fragmented manner this book addresses this issue by providing a detailed micro sociological account of the construction of a cctv network in one english city it differs from previous studies which have concentrated on open street cctv systems in documenting and analysing the use

of visual surveillance systems in a number of different locations and institutional settings including the industrial workplace shopping malls high rise housing schemes and hospitals it is concerned not just with abstract categories of grand theory but seeks to explain how people living in contemporary society experience these changes the surveillance situates the growth of visual surveillance systems in the context of many of the key concerns of theorists of modernity and makes a key contribution to understanding the nature of the relationship between surveillance and society its starting point is to view the relationship between surveillance and society as a two way process the book looks at both the social impact of visual surveillance systems and at how the impact of these technologies is shaped by existing social relations political practice and cultural traditions provides a richly textured account and analysis of the introduction of visual surveillance technologies cctv in an english cityexplores the impact of the introduction and use of visual surveillance systems in a wide variety of locales and institutional settings both public and private makes a key contribution to theoretical debates over the relationship between surveillance systems and society one of the central concerns of theorists of modernity

video surveillance systems often referred to as closed circuit television cctv have become a defining feature of modern life their widespread use by many different agencies for a range of purposes is no longer surprising and is generally accepted in most european countries although broad academic interest accompanied the proliferation of cctv in the mid to late 1990s issues of governance and public policy are rarely explicitly addressed by social scientists and many of the concerns raised during the debate which followed the video surveillance revolution remain unanswered and are as pertinent today as they were then this book brings into focus the ways in which the implementation of cameras and systems and their operation and technical features are the product of decisions and policies made in a variety of contexts and by a variety of authorities and interested parties it examines the cultural context in which cameras are deployed and explores how this context can shape their diffusion and use the book places particular emphasis on studies of video surveillance in different national institutional cultural and linguistic settings the book is divided into two parts the chapters in part one are theoretically informed contributions from a variety of academic disciplines part two consists of five case studies which are less theoretical and more

descriptive but which offer important insights for the governance of video surveillance cameras providing a fascinating study of the wider implications of video surveillance and its pervasive use this book will be of interest to all those interested in how this phenomenon affects all of us in society today

you are walking in town the contents of a beggar s mind spill out in a chaotic muddle on the busy pavement in front of you simultaneously fascinated and revolted you are not sure how or whether to help the beggar shrieks you realise that it is your old english teacher this story is a partial decryption of a tiny portion of the rage and frustration in that inchoate scream george is a big issue vendor in london s soho driven to write about his experience while unsure whether allegory brutal realism or metaphor will best help people understand he has conjured an intimate mindscape of soho offering a unique insight into the people who live work and visit there and a stark analysis of social attitudes you will never look at a rough sleeper a beggar or a big issue vendor in the same way again

the book used by thandie newton to research her part in line of duty a lone policewoman disarms a knife wielding schizophrenic two officers drag a woman from a railway line seconds before an express train roars past an undercover cop clings onto the bonnet of a drug dealer s car as it speeds through a busy town centre these are just some of the ways britain s police officers are daily called upon to demonstrate bravery in the line of duty when even the most routine call can turn into a life or death situation and split second judgements can make all the difference sometimes officers make the ultimate sacrifice in fulfilling their duty when pc bill parker was swept to his death by floodwaters in cumbria in 2009 he had been working to save stranded motorists from the same fate this thrilling collection of first person accounts of true courage celebrates the sustained bravery and presence of mind routinely displayed by so many officers in england wales and scotland the stories also reveal an insider s view of the culture training and techniques police officers use in carrying out their duties
