from catherine linka the sequel and explosive conclusion to a girl called fearless having survived a violent confrontation with the us government avie is not out of danger both she and the young man she loves yates have been declared terrorists and yates is hospitalized in critical condition leaving avie with the perilous task of carrying information that can bring down the paternalist party if she can get it into the right hands forced on the run with handsome enigmatic woodsman luke avie struggles when every turn becomes a choice between keeping the two of them alive or completing their mission with her face on every news channel and a quarter million dollar reward from the man who still owns her marriage contract avie s worst fears are about to come true equal parts thrilling and romantic a girl undone is sure to keep your heart racing right until the very end

an indie next pick avie reveare has the normal life of a privileged teen growing up in l a at least as normal as any girl s life is these days after a synthetic hormone in beef killed fifty million american women ten years ago only young girls old women men and boys are left to pick up the pieces the death threat is past but fathers still fear for their daughters safety and the paternalist movement begun to protect young women is taking over the choices they make like all her friends avie still mourns the loss of her mother but she s also dreaming about college

and love and what she'll make of her life when her dad contracts her to marry a rich older man to raise money to save his struggling company her life suddenly narrows to two choices be trapped in a marriage with a controlling politician or run her lifelong friend student revolutionary yates urges her to run to freedom across the border to canada as their friendship turns to passion the decision to leave becomes harder and harder running away is incredibly dangerous and it's possible avie will never see yates again but staying could mean death from catherine linka comes this romantic thought provoking and frighteningly real story a girl called fearless about fighting for the most important things in life freedom and love

a college freshman is swept into shaky moral territory within the cut throat world of visual arts in this razor sharp novel winning a scholarship to california's most prestigious art school seems like a fairy tale ending to sabine reye's awful senior year after losing both her mother and her home sabine longs for a place where she belongs but the cutthroat world of visual arts is nothing like what sabine had imagined colin krell the renowned faculty member whom she had hoped would mentor her seems to take merciless delight in tearing down her best work and warns her that she'll lose the merit based award if she doesn't improve desperate and humiliated sabine doesn't know where to turn then she meets adam a grad student who understands better than anyone the pressures of art school he even helps sabine get insight on krell by showing her the modern master's work in progress a portrait that's sold for a million dollars sight unseen sabine is enthralled by the portrait within those swirling colorful layers of paint is the key to winning her inscrutable teacher's approval krell did advise her to improve her craft by copying a painting she connects with but what would he think of sabine secretly painting her own version of his masterpiece and what should she do when she accidentally becomes party to a crime so well plotted that no one knows about it but her complex and utterly original what i want you to see is a gripping tale of deception attraction and moral ambiguity

eighteen year old cayenne barely remembers her mother who died of breast cancer when cayenne was four the women in her family have a history of dying young cayenne figures she'll meet the same fate so she might as well enjoy life now engaging in death defying risks like dodging trains and jumping off cliffs with her boyfriend when cayenne receives a series of video messages her mother made for her before dying she isn't sure she wants them her aunt tee has been her true mother figure but then aunt tee tests positive for a brca gene mutation the one that doomed cayenne's mom and decides to get a mastectomy to reduce her chances of developing cancer as cayenne helps her aunt prepare for the surgery she finds herself drawn to her mother's messages with their musings on life love and perseverance for the first time cayenne starts to question what it truly means to live life to the fullest even when death might be written into her dna

an emotional and heart wrenching novel about grief and striving for perfection lighter leaner faster raesha will do whatever it takes to win nationals for her competing isn't just about the speed of her horse or the thrill of the win it's about honoring her mother's memory and holding onto a dream they once shared lighter leaner faster for an athlete every second counts raesha knows minus five on the scale will let her sit deeper in her saddle make her horse lighter on his feet and lighter leaner faster gives her the edge she needs over the new girl on the team a girl who keeps flirting with raesha's boyfriend and making plans with her best friend so she focuses on minus five but if she isn't careful she's going to lose more than just the people she loves she's going to lose herself to lighter leaner faster sit quietly with this book feel the wind the dusty air taste the sorrow and the wonder listen to the heart that is beating on every page then be grateful that catherine alene gave us this stunning story it's a thing of beauty kathi appelt newbery honor and national book award finalist

beautiful views deadly encounters grief stricken over her mother s death and bruised by her failure on her most recent case special agent emmeline helliwell with the national park service returns to her utah hometown to heal and regroup she s determined to turn in her badge and take over her mother s bakery for a much quieter life until the body of a childhood friend turns up in the narrows of zion national park the case is too personal for emme to turn down but the seemingly simple investigation turns treacherous as clues that connect to her previous case grow too glaring to ignore when bodies start to pile up emme must track down the killer before they take more lives venturing deep into zion national park to uncover the sordid secrets hiding beneath its stunning beauty perfect for fans of c j box and lisa gardner
