vienna in the age of uncertainty traces the vital and varied roles of science through
the story of three generations of the eminent exner family whose members
included nobel prize winning biologist karl frisch the teachers of freud and of
physicist erwin schrödinger artists of the vienna secession and a leader of vienna s
women s movement training her critical eye on the exners through the rise and fall
of austrian liberalism and into the rise of the third reich deborah r coen
demonstrates the interdependence of the family s scientific and domestic lives
exploring the ways in which public notions of rationality objectivity and autonomy

were formed in the private sphere vienna in the age of uncertainty presents the story of the exners as a microcosm of the larger achievements and tragedies of austrian political and scientific life in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries

the psychoanalytic encounter of sigmund freud at mid life and dora an emotionally troubled adolescent suffering from hysteria provides a glimpse into the private lives of upper middle class jews in fin de siecle vienna their professional concerns familial relations sexual undercurrents and responses to the social forces of anti semitism and the derogation of women decker places the treatment of dora in a larger social and historical context and pursues the lives of the two protagonists before and after their meeting

friedrich beck was the single most important figure in the transformation of the inept habsburg military into the modern military state that would wage world war i he correctly perceived that only an elite body of officers responsible for war planning and preparation could provide lasting security for the austro hungarian empire after firmly establishing the general staff as an institution beck led war planning to counter threats from russia italy and the balkans and spearheaded a vast rebuilding of the rail network while his rise to power marked a return to the favorite system of military administration of the early franz joseph period beck proved himself a man with real military ability that revolutionized an army

on the cusp of the twentieth century in the most cosmopolitan city in the world there a sensation that entranced the city s populace as nothing had before a sensation that cast a great and disturbing shadow over the city and then vanished leaving no more trace than a shadow would child abuse in freud s vienna is the story of that forgotten sensation in this fabled city in the autumn of 1899 vienna s attention was focused not on its extraordinary cultural life but on child abuse specifically two cases of child murder and two of abuse while sigmund freud was anxiously awaiting the publication of the interpretation of dreams in which he first theorized about the oedipal hostilities between parents and children every day s headlines proclaimed the ugly reality of child abuse focusing on the four cases that dominated the pages of the newspapers larry wolff s riveting narrative paints a picture of a great city enthralled by a spectacle it desperately wished to ignore

celebrates the sweet excesses of the austro hungarian empire sachertorte apfelstrudel and croissants are among the creations rodgers demystifies publishers weekly take a tour of the legendary cafés of vienna budapest and prague where a rich tradition of masterful desserts and coffee lives on for centuries artists and philosophers have gathered around coffeehouse tables to complement their lively conversations with exquisite desserts modern cafés of this region remain loyal to this pastry tradition though the décor has changed it is still strudel not lemongrass sorbet that is served on the menu in kaffeehaus rick rodgers celebrates 300 years of tradition with over 150 of the best classic austro hungarian pastries using his celebrated skill as a teacher to present the recipes to bakers of all levels rodgers

expertly shows how to create these glorious treats at home included are the explanations of the different kinds of batter dough and icing that form the foundation of this baking tradition in addition to the many beverages coffee or otherwise that pair perfectly with the desserts this revised second edition features new charts for ingredient weights and measures in addition to updated content and resource lists one of the few books on authentic austro hungarian baking written in english with recipes for american kitchens and their ingredients kaffeehaus beautifully captures the taste and elegance of these cafés commemorating their culture history and the delectable legacy of their desserts because the featured desserts e g apfelstrudel and sachertorte are steeped in tradition this is as much a fascinating culinary history as it is a recipe collection library journal

born in vienna in 1890 gertrud bodenwieser became a leading exponent of ausdruckstanz expressionist dance during the 1920s and 1930s developing a definitive personal style and a philosophy of dance that distinguished her from all her contemporaries in 1938 she emigrated to australia to start her career afresh with the remaining nucleus of her company from nazi occupied austria in this collection of writings initially compiled by bettina vernon and posthumously completed by her husband charles warren each contributor highlights bodenwieser s achievements from a different perspective with reminiscences from her pupils and company members together with scholarly studies

this book takes a different approach to the history of philosophy exploring a neglected theme the relationship between catastrophe and philosophy the book analyzes this theme within texts from ancient times to the present from a global perspective the book's focus is timely and relevant today as the planet is certainly facing a number of impending catastrophes right now e g environmental degradation overpopulation the threat of nuclear war etc

now a major motion picture by legendary director david cronenberg starring viggo mortensen kiera knightley and michael fassbender in 1907 sigmund freud and carl gustav jung began what promised to be both a momentous collaboration and the deepest friendship of each man's life six years later they were bitter antagonists locked in a savage struggle in between them stood a young woman named sabina spielrein a patient and lover to jung a colleague and confidante to freud and one of the greatest minds in modern psychiatry this mesmerizing book reconstructs the fatal triangle of freud jung and spielrein it encompasses clinical methods and politics hysteria and anti semitism sexual duplicity and intellectual brilliance wielded as blackmail learned humane and impossible to put down a dangerous method is intellectual history with the narrative power and emotional impact of great tragedy

winner of the 2007 gradiva award an innovative work of biography that traces the lasting impact of the friendship between sigmund freud and pioneering american psychologist james jackson putnam in 1909 sigmund freud made his only visit to america which included a trip to putnam camp the eminent american psychologist james jackson putnam's family retreat in the adirondacks of all the things that i have experienced in america this is by far the most amazing freud wrote of putnam camp putnam a boston unitarian and freud a viennese jew came from opposite worlds cherished polarized ambitions and promoted seemingly irreconcilable visions of human nature and yet they struck up an unusually fruitful collaboration putnam's unimpeachable reputation played a crucial role in legitimizing the psychoanalytic movement by the time of putnam's death in 1918 psychoanalysis had been launched in america where in large part thanks to the influence of putnam and in a development freud had not anticipated it went on to become a practice that moved beyond the vicissitudes of desire to cultivate the growth and spiritual aspirations of the individual as a whole putnam camp reveals details of putnam's and freud's personal lives that have never been fully explored before including the crucial role putnam's muse susan blow founder of america's first kindergarten pioneering educator and philosopher in the american hegelian movement played in the intense debate between these two great thinkers as the great grandson of putnam author george prochnik had access to a wealth of personal firsthand material from the putnam family as well as from the james and emerson families all of which contribute to a new and intimate vision of the texture of daily life at a moment when america was undergoing a cultural and intellectual renaissance
