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the power which has always started the greatest religious and political avalanches in history rolling has from time immemorial been the magic power of the spoken word and that alone adolf hitler mein kampf as historians have long noted public oratory has seldom been as pivotal in generating and sustaining the vitality of a movement as it was during

the rise and rule of the national socialist party from 1919 to 1945 led by the charismatic and indefatigable hitler national socialists conducted one of the most powerful rhetorical campaigns ever recorded indeed the mass addresses which were broadcast live on radio taped for re broadcast and in many cases filmed for play on theater newsreels throughout the third reich constituted one of the most thorough exploitations of media in history because such evil lay at the heart of the national socialist movement its overwhelming rhetoric has often been negatively characterized as propaganda as randall bytwerk points out however the propaganda label was anything but negative in the minds of the leaders of the national socialist movement in their view the clear simplistic and even one sided presentation of information was necessary to mobilize effectively all elements of the german population into the national socialist program gathered here are thirteen key speeches of this historically significant movement including hitler s announcement of the party s reestablishment in 1925 following the unsuccessful beer hall putsch four addresses by joseph goebbels the 1938 kristallnacht speech by julius streicher and four speeches drafted as models for party leaders use on various public occasions the volume concludes with adolf hitler s final public address on january 30 1945 three months before his suicide several of these works are presented for the first time in english translation bytwerk provides a brief introduction to each speech and allows the reader to trace the development and downfall of the nazi party landmark speeches of national socialism is an important volume for students of rhetoric world war ii nazi germany and the holocaust

adolf hitler is the most notorious political figure of the twentieth century the story of his life how he became a dictator and how he managed to convince so many to follow his cause is a subject of perennial fascination balancing narrative and analysis this biography employs a chronological approach to describe the main features of hitler s career set against the background of developments in germany and europe during his lifetime the text tells the extraordinary story of how an austrian layabout rose to become führer of the third reich the chapters incorporate into their narrative the major debates surrounding hitler s ideas behaviour and historical significance particular attention is paid to his experience as a soldier in 1914 18 and to the reasons why his original left wing sympathies transmuted into nazism arguments over the real character of hitler s dictatorship are analysed and a measured assessment is offered on the disputed issues of how far hitler initiated the third reich s domestic and foreign policies himself and to what extent he was controlled by events his

selected as a book of the year by the new york times times literary supplement and the times despite his status as the most despised political figure in history there have only been four serious biographies of hitler since the 1930s even more surprisingly his biographers have been more interested in his rise to power and his methods of leadership than in hitler the person some have even declared that the führer had no private life yet to render hitler as a political animal with no personality to speak of as a man of limited intelligence and poor social skills fails to explain the spell that he cast not only on those close to him but on the german people as a whole in the first volume of this monumental biography volker ullrich sets out to correct our perception of the führer while charting in detail hitler s life from his childhood to the eve of the second world war against the politics of the times ullrich unveils the man behind the public persona his charming and repulsive traits his talents and weaknesses his deep seated insecurities and murderous passions drawing on a wealth of previously neglected or unavailable sources this magisterial study provides the most rounded portrait of hitler to date ullrich renders the führer not as a psychopath but as a master of seduction and guile and it is perhaps the complexity of his character that explains his enigmatic grip on the german people more convincingly than the clichéd image of the monster this definitive biography will forever change the way we look at the man who took the world into the abyss

this book addresses two closely related questions what is the process by which the relatively short and violent genocides of the twentieth century and beyond have occurred why have these instances of mass violence been genocidal and not some other form of state violence repression or conflict hiebert answers these questions by exploring the structures and processes that underpin the decision by political elites to commit genocide focusing on a sustained comparison of two cases the nazi final solution and the cambodian genocide the book clearly differentiates the structures and processes contained within a larger overall process that leads to genocidal violence uncovering the mechanisms by which societies at least in the contemporary era come to experience genocide as a distinct form of destruction and not some other form of mass or political violence hiebert is able to highlight a set of key process that lead to specifically genocidal violence providing an insightful contribution to the burgeoning literature in this area this book will be of interest to students and scholars of genocide international relations and political violence

from historian frank mcdonough the first volume of a new chronicle of the third reich under hitler's hand on january 30th 1933 adolf hitler was appointed the german chancellor of a coalition government by president hindenburg within a few months he had installed a dictatorship jailing and killing his leftwing opponents terrorizing the rest of the population and driving jews out of public life he embarked on a crash program of militaristic keynesianism reviving the economy and achieving full employment through massive public works vast armaments spending and the cancellations of foreign debts after the grim years of the great depression germany seemed to have been reborn as a brutal and determined european power over the course of the years from 1933 to 1939 hitler won over most of the population to his vision of a renewed reich in these years of domestic triumph cunning maneuvers pitting neighboring powers against each other and biding his time we see hitler preparing for the moment that would realize his ambition but what drove hitler's success was also to be the fatal flaw of his regime a relentless belief in war as the motor of greatness a dream of vast conquests in eastern europe and an astonishingly fanatical racism

the story of the making of adolf hitler that we are all familiar with is the one hitler himself wove in his 1924 trial and then expanded upon in mein kampf it tells of his rapid emergence as national socialist leader in 1919 and of how he successfully rallied most of munich and the majority of bavaria s establishment to support the famous beer hall putsch of 1923 it is an account which has largely been taken at face value for over ninety years yet on closer examination hitler s account of his experiences in the years immediately following the first world war turns out to be every bit as unreliable as his account of his experiences as a soldier during the war itself in becoming hitler thomas weber continues from where he left off in his previous book hitler s first war stripping away the layers of myth and fabrication in hitler s own tale to tell the real story of hitler s politicization and radicalization in post first world war munich it is the gripping account of how an awkward and unemployed loner with virtually no recognizable leadership qualities and fluctuating political ideas turned into the charismatic self assured virulently anti semitic leader with an all or nothing approach to politics with whom the world was soon to become tragically familiar as weber clearly shows far from the picture of a fully formed political leader which hitler wanted to portray in mein kampf his ideas and priorities were still very uncertain and largely undefined in early

1919 and they continued to shift until 1923 it was the failed Ludendorff putsch of November 1923 and the subsequent Ludendorff trial which was to prove the making of Hitler and he was not slow to spot the opportunity that it offered as the movers and shakers of Munich's political scene tried to blame everything on him in the course of the trial Hitler was presented with a golden opportunity to place himself at the centre of attention turning what had been the Ludendorff trial into the Hitler trial henceforth he would no longer be merely a local Bavarian political leader from now on he would present himself as a potential national saviour in the months after the trial Hitler cemented this myth by writing *Mein Kampf* from his comfortable prison cell his years of metamorphosis were now behind him his years as Führer were soon to come

Ian Kershaw's Hitler allows us to come closer than ever before to a serious understanding of the man and of the catastrophic sequence of events which allowed a bizarre misfit to climb from a Viennese doss-house to leadership of one of Europe's most sophisticated countries with extraordinary skill and vividness drawing on a huge range of sources Kershaw recreates the world which first thwarted and then nurtured the young Hitler as his seemingly pitiful fantasy of being Germany's saviour attracted more and more support Kershaw brilliantly conveys why so many Germans adored Hitler connived with him or felt powerless to resist him
