ALVAR AALTO NICHOLAS RAY ALVAR AALTO NICHOLAS RAY AN UNEXPECTED DIALOGUE OF FORM AND FEELING ALVAR AALTO THE FINNISH MASTER OF ORGANIC MODERNISM AND NICHOLAS RAY THE REBELLIOUS American director of film noir and rebelwithoutacause narratives might seem like unlikely BEDFELLOWS YET A COMPELLING COMPARISON EMERGES WHEN EXAMINING THEIR SHARED ARTISTIC PHILOSOPHIES FOCUSING ON A FUNDAMENTAL TENSION BETWEEN STRUCTURE AND EMOTION FORM AND FEELING WHILE SEPARATED BY MEDIUM ARCHITECTURE AND CINEMA AALTO AND RAY EXPLORED SIMILAR THEMES OF HUMAN EXPERIENCE UTILIZING THEIR CHOSEN FORMS TO EXPRESS A PROFOUND EMPATHY FOR THE INDIVIDUAL WITHIN A LARGER OFTEN UNFORGIVING CONTEXT AALTOS ARCHITECTURE EMBRACING THE HUMAN SCALE AALTOS ARCHITECTURE TRANSCENDS THE RIGID GEOMETRIES OF EARLY MODERNISM HE CHAMPIONED HUMANCENTERED DESIGN REJECTING THE COLD FUNCTIONALIST AESTHETIC IN FAVOR OF WARMTH AND INTUITIVE FUNCTIONALITY HIS buildings from the Paimio Sanatorium to the Syntsalo Town Hall are characterized by organic FORMS NATURAL MATERIALS WOOD BRICK STONE AND A METICULOUS ATTENTION TO DETAIL MAGINE A FLOWING RIVER AALTOS ARCHITECTURE SIMILARLY ADAPTS TO ITS SURROUNDINGS MEANDERING AND RESPONDING TO THE LANDSCAPE AND ITS INHABITANTS HIS USE OF LIGHT BOTH NATURAL AND ARTIFICIAL IS MASTERFUL CREATING ATMOSPHERES OF CALM AND CONTEMPLATION OR DYNAMIC ENERGY DEPENDING ON THE INTENDED function This humancentric approach is evident in his furniture designs as well His iconic bent PLYWOOD CHAIRS FOR EXAMPLE ARE ERGONOMICALLY DESIGNED FOR COMFORT AND INTUITIVE USE REFLECTING HIS DEEP UNDERSTANDING OF HUMAN NEEDS THIS FOCUS ON THE HUMAN BODY EXTENDS TO THE VERY FABRIC OF HIS BUILDINGS WITH SPACES INTUITIVELY SCALED FOR HUMAN INTERACTION AND MOVEMENT RAYS CINEMA EXPLORING THE FRACTURED PSYCHE NICHOLAS RAYS CINEMATIC UNIVERSE IS MARKED BY A SIMILAR CONCERN FOR THE HUMAN CONDITION ALBEIT EXPRESSED THROUGH A DIFFERENT LENS HIS FILMS OFTEN CHARACTERIZED BY STARK LIGHTING UNSETTLING COMPOSITIONS AND MORALLY AMBIGUOUS CHARACTERS EXPLORE THE ANXIETIES AND ALIENATION OF POSTWAR AMERICA THINK OF THE FRACTURED MIRROR IMAGE RAYS FILMS OFTEN REFLECT THE FRAGMENTED PSYCHES OF HIS PROTAGONISTS INDIVIDUALS STRUGGLING TO FIND THEIR PLACE IN A RAPIDLY CHANGING WORLD 2 FILMS LIKE REBEL WITHOUT A CAUSE JOHNNY GUITAR AND IN A LONELY PLACE SHOWCASE RAYS ABILITY TO VISUALLY CONVEY INTERNAL TURMOIL HIS USE OF CHIAROSCURO CONTRASTING LIGHT AND SHADOW REFLECTS THE INTERNAL CONFLICTS HIS CHARACTERS GRAPPLE WITH THE DESOLATE LANDSCAPES AND CLAUSTROPHOBIC INTERIORS MIRROR THE EMOTIONAL STATES OF HIS PROTAGONISTS REINFORCING THE SENSE OF ISOLATION AND VULNERABILITY HE USES VISUAL LANGUAGE TO EXPOSE THE PSYCHOLOGICAL TENSIONS BENEATH THE SURFACE OF SEEMINGLY ORDINARY INTERACTIONS THE PARALLEL FORM AS A VESSEL FOR EMOTION BOTH AALTO AND RAY EMPLOYED FORM AS A PRIMARY VEHICLE FOR EXPRESSING

THIS BOOK FIRST PUBLISHED IN FINNISH IN 1985 UNDER THE TITLE AALTO IS A CRITICAL INTRODUCTION TO FINNISH ARCHITECT ALVAR AALTO 1898 1976 WRITTEN BY ONE OF AALTO S FINNISH ARCHITECTURAL CONTEMPORARIES KIRMO MIKKOLA 1934 1986 THE BOOK IS DIVIDED INTO SIX SECTIONS DEALING WITH DIFFERENT ASPECTS OF AALTO S ARCHITECTURE FROM HIS CLASSICAL BEGINNINGS TO URBAN PLANNING AS WELL AS HIS VARIOUS PROFESSIONAL AND INTELLECTUAL ASSOCIATES MIKKOLA DEBUNKS THE COMMON OPINION OF A RETICENT AALTO TO DETERMINE THE ROOTS OF HIS THINKING SEEING HIM AS A MEDIATOR OF INFLUENCES FROM A WIDE VARIETY OF SOURCES THE BOOK WAS ORIGINALLY TARGETED AT A FINNISH AUDIENCE AND SO ITS TRANSLATION REQUIRES INTERPRETERS TWO ARCHITECT SCHOLARS WHO KNEW MIKKOLA WELL JUHANI PALLASMAA AND AINO NISKANEN THE BOOK ALSO SHEDS LIGHT ON A YOUNG GENERATION OF FINNISH ARCHITECTS THAT DISTANCED ITSELF FROM AALTO AS A ROLE MODEL PINPOINTED HERE BY THE INCLUSION OF THE ESSAY SNOWBALLS 1948 BY AULIS BLOMSTEDT OFTEN QUOTED BY FINNISH ARCHITECTURAL SCHOLARS THE PUBLICATION FINALLY OF AN ENGLISH TRANSLATION OF MIKKOLA S BOOK WILL APPEAL TO THOSE INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARS AND STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN AWARE OF THE LACK OF CRITICAL PERSPECTIVES FROM AALTO S FINNISH ARCHITECT CONTEMPORARIES
