

Anxious Decades America In Prosperity And Depression 1920 1941

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impressively detailed an authoritative and epic overview publishers weekly in the convulsive years between 1920 and 1941 americans were first dazzled by unprecedented economic prosperity and then beset by the worst depression in their history it was the era of model t s rising incomes scientific management

electricity talking movies and advertising techniques that sold a seemingly endless stream of goods but it was also a time of grave social conflict and human suffering the crash forced hoover and then roosevelt and the nation to reexamine old solutions and address pressing questions of recovery and reform economic growth and social justice the world beyond america changed also in these years making the country rethink its relation to events in europe latin america and asia the illusion of superiority slowly died in the 1930s sustaining a fatal blow in december 1941 at pearl harbor

first published in 1985 this study explores the agricultural depression in the united states of america in the 1920 s the author examines overproduction wartime optimism and the farm crisis and continuity and change in agriculture during this period this title will be of great interest to students of history agriculture and economics

during the 1920s and 1930s changes in the american population increasing urbanization and innovations in technology exerted major influences on the daily lives of ordinary people explore how everyday living changed during these years when use of automobiles and home electrification first became commonplace when radio emerged and when cinema with the addition of sound became broadly popular find out how worklife domestic life and leisure time activities were affected by these factors as well as by the politics of the time details of matters such as the creation of the pickup truck the development of radio programming and the first mass use of cosmetics provide an enjoyable read that brings the period clearly into focus centering its attention on the broad masses of the population this animated reference resource emphasizes the wide variety of experiences of people living through the roaring twenties and the great depression readers will be surprised to discover that some of the assumptions we have about the lives of average americans during these eras are historically inaccurate a final chapter provides a unique look at six american communities and gives a vivid sense of the diversity of american experience over the course of these tumultuous years

using case records of prosecutions at the scottish high court of justiciary between 1918 and 1930 this book takes a quantitative and qualitative approach to understand sexual violence in scotland at this time analysing legal records alongside victim and witness testimonies louise heren analyses who committed sexual violence against whom where and how and to an extent looks to uncover the victims voice assessing how the courts responded sex and violence in 1920s scotland reveals that despite pejorative views of working class female behaviour the successful conversion of prosecutions to convictions was greater than what is seen in modern sexual assault cases in a society adjusting to post conflict stresses there were fears expressed in middle class circles that those most affected by the first world war might react with violence however the high court archives suggest otherwise cases of incest rape and sexual assault appears to have been endemic an opportunistic crime against older victims yet often pre meditated against the youngest selfish crimes that suggest toxic masculinity among some working class men the book concludes with the ultimate question why did these men perpetrate sexual violence

in the twentieth century there have been five major recessions two in the interwar period and three more starting 1973 1979 and 1989 this book focuses on events in the uk but sets them in their international context and makes frequent comparisons with other countries major recessions happened at a similar time in all major countries and the lessons are general three main conclusions are reached 1 major recessions reflect abrupt fallings off in demand not supply 2 these are due to identifiable demand shocks and by swings in consumer and business confidence which amplify the direct effects of demand shock 3 major recessions are not predictable in the final chapter christopher dow puts forward an insider s view on how to avoid future severe recessions action must be taken to control booms which if uncontrolled will lead to a period of bust and once a major recession has begun fiscal and monetary policy must be adjusted to mitigate the downturn often unpopular with economists this is the line which many governments and central banks take major recessions will help them to have more success

from the mid 1980s investors in the us increasingly directed capital towards the financial sector at the expense of non financial sectors lured by the perception of higher profits this flow of capital inflated asset prices creating the stock market and housing bubbles which burst when the imbalance between stagnant incomes and rising debts triggered the banking meltdown profitability and the great recession analyses these trends in profitability and capital accumulation which the authors identify as the root cause of the financial crisis in the context of the us and other major oecd countries drawing on insights from adam smith david ricardo john stuart mill and karl marx the authors interpret the relationship between capital accumulation and profitability trends through the conceptual lens of classical political economy the book provides extensive empirical evidence of declining rates of us non financial corporate accumulations from the mid 1960s and profitability trends in that sector falling from post war highs in contrast to this it is shown that there was a vigorous rise of profitability in the financial sector from a 1982 trough to the early part of the twenty first century which led to the bloating of that sector the authors conclude that the long term falling accumulation trend in the non financial corporate sector highlighted by the bankruptcy of major automobile corporations stands out as the underlying force that transformed the financial crisis into a fully fledged great recession this book will be of interest to students and researchers in the areas of economics political economy business and finance
