method in ancient philosophy brings together fifteen new specially written essays by leading scholars on a broad subject of central importance it is characteristic of human beings that they direct their activities by reasoning methods of reasoning even toward the same ends vary self conscious reflection on the methods of reasoning marks the beginning of philosophy in the west examination of how the ancient greeks reasoned and how they thought about methods of reasoning helps us to see how they came to hold the views they did and how we have come to think as we do for the views of the ancients have had a considerable influence upon our own assumptions about the demarcations between different kinds of enquiry and the sorts of methods that are appropriate for them the aims of the volume are thus both exegetical and philosophical most of the essays focus on socrates plato or aristotle but earlier and later ancient philosophy is brought into the picture by essays on eleatic and epicurean thought

this is a major reinterpretation of ancient philosophy that recovers the long greek and roman tradition of philosophy as a complete way of life and not simply an intellectual discipline distinguished philosopher john cooper traces how for many ancient thinkers philosophy was not just to be studied or even used to solve particular practical problems rather philosophy not just ethics but even logic and physical theory was literally to be lived yet there was great disagreement about how to live philosophically philosophy was not one but many mutually opposed ways of life examining this tradition from its establishment by socrates in the fifth century bce through plotinus in the third century ce and the eclipse of pagan philosophy by christianity pursuits of wisdom examines six central philosophies of living socratic aristotelian stoic epicurean skeptic and the platonist life of late antiquity the book describes the shared assumptions that allowed these thinkers to conceive of their philosophies as ways of life as well as the distinctive ideas that led them to widely different conclusions about the best human life clearing up many common misperceptions and simplifications cooper explains in detail the socratic devotion to philosophical discussion about human nature human life and human good the aristotelian focus on the true place of humans within the total system of the natural world the stoic commitment to dutifully accepting zeus s plans the epicurean pursuit of pleasure through tranquil activities that exercise perception thought and feeling the skeptical eschewal of all critical reasoning in forming their beliefs and finally the late platonist emphasis on spiritual concerns and the eternal realm of being pursuits of wisdom is essential reading for anyone interested in understanding what the great philosophers of antiquity thought was the true purpose of philosophy and of life

a magisterial mappa mundi of the terrain that pierre hadot has so productively worked for decades this ambitious work revises our view of ancient philosophy and in doing so proposes that we change the way we see philosophy itself hadot takes ancient philosophy out of its customary realm of names dates and arid abstractions and plants it squarely in the thick of life through a meticulous historical reading he shows how the various schools trends and ideas of ancient greek and roman philosophy all tended toward one goal to provide a means for achieving happiness in this life by transforming the individual s mode of perceiving and being in the world most pressing for hadot is the question of how the ancients conceived of philosophy he argues in great detail systematically covering the ideas of the earliest greek thinkers hellenistic philosophy and late antiquity that ancient philosophers were concerned not just to develop philosophical theories but to practice philosophy as a way of life a way of life to be suggested illuminated and justified by their philosophical discourse for the ancients philosophical theory and the philosophical way of life were inseparably linked what is ancient philosophy also explains why this connection broke down most conspicuously in the case of academic professional philosophers especially under the influence of christianity finally hadot turns to the question of whether and how this connection might be reestablished even as it brings ancient thoughts and thinkers to life this invigorating work provides direction for those who wish to improve their lives by means of genuine philosophical thought

the problem of body and soul has a long history that can be traced back to the beginnings of greek culture the existential question of what happened to the soul at the moment of death whether and in what form there is life after death and of the exact relationship between body and

soul was answered in different ways in greek philosophy from the early days to late antiquity the contributions in this volume not only do justice to the breadth of the topic they also cover the entire period from the pre socratics to late antiquity particular attention is paid to plato aristotle and hellenistic philosophers that is the stoics and the epicureans

method and metaphysics presents twenty six essays in ancient philosophy by jonathan barnes one of the most admired and influential scholars of his generation the essays span four decades of his career and are drawn from a wide variety of sources many of them will be relatively unknown even to specialists in ancient philosophy several essays are now translated from the original french and made available in english for the first time others have been substantially revised for republication here the volume opens with eight essays about the interpretation of ancient philosophical texts and about the relationship between philosophy and its history the next five essays examine the methods of ancient philosophers the third section comprises thirteen essays about metaphysical topics from the presocratics to the late platonists this collection will be a rich feast for students and scholars of ancient philosophy

scientific interest in ancient especially in greek philosophy is not confined to the value that it possesses as a peculiar subject for historical research and for the study of the growth of civilization but it is also equally concerned in the permanent significance that the content of ancient thought possesses by reason of its place in the development of the intellectual life of europe the emphasis falls primarily upon the lifting of mere knowing to the plane of systematic knowledge or science not content with his storing of practical facts and with his fantastic speculations born of his religious needs the greek sought knowledge for its own sake knowledge like art was developed as an independent function from its involvement in the other activities of civilization so first and foremost the history of ancient philosophy is an insight into the origin of european science in general from introduction p 1
