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an engaging accessible introduction to buddhism for those who are looking to explore a new spiritual tradition or understand the roots of their mindfulness practice are you curious about buddhism but find yourself met with scholarly texts or high minded moralizing every time you try to pick up a book about it well if so relax this is no ordinary introduction to buddhism there are none of the saccharine platitudes and dense pontification that you may have come to expect buddhist is a readable introduction for complete newcomers that provides an objective streamlined overview of the tradition from unpacking the four noble truths to understanding what nirvana actually means for those who have already dipped their toes into the tradition through the practice of mindfulness or meditation this guide will help you create a more well rounded and informed experience by delving into the history of the buddhist traditions that shape a mindful practice buddhist scholar dr pierce salguero analyzes the ideas and philosophy of the complex tradition through the eyes of both a critic and an admirer he shares anecdotes from his time at a thai monastery stories from the years he spent living throughout asia and other personal experiences that have shaped his study of buddhism through this guide readers will have the opportunity to develop an

approach to practice that is not quite buddhist but buddhish through engaging and lighthearted stories dr salguero breaks down 20 central principles of the tradition including awakening suffering doubt karma buddha nature

this volume provides practical but provocative case studies of exemplary projects that apply digital technology or methods to the study of religion an introduction and 16 essays are organized by the kinds of sources digital humanities scholars use texts images and places with a final section on the professional and pedagogical issues digital scholarship raises for the study of religion

although scholars have long assumed that early chinese political authority was rooted in confucianism rulership in the medieval period was not bound by a single dominant tradition to acquire power emperors deployed objects and figures derived from a range of traditions imbued with religious and political significance author april d hughes demonstrates how dynastic founders like wu zhao wu zetian r 690 705 the only woman to rule china under her own name and yang jian emperor wen r 581 604 the first ruler of the sui dynasty closely identified with buddhist worldly saviors and wheel turning kings to legitimate their rule during periods of upheaval caused by the decline of the dharma worldly saviors arrived on earth to quell chaos and to rule and liberate their subjects simultaneously by incorporating these figures into the imperial system sovereigns were able to depict themselves both as monarchs and as buddhas or bodhisattvas in uncertain times in this inventive and original work hughes traces worldly saviors in particular maitreya buddha and prince moonlight as they appeared in apocalyptic scriptures from dunhuang claims to the throne made by various rebel leaders and textual interpretations and assertions by yang jian and wu zhao yang jian associated himself with prince moonlight and took on the persona of a wheel turning king whose offerings to the buddha were not flowers and incense but weapons of war to reunite a long fragmented empire and revitalize the dharma wu zhao was associated with several different worldly savior figures in addition she saw herself as the incarnation of a wheel turning king for whom it was said the seven treasures manifested as material representations of his right to rule wu zhao duly had the seven treasures created and put on display whenever she held audiences at court the worldly savior figure allowed rulers to inhabit the highest role in the religious realm along with the supreme role in the political sphere this incorporation transformed notions of chinese imperial sovereignty and associating rulers with a buddha or bodhisattva continued long after the close of the medieval period

jesus in the hands of buddha is an enthralling memoir of father shigeto oshida a man who was at once a japanese zen buddhist master and a catholic dominican priest guided by the hand of god and the buddha dharma he became the founder and director of the takamori hermitage in the japanese alps a place where pilgrims have been drawn for decades he was a unique pioneer in the encounter between religions east to west who felt he was led to the catholic faith and the priesthood by a trick of god overwhelmed by the weight of european styled catholic culture inundating the catholic church in japan oshida received permission from his superiors to strike out on his own and listen to the voice of god while remaining a dominican priest and zen master thus becoming both hermit and healer in a community of pilgrims the sick the poor and the disenchanted from around the world through this encounter with shigeto oshida s life and works and awakening to his oneness of being a catholic priest and buddhist monk readers are invited to enter their own journey to jesus in the hands of buddha the unifying thread of this new horizon is grace the unmitigated gift of divine love that permeates individuals events and locations and makes them holy

the dhammapada is a versified buddhist scripture traditionally ascribed to the buddha himself it is one of the best known texts from the theravada canon the title dhammapada is a compound term composed of dhamma and pada each word having a number of denotations and connotations generally dhamma can refer to the buddha s doctrine or an eternal truth or righteousness or all phenomena and at its root pada means foot and thus by extension especially in this context means either path or verse or both english translations of this text s title have used various combinations of these and related words according to tradition the dhammapada s verses were spoken by the buddha on various occasions most verses deal with ethics the text is part of the khuddaka nikaya of the sutta pitaka although over half of the verses exist in other parts of the pali canon

an introduction to the buddhist scriptures with the aim to encourage the reader to study the texts themselves the book has a particular emphasis to help with the development of right understanding of all phenomena of life at the present moment it is a follow up to nina van gorkom s book the buddha s path

this small book presents 23 highly readable selections from the buddhist scriptures in which we read the words of the buddha and the early buddhist disciples themselves

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
