issues are almost always impediments to any or productive interactions with host country officials particularly on the front lines where migrants encounter border patrol and law enforcement officers without adequate means of communicating their situation or understanding their rights since undocumented people are categorized as illegal they can be subjected to abuse and exploitation by host country officials who can choose to either tolerate or punish them on the basis of unpredictable changeable and even illusory or arbitrary laws and regulations citing experts at every level of the undocumented immigrant apparatuses worldwide from public defenders to interpreters Barsky concludes that the only viable policy to address prevailing abuses and inequalities is to move towards open borders an approach that would address prevailing issues and surprisingly provide security and economic benefits to both host and home countries
