- 3 The US Constitution 1787** The shortcomings of the s of Confederation led to the creation of the US Constitution a more robust framework for national governance **Key features include** **Federal System** The Constitution created a federal system dividing power between the national government and the states **Separation of Powers** Power is divided between the three branches of government the legislative Congress executive President and judicial Supreme Court **Checks and Balances** Each branch of government has the ability to limit the power of the other two branches preventing any single branch from becoming too powerful **Popular Sovereignty** The Constitution emphasizes the principle of popular sovereignty with power ultimately residing in the people
