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ford s administration in which kissinger continued to play a decisive role years of renewal is the triumphant conclusion of a major achievement and a book that will stand the test of time as a historical document of the first rank

on 14 january 1963 general de gaulle described by the foreign office as an almost impossible ally brutally vetoed britain s first bid to join the common market it was a blow that delayed britain s entry for a decade and hastened the end of harold macmillan s political career peter mangold writes in arresting detail about the fascinating personal duel that shaped high politics and anglo french diplomacy he portrays two of the most complex and skilful leaders of the post war era old friends from their association in algiers during world war ii de gaulle the dour lofty moralist obsessed with high notions of france and macmillan the canny ambitious fixer always the pragmatist seeking to get things done as resident minister allied forces headquarters in algiers in 1943 macmillan had done much to help de gaulle and protect him from churchill s and roosevelt s hostility they next met in 1958 as leaders of their two countries when britain and france faced many similar problems ranging from decolonization and their determination to retain national great power status to relations with the impetuous soviet leader nikita khrushchev but while both seemed anxious to retain their old wartime connection they were now rivals with very different views of the world divided by the atlantic as much as the channel the two leaders disagreed fundamentally over america de gaulle sought the leadership of a europe independent of the united states the pro american macmillan talked of britain as a bridge between the two sides of the atlantic when macmillan finally sought eec membership de gaulle played on the old alliance to keep the british prime minister off guard ultimately macmillan was outwitted out manoeuvred and even perhaps outclassed by the general the almost impossible ally is a fascinating story of a friendship turned sour and of a compelling new episode in the turbulent relations between britain and france

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the chapters in this book reflect on people s relationships with past financial crises from public opinion to business leaders and policy makers in connection with financial crises remembering and learning from financial crises addresses three fundamental questions first are financial crises remembered and if so how second have lessons been

drawn from past financial crises and third have past experiences been used in order to make practical decisions when confronted with a new crisis these questions are of course related yet they have been approached from different historical perspectives using methodologies borrowed from different academic disciplines one of the objectives of this book is to explore how these approaches can complement each other in order to better understand the relationships between remembering and learning from financial crises and how the past is used by financial institutions it thus recognises financial crisis as a recurring phenomenon and addresses the impact that this has in a range of public and policy contexts

in a turbulent world keynes s warnings of a century ago are no less relevant and some even more so

financial crises are recurring phenomena that result in the financial distress of systemically important banks making it imperative to understand how to best respond to such crises and their consequences two policy responses became prominent for dealing with these distressed institutions since the last global financial crisis bailouts and bail ins the main questions surrounding these responses touch everyone are bailouts or bail ins good for the financial system and the real economy is it essential to save distressed financial institutions by putting taxpayer money at risk in bailouts or is it better to use private money in bail ins instead are there better options such as first lines of defense that help prevent such distress in the first place can countercyclical prudential and monetary policies lessen the likelihood and severity of the financial crises that often bring about this distress through careful analysis authors berger and roman review and critically assess the extant theoretical and empirical research on many resolution approaches and tools placing special emphasis on lessons learned from one of the biggest bailouts of all time the troubled asset relief program tarp while also reviewing other programs and tools tarp and other bank bailouts and bail ins around the world sheds light on how best to protect the financial system on wall street and the real economy on main street presents a well informed and rich account of bailouts bail ins and other resolution approaches to resolve financially distressed banks uses tarp as a key case study of bailouts that has been thoroughly researched provides valuable research and policy guidance for dealing with future financial crises

bernard gwertzman tells the story of growing up as a journalist in the world of print newspapers his hometown new rochelle new yorks standard star then the washington dc evening star both of which went under as print papers collapsed where he became a senior diplomatic correspondent until moving to the new york times where he served during the cold war as moscow bureau chief and then traveled with henry kissinger who was making deals and opening the way toward peace in the middle east he rose to foreign editor guiding the paper in covering the collapse of communism from 1989-1993 the end of apartheid and other major stories in 1995 he helped lead the times into the world of the internet which may be the future of the press today

in book 4 of the speedicut memoirs charles speedicut finds his fortunes and misfortunes tied up with those of the future king edward viii mr mrs ernest simpson and adolf hitler in the course of his narrative speedicut relates how he was responsible for the murderous night of the long knives when hitler ruthlessly purged the sturmabteilung he also provides previously unpublished details of his intimate involvement in the events leading to the abdication his activities to subvert the british government's policy of appeasement his part in the duke duchess of windsor's infamous tour of germany in 1937 and his disruptive and usually secret role in many other events of the period the history of the twentieth century might have been very different possibly better but probably worse without the activities of major charles speedicut sir winston churchill i bitterly regret the day that wallis met that shit speedicut ernest simpson

the presidency of george w bush is the first balanced academic study to analyze the entirety of his presidency domestic social economic and national security policies as well as the administration's response to 9 11 and the subsequent war on terror in so doing john robert greene argues persuasively that the judgment of most scholars that the bush administration was a complete failure has been made in haste and without the benefit of primary sources this book is the first scholarly work to make wide use of the documents at the george w bush presidential library many of which have only recently been made available to researchers through the freedom of information act john robert greene offers a balanced assessment and nuanced conclusions supported by documentary evidence yet in doing so he does not absolve the bush administration of its shortcomings the presidency of george w bush shows that the administration could be vindictive as demonstrated by the plame wilson affair and the firing of the us attorneys it all too often moved too slowly as shown by the national security council's lethargic handling of terrorism pre 9 11 the failed attempt to revise social security and the sluggish reaction to hurricane katrina it was an administration that accepted and acted on the highly suspect theory of the unitary presidency as advocated by dick cheney and accepted by the president on the other side of the balance sheet however the evidence also makes it eminently clear that the bush administration was responsible for many

positive achievements no child left behind set the nation on the road toward affecting serious educational reform in healthcare reform the bush administration both strengthened the medicare system and extended its benefits for millions of americans and bush did more to combat the worldwide scourge of aids particularly in africa than any other president in sum the actions of this presidency continue to affect the presidencies of each of his successors as well as the trajectory of world history to the present day
