the experience of the divine in india merges the three components of sight performance and sound this book is about the power and importance of seeing in the hindu religious tradition in the hindu view not only must the gods keep their eyes open but so must we in order to make contact with them to reap their blessings and to know their secrets when hindus go to temple their eyes meet the powerful eternal gaze of the eyes of god it is called darsan seeing the divine image and it is the single most common and significant element of hindu worship this book explores what darsan means this is also a book about the divine image in the hindu tradition what do hindus see in the images of the gods what is meant by these multi armed gods with their various weapons emblems and animals how are these images made and consecrated how are they treated in a ritual context in exploring the nature of the divine image this book not only considers the images of the gods but also the hindu temple and the hindu place of pilgrimage

this book explores the power of sight for ancient rabbis across the realms of divinity sexuality idolatry and rabbinic subjectivity

of god as an infinite and personal being of maximal greatness craig carefully defines and explicates the divine attributes of incorporeality necessity aseity simplicity eternality omnipresence omniscience omnipotence and goodness in the second part volume iib excursus on natural theology the trinity craig examines six arguments for god s existence including the argument from contingency the kalâm cosmological argument the argument from the applicability of mathematics the argument from cosmic fine tuning the moral argument and the ontological argument along with the problem of evil following the excursus he transitions to an articulation and defence of christian theism formulating a biblical doctrine of the trinity and offering a model of god as a tripersonal soul

the philosophical and theological study of aesthetics has a long and rich history stretching back to platos identification of ultimate goodness and beauty together representing the eternal form recent trends in aesthetic theory however characterised by a focus on the beautiful at the expense of the good have made it an object of suspicion in the orthodox church in its place greek theologians have sought to emphasise philokalia as a truer theological discipline seeking to reverse this trend chrysostomos stamoulis brings into conversation a plethora of voices from church fathers to contemporary poets and from a marxist political theorist to a literary critic out of this dialogue stamoulis builds a model for the re appropriation of orthodoxys patristic and byzantine past that is no longer defined in antithesis to the western present the openness he proposes allows us to perceive afresh the world shot through with divinity if only we can lift our gaze to see it dismantling the false dichotomy philokalia or aesthetics is the first step

the book proposes a new way of understanding the glory of god in christian theology based on glory as sign

in this volume on the holy spirit missed treasures designates the rich pneumatologies in the new testament books and letters beyond paul john and luke acts depictions of the holy spirit in matthew the letter of james revelation and other books are analyzed and incorporated into the theological tapestry of new testament thought another unique feature of this volume is its focus on the numinous presence of god in the sweep of israel s history there are chapters on the septuagint the dead sea scrolls and the wisdom of solomon that trace christian pneumatology back to its source the hebrew scriptures in short this volume expands the scholarly conversation exponentially as it explores a complement of texts spanning the new testament and reaching back into the hebrew scriptures a lucid guide to the distinctive pneumatologies of the new testament this collection is must reading for all who would engage the dialogue between scriptural study and systematic theology

during the last two decades there has been a renaissance in the field of christian philosophy unfortunately most of this excellent work has not reached general readers reason for the hope within was produced specifically to make available the best of contemporary christian philosophy in a clear accessible and highly relevant manner fourteen of america s rising christian philosophers here cover many of the traditional themes of christian apologetics arguments for the existence of god the problem of evil the possibility of miracles as well as topics of special relevance to today s world eastern religions christianity and science christianity and ethics the existence of heaven and hell

this book is an exploration and interpretation of the diverse symbols and images that represent the sacred presence of god in the book of psalms these images of sacred spaces and objects represent diverse conceptions of the sanctuary or sacred spaces objects and texts that mediate god s presence and bridge the gap between the ineffable nature of god as transcendent and beyond human comprehension and as immanently and intimately present in human experience i explore the multivalent ways in which images of sacred spaces and objects facilitate prayer and contemplation this book represents a valuable contribution to the study of psalms and biblical theology spirituality and prayer

in his sermon what is man john wesley spoke of the human being as a curious machine reflecting the eighteenth century view of the person as a set of complex mechanisms animated by the soul the rapid rate of technological development in recent decades is opening toward a future in which the centrality and uniqueness of human beings is undergoing a shift developments in robotics artificial intelligence surveillance autonomous weapons human enhancement and genetic modification raise an array of questions for the christian tradition the awareness of the negative impact of human activity on the natural environment is challenging the traditional view of humanity as having a uniquely privileged role at the heart of creation this collection of essays addresses wesleyan and broadly christian voices that explore the theological philosophical biblical ethical and practical implications of emerging technologies their impact upon different aspects of human life and the possibilities that are opening up toward a posthuman future

this set reprints three classic volumes on jeremy bentham s economic writings before these volumes were published a great deal of jeremy bentham s economic work was completely unknown all three volumes contain historical introductions and collections of passages from bentham s non economic writings which illustrate his views on economics as a science and the problems of methodology first published by george allen unwinn in the 1950s

in between philosophy and religion volumes i and ii brayton polka examines spinoza s three major works on religion politics and ethics in order to show that his thought is at once biblical and modern this book and its companion volume are essential reading for any scholar of spinoza

this book is an introduction to three questions on love according to st thomas aquinas summa theologiae i ii qq 26 28 these three questions reflect on the nature of love q 26 the causes of love q 27 and the effects of love q 28 it is thus an introduction to the entire phenomenon of love both as a bodily passion and an act of the will the purpose is to present the thomistic and broadly scholastic account of human and divine love from a philosophical and theological perspective it aims to be a theological and philosophical study of the topic useful both for a graduate professional audience as part of an undergraduate or graduate course and perhaps for the educated reader the thesis of the book is that contrary to contemporary conceptions not all loves are created equal some loves perfect us and some loves corrupt us the worth of a

love depends on its object and end st thomas thus presents an objective and teleological account of human and divine love that is of philosophical and theological interest the method is broadly exegetical presenting a careful reading of the text and supplying the philosophical and theological background which the text of aquinas assumes the scope of the work is limited to three questions st i ii qq 26 28 references to interpretative disputes of aquinas and references to further resources in the secondary literature will be mostly limited to the footnotes making the body of the text accessible to more readers

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
