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in the early days of television many of its actors writers producers and directors came from radio this crossover endowed the american radio archives with a treasure trove of television documents the collected scripts span more than 40 years of american television history from live broadcasts of the 1940s to the late 1980s they also cover the entire spectrum of television entertainment programming including comedies soap operas dramas westerns and crime series the archives cover nearly 1 200 programs represented by more than 6 000 individual scripts includes an index of personal names program and episode titles

and production companies as well as a glossary of industry terms

one of the most charismatic feature films of the new wave a bout de souffle 1960 has retained much of its appeal not only as the emphatic statement of a generational break with tradition but also as godard s earliest rendition of a set of thematic and stylistic motifs that would become his trademark sustained critical attention over almost fifty years has made this a cult film propelled in part by the memorable coupling of its lead actors jean paul belmondo and jean seberg whose story on screen seemed to portray the troubled love affair between french cinema and hollywood in this original guide to the film ramona fotiade provides an in depth analysis of its production and reception contexts as well as of salient aspects mise en scene and editing she situates a bout de souffle in relation to godard s filmography and critical writings up to 1960 focusing on the elaboration of a narrative and visual discourse that has come to be identified with a distinctive strand in postmodern french cinema she also explores the impact of godard s early counter narrative and visual strategies on the independent american filmmakers and the french cinema du look during the 1980s and 1990s

looks at how hollywood is changing to meet economic and creative challenges this title probes the working methods of a diverse range of screenwriters to explore how they come up with their ideas how they go about adapting a stage play or work of fiction and whether their variegated life experiences contribute to the success of their writing

an intimate portrait of the turmoil that spawned the new wave in french cinema and the story of its greatest director jean luc godard godard s early films revolutionized the language of cinema hugely prolific in his first decade breathless contempt pierrot le fou alphaville and made in usa are just a handful of the seminal works he directed godard introduced filmgoers to the generation of stars associated with the trumpeted sexuality of postwar movies and culture brigitte bardot jean seberg jean paul belmondo and anna karina as the sixties wore on however godard s life was transformed the hollywood he had idolized began to disgust him and in the midst of the socialist ferment in france his second wife introduced him to the activist student left from 1968 to 1972 europe s greatest director worked in the service of maoist politics and continued thereafter to experiment on the far peripheries of the medium he had transformed his extraordinary later works are little seen or appreciated yet he remains one of europe s most influential artists drawing on his own working experience with godard and his coterie colin maccabe in this first biography of the director has written a thrilling account of the french cinema s transformation in the hands of truffaut rohmér rivette and chabrol critics who toppled the old aesthetics by becoming legendarily directors themselves and godard s determination to make cinema the greatest of the arts

this book focuses on the debates which shook french cinema in the immediate aftermath of the student revolution of may 1968 alison smith examines these effects across the spectrum of french production the rise of new genres and re formulation of older ones chapters investigate political thrillers historical films new naturalism and utopian fantasies dealing with a wide variety of films a particular concern is the extent to which filmmakers ideas and intentions are contained in or contradicted by their finished work and the gradual change in these ideas over the decade

focusing on the career of the surrealist poet jacques prevert this book explores the stylistic and thematic currents that prevailed in french films of the 1930s prevert s involvement with the surrealists his contribution to the avant grade theatre company groupe octobre and his unique collaboration with marcel carne are examined

an unusual and captivating memoir by the acclaimed author of hurry down sunshine michael greenberg a native new yorker loves the city as a child loves a parent and in its honour he has put together a collection of tightly written incisive chapters each another tessera or tile in a big mosaic michael greenberg is an acute observer new york times they are short snapshots of memoir beautifully observed this is the perfect bedside book split as it is into neat insomniac chunks scott pack in beg borrow steal michael greenberg regales us with his wry and vivid take on the life of a writer of little means trying to practise his craft or simply stay alive he finds himself doctoring doomed movie scripts selling cosmetics from an ironing board in front of a women s department store writing

about golf a game he has never played and botching his debut as a waiter in a posh restaurant central characters include michael s father whose prediction that michael s scribbling wouldn t get him on the subway almost came true his artistic first wife whom he met in a greenwich village high school and their son who grew up on the lower east side fluent in the language of the street then there are greenberg s unexpected encounters a holocaust survivor who on his deathbed tries to leave michael his fortune a repentant communist who confesses his sins a man who becomes a woman a chilean film maker in search of his past and rats who behave like humans and cease to live underground hilarious and bittersweet greenberg s stories invite us into a world where the familial the literary the tragic and the mundane not only speak to one another but deeply enjoy the exchange

produced in italy from the turn of the 20th century sword and sandal or peplum films were well received in the silent era and attained great popularity in the 1960s following the release of hercules 1959 starring mr universe steve reeves a global craze for bronze age fantasy adventures ensued and the heroic exploits of hercules maciste samson and goliath were soon a mainstay of american drive ins and second run theaters though mainly disparaged by critics by 1965 the genre was eclipsed by the spaghetti western yet the 1960s peplum canon continues to inspire hollywood epics this filmography provides credits cast and comments for dozens of films from 1908 through 1990

one of the most important controversial and prolific filmmakers in film history and a founder of french new wave cinema jean luc godard has maintained an unbroken string of films in various genres and mediums from the late 1950s onward godard has established a reputation as a rebel who can work within and outside the system producing films that are creative breathtakingly beautiful and yet commercial enough to earn back their production costs in this book wheeler winston dixon offers an overview of all of godard s work as a filmmaker including his work for television and his ethnographic work in africa free from the jargon and value judgments that have marred much of what has been written about godard this is the only book that covers the entirety of godard s career from his early film criticism for cahiers du cinema to his most recent video film work illustrated with forty six rare stills and researched in detail it is the godard book for the 1990s

cine craft 1974 is an ideal guide to the world of amateur film making a treasure house of authoritative information it covers the equipment both basic and advanced and the planning needed for a successful production it looks at indoor and outdoor shooting composition exposure continuity and camera movement editing and titling and the methods and use of recorded sound an intriguing chapter deals with the various forms of cine animation using puppets cut outs and cells

this scarce work pulls together much important information on early settlers of jamaica including seventy pedigrees of early jamaicans a table showing the

starting date for baptismal marriage and burial records as found in all jamaican parishes and an early census of 700 jamaican landowners

with essays by baru bart beaty cécile vernier danehy hugo frey pascal lefèvre fabrice leroy amanda macdonald mark mckinney ann miller and clare tufts in belgium france switzerland and other french speaking countries many well known comics artists have focused their attention on historical and political events in works ranging from comic books and graphic novels to newspaper strips cartoonists have addressed such controversial topics as french and belgian collaboration and resistance during world war ii european colonialism and us imperialism anti semitism in france the integration of african immigrant groups in europe and the green and feminist movements history and politics in french language comics and graphic novels collects new essays that address comics from a variety of viewpoints including a piece from practicing artist baru the explorations range from discussion of such canonical works as hergé s tintin series to such contemporary expressions as baru s road to america 2002 about the algerian war included are close readings of specific comics series and graphic novels such as cécile vernier danehy s examination of cosey s saigon hanoi about remembering the vietnam war other writers use theoretical lenses as a means of critiquing a broad range of comics such as bart beaty s bourdieu inspired reading of today s comics field and amanda macdonald s analysis of bandes dessinées french comic books in new caledonia during the 1990s the anthology establishes the french language comics tradition as one rich with representations of history and politics and is one of the first english language collections to explore the subject

this work offers insights into how specific films influenced the americanization of the holocaust and how the medium per se helped seed that event into the public consciousness in addition to an in depth study on films produced for both theatrical release and tv since 1937 including the great dictator cabaret julia and the mini series holocaust this work provides an analysis of schindler s list and the debate over the merit of spielberg s vision of the holocaust it also examines more thoroughly made for television movies such as escape from sobibor playing for time and war and remembrance a special chapter on the diary of anne frank discusses the evolution of that singularly european work into a universal symbol paying special attention to the tumultuous 1960s in america it assesses the effect of the era on holocaust films made during that time it also discusses how these films helped integrate the holocaust into the fabric of american society transforming it into a metaphor for modern suffering finally the work explores cinema in relation to the americanization of the jewish image

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
