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catalog of catalogs provides a comprehensive index of nearly 2 300 publications documenting

the exhibition of judaica over the past 140 years this vast corpus of material ranging from simple leaflets to scholarly catalogs contains textual and visual material as yet unmined for the study of jewish art religion culture and history through highly detailed fully indexed catalog entries william gross orly tzion and falk wiesemann elucidate some 2 000 subjects geographical locations and judaica objects ceremonial objects illuminated manuscripts printed books synagogues cemeteries et al addressed in these catalogs descriptions of the catalog s bibliographic components contributors exhibition history and contents all accessible through the volume s five indices render this volume an unparalleled new resource for the study of jewish art culture and history

an artist who has long exploited the emotional power of color and texture jo ann callis is widely known for her inventive photographs involving tactile objects and images of people in mysterious often unsettling narratives jo ann callis woman twirling is the catalogue of an exhibition held at the j paul getty museum from march 31 to august 9 2009 the book comprising sixty eight color and fifteen black and white works that range from 1974 to 2005 constitutes the first book length treatment of callis s work since 1989 many of these invented dreamlike scenes of people and objects will be new to viewers including a photographic installation of fifteen images of pastries lusciously printed in cibachrome against textile backgrounds and a more recent series of digitally montaged domestic interiors others such as salt pepper fire in which a pair of salt and pepper shakers and a cup of coffee stand next to a plate of food that has burst into flame while a bird flies over the table are familiar favorites all of these works attest to callis s singular vision of the delicate boundary between the world within and the world without

judith nasby founding director and curator of the macdonald stewart art centre animates the story of the gallery from its humble beginnings in the hallways of a university campus in 1916 to its latest incarnation as the internationally recognized art gallery of guelph the book is beautifully illustrated with eighty images of artworks in the permanent collection beginning with the gallery s first acquisition tom thomson s 1917 masterpiece the drive the last large canvas he painted before his tragic death as curator nasby oversaw the creation of one of the most comprehensive sculpture parks in canada and the amassing of a permanent collection of some nine thousand artworks in the making of a museum nasby reveals how the museum developed its internationally recognized collection of contemporary inuit drawings and wall hangings that toured four continents she discusses the development of the collection s specializations in contemporary works by canadian silversmiths historical european etchings woodland and northeastern indigenous beadwork and others that arose from curatorial collaborations such as molas by kuna women artists from panama and contemporary paintings and indigenous woodcuts from chongqing china nasby recounts her long career as founding director and curator peppering the hundred year history of cultural development on the university of guelph campus

and in the city with humorous anecdotes and personal insights to reveal how arts institutions can be created through dedication serendipity and perseverance

this book is the first survey of the figural arts of the iranian world from prehistoric times to the early twentieth century ever to consider themes rather than styles analyzing primarily painting in manuscripts and albums on walls and on lacquered painted pen boxes and caskets but also the related arts of sculpture ceramics and metalwork the author finds that the underlying themes depicted on them through the ages are remarkably consistent eleanor sims demonstrates that all these arts display similar concerns kingship and legitimacy the righteous exercise of princely power and the defense of national territory and the performance of rituals and the religious duties called for by the paramount cult of the day she describes a variety of superb works of art inside and outside these categories noting not only how they illustrate archetypal themes but also what it is about them that is unique she also discusses the ways that iranian art both influenced and was influenced by invaders and neighboring lands boris i marshak discusses pre islamic and also central asian art in particular the earliest iranian wall paintings and their pictorial parallels in rock carvings and metalwork and the richly painted temples and houses of panjikent ernst j grube considers religious imagery and provides an informative bibliography

ceramics and the museum interrogates the relationship between art oriented ceramic practice and museum practice in britain since 1970 laura breen examines the identity of ceramics as an art form drawing on examples of work by artist makers such as edmund de waal and grayson perry addresses the impact of policy making on ceramic practice traces the shift from object to project in ceramic practice and in the evolution of ceramic sculpture explores how museums facilitated multisensory engagement with ceramic material and process and analyses the exhibition as a text in itself proposing the notion that gestures of showing such as exhibitions and installation art can be read as statements she examines what they tell us about the identity of ceramics at particular moments in time highlighting the ways in which these gestures have constructed ceramics as a category of artistic practice breen argues that they reveal gaps between narrative and practice which in turn can be used to deconstruct the art

a beautiful book that showcases how circus figures and artifacts have been portrayed in art over

the past two centuries the circus is a dazzling world filled with acrobats and harlequins tumblers and riders monsters and celestial creatures now this engaging book sets that world in a new light examining how painters sculptors and photographers from the eighteenth century to the present have used the circus as a springboard for their imaginative expression and have envisioned the clown as a metaphor for the modern artist the book presents more than 175 works by such artists as degas toulouse lautrec rouault picasso chagall and léger some of these are masterful works shown for the first time these range from the 18 meter stage curtain picasso designed in 1917 for erik satie s ballet parade to more intimate works such as nadar and tournachon s photographs of pierrot as played by celebrated mime charles debureau

in the early decades of the twentieth century british art was enlivened by a wide variety of imaginative attempts to take painting and sculpture outside the boundaries of the gallery some of the works were commissioned by architects as integral parts of new buildings

this book explores the great diversity and range of islamic culture through one of the finest collections in the world published to coincide with the historic reopening of the galleries of the metropolitan museum s islamic art department it presents nearly three hundred masterworks created in the rich tradition of the islamic faith and culture the metropolitan s renowned holdings range chronologically from the origins of islam in the 7th century through the 19th century and geographically from as far west as spain to as far east as southeast asia

reveals the exquisite work and extraordinary skill of a group of new zealand artists most of them women working in a wide variety of art and craft forms this flowering of local talent originated in the british arts and crafts movement and is associated with the growth of art education in this country its quiet but dedicated character also suggests much about the situation of women in the years before and after 1900 jacket

a breathtaking and superbly designed volume on the influential form of the realist to art nouveau art movements it lets you trace the roots of modern art beginning with realist paintings such as courbet s the stonebreakers and millet s the gleaners works that shocked mid 19th century paris with their unblinking depiction of the lives of the poor from realism to art nouveau beautifully captures this turbulent era with an incisive text and breathtaking reproductions of works by manet rossetti sargent monet seurat cezanne van gogh gauguin rodin klimt and others

a broad historical study of the provocative innovations of european and american photography between the world wars presents more than 160 images from the ford motor company collection of photographs

chapter on contemporary maori and pacific island painting as well as an acknowledgement of the coming wave of asian artists

published on the occasion of the exhibition of the same name held at the museum of modern art new york march 14 june 1 1999

this is the first investigation of one of the main interests of astronomy in islamic civilization namely timekeeping by the sun and stars and the regulation of the astronomically defined times of muslim prayer the study is based on over 500 medieval astronomical manuscripts first identified by the author now preserved in libraries all over the world and originally from the entire islamic world from the maghrib to central asia and the yemen the materials presented provide new insights into the early development of the prayer ritual in islam they also call into question the popular notion that religion could not inspire serious scientific activity only one of the hundreds of astronomical tables discussed here was known in medieval europe which is one reason why the entire corpus has remained unknown until the present a second volume also to be published by brill deals with astronomical instruments for timekeeping and other computing devices

archaeological digs have turned up sculptures in inuit lands that are thousands of years old but inuit art as it is known today only dates back to the beginning of the 1900s early art was traditionally produced from soft materials such as whalebone and tools and objects were also fashioned out of stone bone and ivory because these materials were readily available the inuit people are known not just for their sculpture but for their graphic art as well the most prominent forms being lithographs and stonecuts this work affords easy access to information to those interested in any type of inuit art there are annotated entries on over 3 761 articles books catalogues government documents and other publications

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
