how the civilian conservation corps constructed rejuvenated and protected american forests and parks at the height of the great depression propelled by the unprecedented poverty of the great depression president franklin d roosevelt established an array of massive public works programs designed to provide direct relief to america s poor and unemployed the new deal s most tangible legacy may be the civilian conservation corps s network of parks national forests scenic roadways and picnic shelters that still mark the country s landscape ccc enrollees most of them unmarried young men lived in camps run by the army and worked hard for wages most of which they had to send home to their families to preserve america s natural treasures in the new deal s forest army benjamin f alexander chronicles how the corps came about the process applicants went through to get in and what jobs they actually did he also explains how the camps and the work sites were run how enrollees spent their leisure time and how world war ii brought the ccc to its end connecting the story of the ccc with the roosevelt administration s larger initiatives alexander describes how fdr s policies constituted a mixed blessing for african americans who even while singled out for harsh treatment benefited enough from the new deal to become an increasingly strong part of the electorate behind the democratic party the ccc was the only large scale employment program whose existence fdr foreshadowed in speeches during the 1932 campaign and the dearest to his heart throughout the decade that it lasted alexander reveals how the work itself left a lasting imprint on the country s terrain as the enrollees planted trees fought forest fires landscaped public parks restored historic battlegrounds and constructed dams and terraces to prevent floods a uniquely detailed exploration of life in the ccc the new deal s forest army compellingly demonstrates how one new deal program changed america and gave birth to both contemporary forestry and the modern environmental movement

no group of american minority voters shifted allegiance more dramatically in the 1930s than black americans did up until the new deal era blacks had shown their traditional loyalty to the party of lincoln by voting overwhelmingly the republican ticket by the end of f d roosevelt s first administration however they tremendously voted the democratic ticket the decades long wholesale attachment of blacks to the party of lincoln with its laudable efforts to support blacks emancipation proclamation and reconstruction was understandable and inevitable enough the anomaly was the massive shift by blacks to the democratic party traditionally identified with its long list of constant anti black and premeditated opposition to black liberation opposition to emancipation and reconstruction and with an ongoing record of all forms of racial discrimination segregation disfranchisement exclusion white primaries and white supremacy the transformation of the black vote from solidly republican to solidly democratic did not happen instantaneously but rather it developed over decades of maturing as a result of the amalgamated efforts of presidents and black leaders the move of black voters toward the democratic party was part of a nationwide trend that had occurred with the creation of the roosevelt coalition of 1936 this national shift would make the democrats the majority party for the next several decades including a very decisive margin of black voters in the balance of power

tara mitchell mielnik fills a significant gap in the history of the new deal south by examining the lives of the men of south carolina s civilian conservation corps ccc who from 1933 to 1942 built sixteen state parks all of which still exist today enhanced with revealing interviews with former state ccc members mielnik s illustrated account provides a unique exploration into the great depression in the palmetto state and the role that south carolina s state parks continue to play as architectural legacies of a monumental new deal program in 1933 thousands of unemployed young men and world war i veterans were given the opportunity to work when emergency conservation work ecw one of franklin delano roosevelt s new deal programs came to south carolina renamed the civilian conservation corps in 1937 the program was responsible for planting millions of trees in reforestation projects augmenting firefighting activities stringing much needed telephone lines for fire prevention throughout the state and terracing farmland and other soil conservation projects the most visible legacies of the ccc in south carolina are many of the state s national forests recreational areas and parks prior

to the work of the ccc south carolina had no state parks but from 1933 to 1942 the ccc built sixteen mielnik s briskly paced and informative study gives voice to the young men who labored in the south carolina ccc and honors the legacy of the parks they built and the conservation and public recreation values these sites fostered for modern south carolina

in a no holds barred indictment of the republican right michael lind once a protege of william f buckley boldly chronicles how right wing orthodoxy has been corrupted from within lind exposes the egregious turning points in the republican agenda and warns of those in the party who are setting america on a course toward irreconcilable class divisions and hostility

in a unique and personal exploration of the game and fish laws in alabama georgia and mississippi from the progressive era to the 1930s julia brock offers an innovative history of hunting in the new south the implementation of conservation laws made significant strides in protecting endangered wildlife species but it also disrupted traditional hunting practices and livelihoods particularly among african americans and poor whites closed seasons highlights how hunting and fishing regulations were relatively rare in the nineteenth century but the emerging conservation movement and the rise of a regional sportsman identity at the turn of the twentieth century eventually led to the adoption of state level laws once passed however these laws were plagued by obstacles including insufficient funding and enforcement brock traces the dizzying array of factors propaganda racial tensions organizational activism and federal involvement that led to effective game and fish laws in the south

american fascism and the new deal demonstrate how fascist ideas gained popularity in the associated farmers of california during the 1930s and 40s it shows that the politics of the intervening decades created economic and political policies that planted the seeds for these fascist ideas by forming alliances between the corporate private realm and the state public realm these same alliances made fd and subsequent political figures rethink the direction they wanted to take american democracy through a careful analysis of the associated farmers of california nelson a pichardo almanzar and brian kulik show how the afc formed positions in direct alliance with fascist ideas but also why these ideas resonate with so many people even to this day the analysis presented in american fascism and the new deal will be of particular interest to sociologists especially social movement theorists chicana o studies scholars political scientists business ethicists and historians

this title was first published in 2002 loosely divided into two sections this book s first part includes chapters which explore young

people's identities and youth cultures in relation to issues such as drug use education and dance music in various ways the authors examine whether there is a need to rethink the existing theories and concepts which have informed the study of youth cultures and identities the second part to the volume is concerned with how young people experience transitions in relation to such topics as employment sexuality and household formation the chapters also raise theoretical questions on the usefulness of the transition concept in late modernity illustrating how the reshaping of key institutions in late modernity has had a profound effect on the sorts of transitions young people make today in addressing such issues the authors examine the potential contribution that concepts around risk and risk society and new third way social policy initiatives can have to contemporary youth studies

taking as its starting point anthony downs seminal work *An Economic Theory of Democracy* this book draws upon insights generated within economics political psychology and the study of rhetoric to examine the way in which new labour achieved and maintained its electoral hegemony from 1994 journalists and politicians routinely attribute new labour's electoral success to its occupation of the centre ground this book is interested in the question of how new labour moved to the right and towards the centre the obvious answer to this question is that new labour moved by changing its policies against this the book contends that changes in policy cannot in themselves constitute a complete explanation of changes in spatial position they cannot do so because there is no pre-given and fixed relationship between policies and position such that the rejection of one policy and the adoption of another moves a party from one position to another policies are not immutably left wing right wing or centrist and so given that the position a party is thought to occupy is a function of the policies to which it is committed parties are not immutably left wing right wing or centrist either the relationship between policy and position and thereby between parties and position is constructed and is in part constructed by parties themselves new labour did not simply move to the centre it had to persuade the media voters and other parties that it had moved to the centre new labour achieved and maintained its electoral hegemony not simply by changing one set of policies for another it achieved and maintained its hegemony by successfully constructing its policies as centrist
